Many Frank Sinatra fans consider "Songs for Swingin' Lovers" the high spot in his now-legendary career. Certainly this album of great ballads sung in the romantic, always-swinging Sinatra style helped to establish him beyond any doubt as a master among modern singers of love songs.

Adding that special something to a dozen of the finest tunes ever written, Frank made each one sound as if it were composed for him alone — a knack that has always been a Sinatra specialty. And not only did the album become a tremendous best-seller, but it also had the far-reaching effects of ushering in a whole new trend in contemporary ballad singing, and introducing the wonderful, easy-swinging style of instrumental backing that has become famous as the "Nelson Riddle sound."

For those who missed it the first time around, here is Capitol's re-issue of "Songs for Swingin" Lovers"—an album that holds a well-deserved place of distinction among the all-time Sinatra favorites.
