The text used is the first version in the Gutenberg collection. *Magna Carta* is the most significant early influence on the long historical process that has led to the rule of constitutional law today. *Magna Carta* was originally created because of disagreements between the Pope, King John and his English barons over the rights of the King. *Magna Carta* required the king to renounce certain rights and respect certain legal procedures and to accept that the will of the king could be bound by law.
