








Buggy the Pirate His Evolution Part 1


* Why does Buggy have a big round nose?


So he'll look like a clown, of course.

Hachi the Messenger



Scissors, cutter, glue or paste, a pen, stiff paper (on the thin side)


You won't need:

I. Glue. (To be cancelled in event of rain.)


Glue the pages containing Part II and Part III to a piece of the stiff paper.




(Use a photocopy if you don't want to cut up your book.)

2. Cut.


Cut out Part I, Part II, and Part III. Be careful when cutting out the slots.


