




Fuel tank door release and cap




NOTE: Tighten until one click is heard. If the cap is not tightened enough, Check Engine " " indicator may illuminate.






Automatic Transmission (if equipped)




^{*} The engine switch must be "ON" and the brake pedal depressed to shift from Park.





Automatic down operation (driver side only)






Air Conditioning/Heating



- Air Conditioning ON/OFF
 Use fresh air to quickly cool interior, then change to recirculate for cooler air.

In "#" or "#" mode, use with the air intake selector position in "" to reduce window fogging.

AUX audio jack



By inserting a mini plug (not included) into the AUX jack, you can listen to music from a portable audio device through the vehicle's speaker system while in AUX mode.

If you do not have a SCION genuine audio system, you will not be able to use the AUX jack.

iPod[®] jack




By inserting the standard iPod® connector cable into the iPod® jack, you can charge the iPod® battery, control the iPod® functions using the car audio unit and listen to music from your iPod® through the vehicle's speaker system.

If you do not have a SCION genuine audio system, you will not be able to use the iPod® jack.

Steering wheel switches




- " V A"
 - -In radio mode Push to select a preset station; push and hold to seek the next strong station.


Multi-information display



Push button to change information in the following succession:


- (1) Odometer

Designed for car accessories. Key must be in the "ACC" or "ON" position for use.








Doors-Child safety locks




Moving the lever to "LOCK" will allow the door to be opened only from the outside.


Seat belts



If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.

To find more information about seat belts, and how to install a child restraint system, refer to the *Owner's Manual*.

Tire Pressure Monitoring (warning) System



System reset initialization

- Push and hold " SET" button until the indicator blinks three times.
- 2. Wait several minutes to allow initialization to complete.


After adjusting tire pressures, or after tires have been rotated or replaced, turn the ignition switch to "ON" and press and hold the "SET" button until indicator blinks three times. Let the vehicle sit for a few minutes to allow initialization to complete.


Refer to the load label on the door jamb or the *Owner's Manual* for tire inflation specifications.

If the tire pressure indicator flashes for more than 60 seconds and then remains on, take the vehicle to your local Toyota dealer.

Note: The warning light may come on due to temperature changes or changes in tire pressure from natural air leakage. If the system has not been initialized recently, setting the tire pressures to factory specifications should turn off the light.
