AF Area Selection Mode



- Press the < → > button.
- Look through the viewfinder and press the <M-Fn> button.
- Each time you press the <M-Fn> button, the AF area selection mode changes.

□ AF Point Selection



● Press the < --> button, then look through the viewfinder



- The AF point selection will change in the direction you tilt the <%>. If you press < ♦ > straight down. the center AF point (or center Zone) will be selected
- The < > dial selects an AF point in the horizontal direction and the < > dial selects an AF point in the vertical direction (toggles between zones in Zone



Metering Mode



- Press the < 3⋅2 > button, then turn the < >> dial.
- Standard metering mode
- Partial metering: Approx. 6.5% at center
- Spot metering: Approx. 2.5% at center
- Center-weighted average metering: Brightness metered at the center and averaged for the entire scene
- When spot metering is set, multi-spot metering is possible with the < M-Fn > button.

Exposure Compensation





Exposure level -

- Press the shutter button halfway and check the exposure level
- Turn the <<<p>> dial to set the exposure compensation amount. You can set the amount up to ±f
- stops in 1/3-stop increments.
- To cancel exposure compensation, set the exposure level indicator <■/▮> to the standard exposure index (<▶/♥>).
- If the exposure compensation amount exceeds ±3 stops. setting it with the Quick Control screen is recommended You can also set it with the <™ > button and <™ / ○ > dial.
- For light-colored subjects, set it to the plus side. For dark-colored subjects, set it to the minus side.

X AE Lock



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LAE lock

- Focus the subject.
- Press the < +> button to lock the current exposure setting.
- the right of the viewfinder will show the AF lock exposure level and the current exposure level in real-time. Recompose and take the picture.

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
