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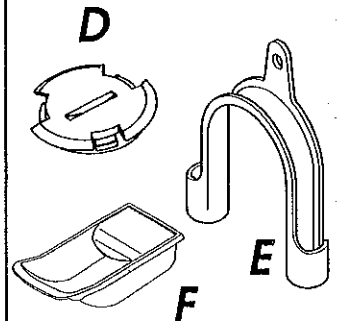
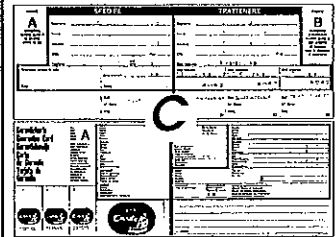
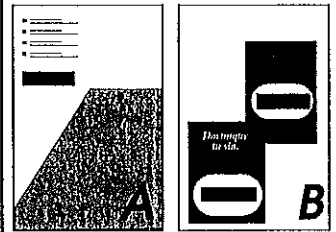
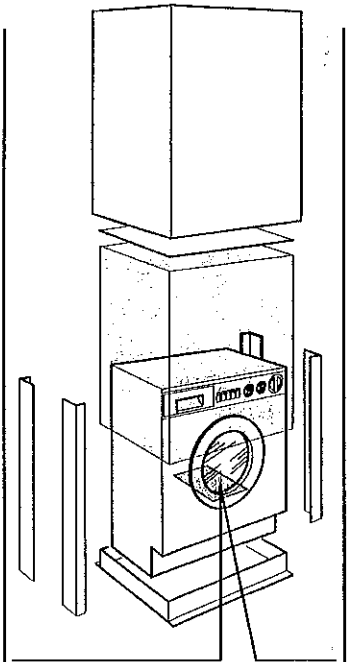
## CHAPTER 1

### GENERAL DELIVERY POINTS

## CHAPTER 2

GUARANTEE

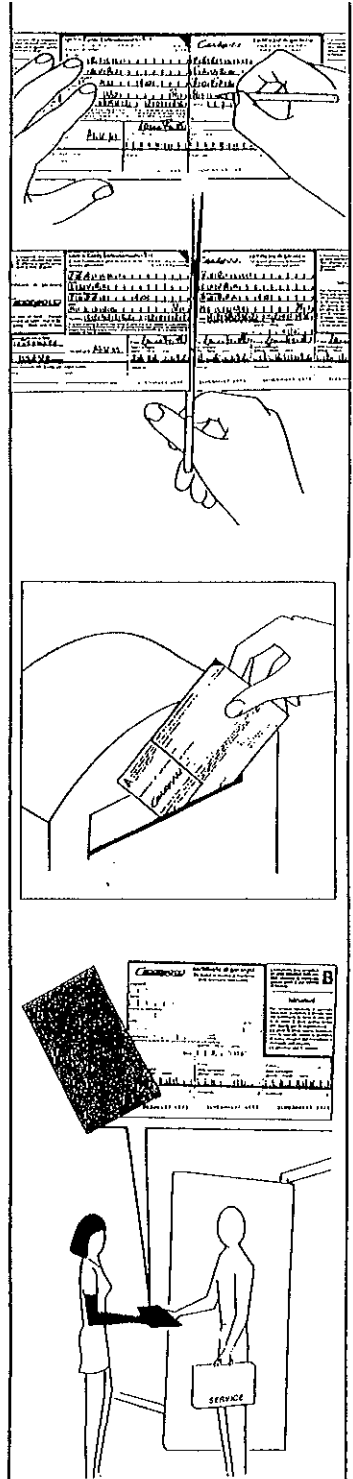
Your new appliance is fully guaranteed by the manufacturer for 12 months against electrical/mechanical breakdown excluding:

- A. Any faults which occur due to bad installation or misuse of the machine.
- B. Any faults which occur due to repair of, or interference with, the machine by any person not authorised by the manufacturer to carry out service.
- C. Any faults which arise from parts fitted to the machine which are not the manufacturers original parts.
- D. Any faults arising from non-domestic use or unusual or abnormal use of the machine.
- E. Any faults arising from operation at an incorrect voltage.
- F. Any faults arising from incorrect operation of the machine.

The guarantee applies to Gt. Britain and Northern Ireland only, and is an addition to your statutory rights.

Your appliance is supplied with a registration card which should be completed and returned as indicated.

This should be kept in a safe place and presented to the Engineer if a service call is required.



## CHAPTER 3

## SAFETY MEASURES

**IMPORTANT:  
BEFORE CLEANING OR GENERAL MAINTENANCE**

- Remove the plug
- Turn off the water inlet tap.
- All Candy appliances are earthed, ensure that the main electricity circuit is earthed. Contact a qualified electrician if this is not the case.

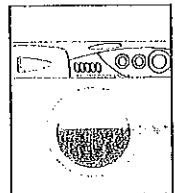
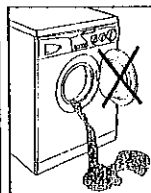
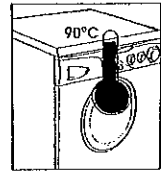
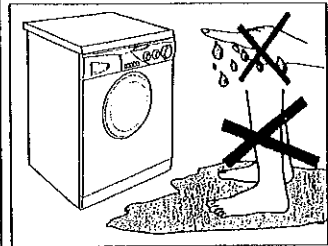
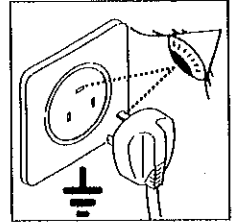
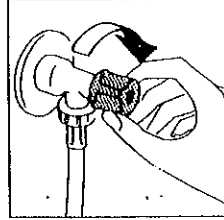
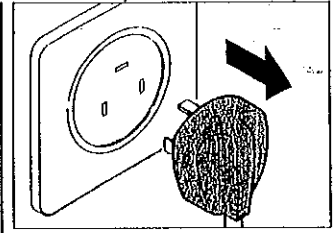
**CE** This appliance complies with Directives 89/336/EEC, 73/23/EEC and the following changes.

- Do not touch the appliance with wet or damp hands or feet.
- Do not use the appliance when bare footed.

**Warning: this appliance must be earthed.**

**WARNING: DURING THE WASH CYCLE, THE WATER CAN REACH A TEMPERATURE OF 90°C.**

- Before opening the washing machine door, ensure that there is no water inside the drum.





- Do not use adapters or multiple plugs.
- Do not allow the appliance to be used by children without supervision.
- Do not pull the mains lead or the machine itself in an attempt to remove the plug from the socket.
- Do not leave the appliance exposed to the natural elements (rain, sun, freezing etc.)

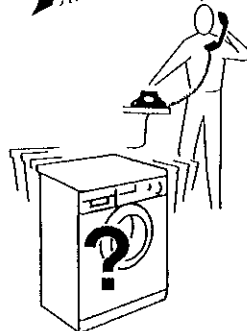
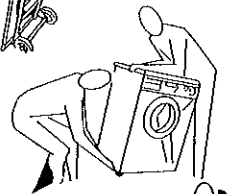
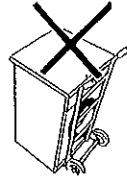
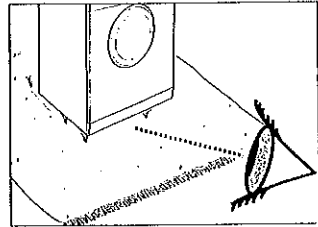
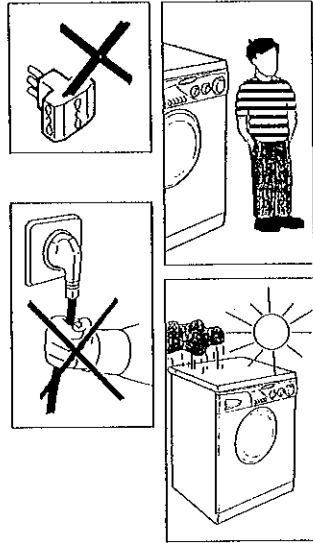

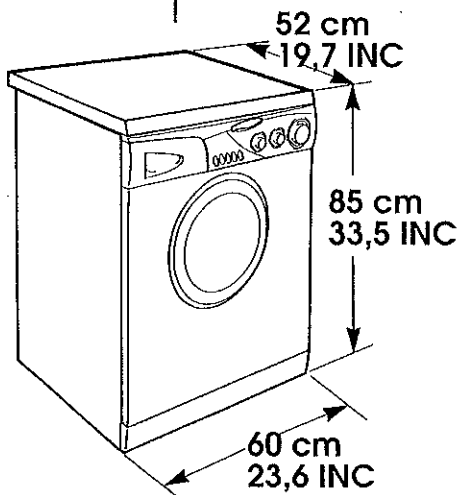
When placed on carpet or carpet tiles care must be taken to ensure that there is no obstruction to the bottom vents.

● During transport do not lean the loading door against a trolley.

● Lift the appliance in pairs as illustrated in the diagram.

● In the event of appliance failure and/or incorrect operation, turn off the washing machine, disconnect the electrical supply and do not tamper with the appliance. Refer to the check list in chapter 13 for "possible reasons for the problem". Then if necessary contact the Candy Service Centre shown in the booklet supplied for repairs.

## CHAPTER 5

## SETTING UP INSTALLATION

Remove the polystyrene base and place the machine near its permanent position (diagram 1).

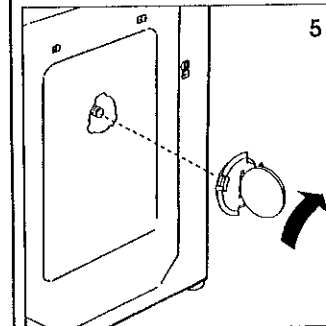
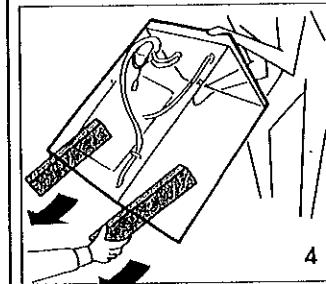
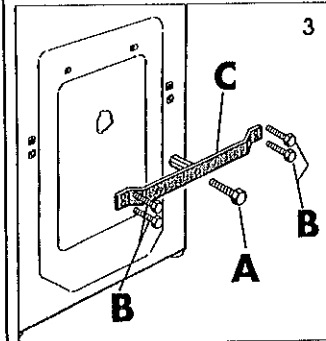
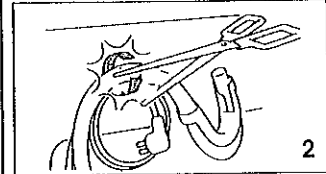
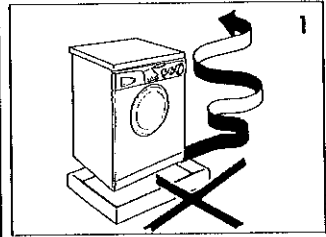
Carefully cut through the hose retaining clip at the rear of the appliance (diagram 2).

Unscrew the central bolt (A); unscrew the 4 lateral screws (B) and remove the cross piece (C) (diagram 3).

Lean the machine forward and remove the plastic bags containing the two polystyrene blocks at the sides, pulling downwards (diagram 4).

Press the plug (to be found in the envelope with the instructions) into the hole and rotate to lock into position (diagram 5).

**WARNING:**  
DO NOT LEAVE THE PACKAGING IN THE REACH OF CHILDREN AS IT IS A POTENTIAL SOURCE OF DANGER.





## WATER CONNECTION

Your machine may either be plumbed in or connected to existing taps, using a tap adaptor with a 3/4 B.S.P. threaded end connection. The water supply hoses to be found inside the drum are terminated in two different ways. One end which has a 90° elbow is to be connected to the appliance water connection E while the straight end is to be connected to the domestic supply tap. The hose with the white collar should be connected to the cold tap, and the hose with the red collar to the hot tap. The appliance is not suitable for use with mixer taps.

Hook the end of the outlet hose over the rim of the sink or outlet pipe, making sure that it is not kinked. For better positioning of the outlet hose make use of the plastic bend provided.

Where possible, use a fixed discharge pipe with a diameter greater than that of the outlet hose this allows the air to escape.

**The minimum height of the top of the outlet hose should be 50 cm.**

Extending the outlet hose, especially if the extension is more than 1 metre, could lead to malfunctioning of the discharge.

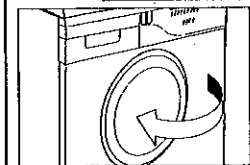
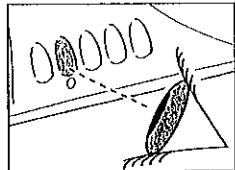
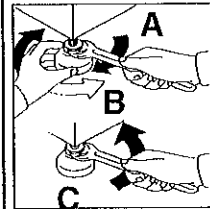
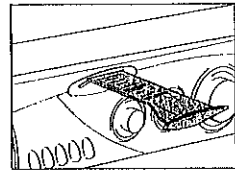
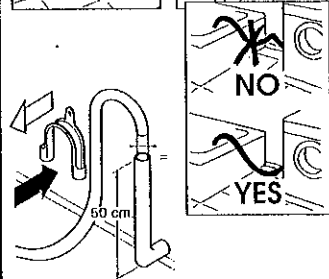
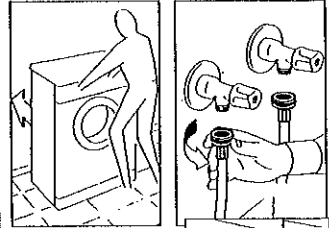
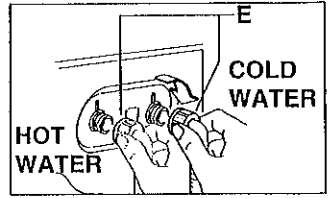
The appliance outlet hose should discharge into the foul water drainage system and not into the surface water drainage system. Should you require further advice please contact your local water authority.

Apply the adhesive label supplied in the appropriate language onto the pull-out wash programme guide (R). (See chapter 6 - description of control panel).

Level the machine by means of the front feet.

- Turn the nut clockwise to release the screw adjuster on the foot.
- Rotate the foot to raise or lower it until it stands firmly on the ground.
- Lock the foot in position by turning the nut anti-clockwise until it comes up against the bottom of the machine.


Ensure that the ON/OFF button (see page 12, button C) is not pressed and the load door is closed.

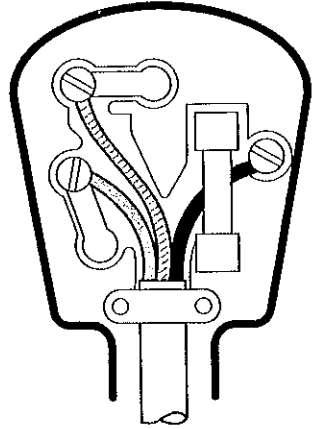




## ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

If the plug we supply does not fit  
**CUT IT OFF AND DESTROY IT!**  
 You can't use it on other appliances, and the exposed wires  
 could be dangerous if plugged in.  
 To fit a replacement plug, proceed as follows:

Only woollens bearing a machine washable care label are suitable for machine washing.



























**When sorting items of laundry for washing always ensure that:**

- you check pockets for metal objects, brooches, safety pins or loose coins.
- cushion covers are zipped or buttoned, loose belts are fastened.
- full attention has been paid to individual wash care labels.
- tough stains have been treated with a pre-wash stain remover prior to machine washing. Only use stain removers recommended on the wash care label.

DETERGENT DRAWER

The detergent drawer is divided into 4 compartments:


- The first I for pre-wash detergent
- The second II for main wash detergent

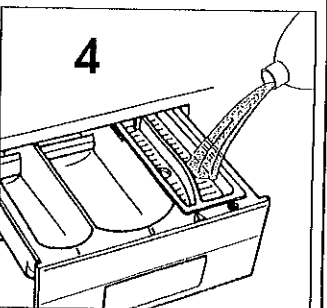
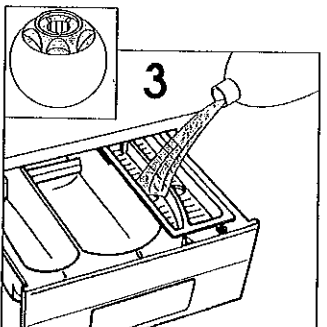
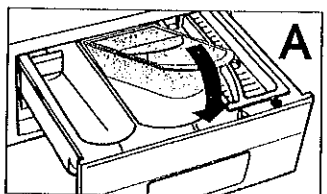
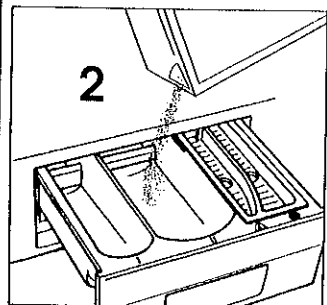
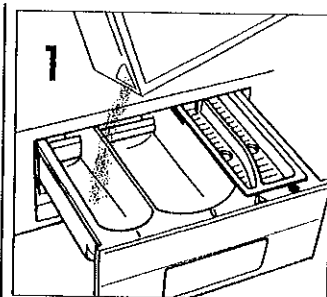
A special container is supplied for use with liquid detergents. This can be placed inside the drawer shown in fig. A.

**IMPORTANT:**  
REMEMBER THAT SOME DETERGENTS CAN BE DIFFICULT TO REMOVE. IF THIS SHOULD OCCUR WE ADVISE THE USE OF A SPECIAL CONTAINER TO BE USED INSIDE THE DRUM.

- The third  bleaching compartment

ONLY USE LIQUID PRODUCTS IN THE THIRD AND FOURTH COMPARTMENTS.

- The fourth  compartment is for special additives, fabric softeners, starches, whiteners, etc.



## CHAPTER 8

## PROGRAMME SELECTION

The wash programme dial is divided into three separate phases, according to different fabric types, the degree of soiling, temperature and length of cycle. (See table of wash programmes).

### 1 Resistant fabrics (mainly heavy cottons)

These programmes have been designed to give maximum wash. The gradual reduction of water temperature reduces fabric creasing and the final spin provides a more efficient removal of water.

### 2 Mixtures and synthetic fabrics

A combination of efficient washing, optimum drum rotation and 3 high water level rinses provides excellent cleaning results.

### 3 Special delicate fabrics

A new wash cycle which has been specifically designed for very delicate fabrics or machine washable woollens, alternates between very gentle washing and soaking cycles.

**CHAPTER 11**

CUSTOMER AWARENESS

A guide environmentally friendly and economic use of your appliance.

**MAXIMISE THE LOAD SIZE**

Achieve the best use of energy, water, detergent and time by using the recommended maximum load size.  
Save up to 50% energy by washing a full load instead of 2 half loads.

**DO YOU NEED TO PRE-WASH?**

For heavily soiled laundry only  
SAVE detergent, time, water and between 5 to 15% energy consumption by NOT selecting Prewash for slight to normally soiled laundry.

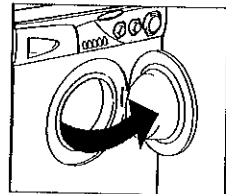
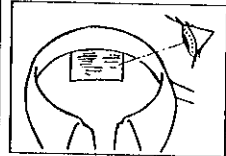
**IS A HOT WASH REQUIRED?**

Pretreat stains with stain remover or soak dried in stains in water before washing to reduce the necessity of a hot wash programme.  
Save up to 50% energy by using a 60°C wash programme.

COMPLETING A STANDARD WASH PROGRAMME


- Comprehensive guidance is provided in the wash programme table, chapter 10.
- Always ensure that clothes are washed in accordance with the temperatures shown on the wash care labels.
- Open the loading door by depressing the button marked B in the diagram.
- Load the drum with a maximum of 4.5 Kg. of dry washing.
- Ensure that the door has been closed properly.
- Set the programme dial to the type of wash required.
- Push the On/Off button.

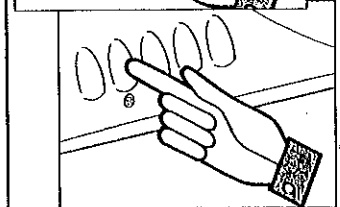
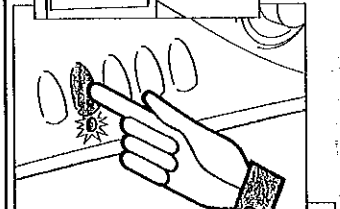
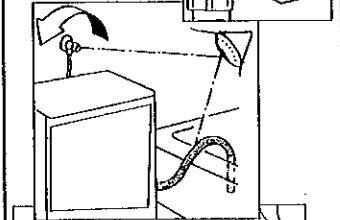
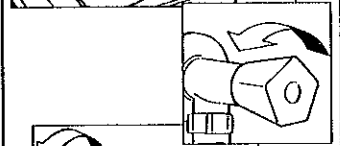
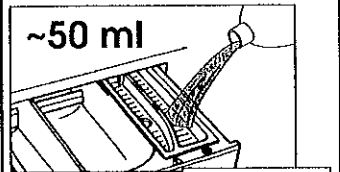
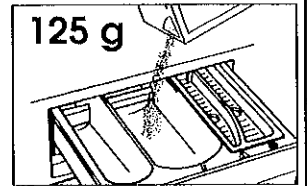
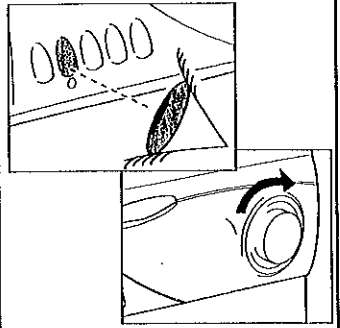


**IMPORTANT:**  
WHEN SETTING THE PROGRAMME ENSURE THAT THE  
ON/OFF BUTTON IS IN THE OFF POSITION.

**EXAMPLE: CARRYING OUT A NORMAL WASH**

1. Select the desired programme.
2. Choose the wash programme by rotating the knob I in a clockwise direction. The programme temperature on the dial should coincide with the temperature shown on the clothing (wash care symbol).
3. Open the detergent drawer (A).
4. Put 125 g. of detergent in the main wash compartment (ii).
5. Put 50 ml. of fabric softener in the additives compartment .
6. Close the detergent drawer (A).
7. Ensure that the water inlet taps are turned on.
8. And that the water discharge hose is in place
9. Press the On button (C).
10. The indicator light (G) will come on.
11. The washing machine will then carry out the set programme.
12. At the end of the programme, press the On/Off button (C) the Indicator light will go out.
13. Open the door and remove the laundry

**ALWAYS CONSULT THE PROGRAMME TABLE AND  
FOLLOW THE STEPS IN THE ORDER INDICATED ABOVE.**



## CHAPTER 12

### CLEANING AND ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Do not use abrasives, spirits or solvents on the machine exterior, simply wipe over with a damp cloth.

- Cleaning the detergent drawer.
- Guidance on transporting the appliance/storage instructions for long periods of inactivity.

#### CLEANING THE DETERGENT DRAWER COMPARTMENTS

Although not strictly necessary, it is advisable to clean each of the compartments occasionally.

Remove the drawer by pulling gently.

Clean with water.

Push the detergent drawer back into place

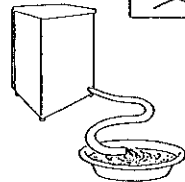
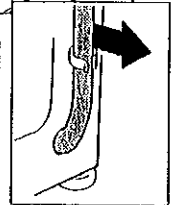
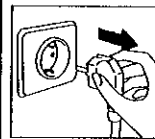
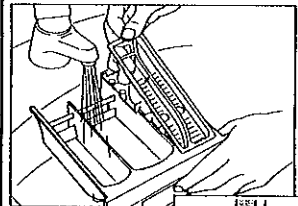
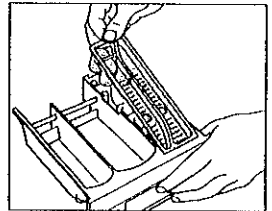
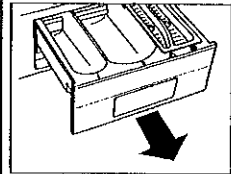
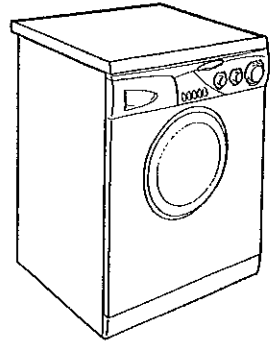
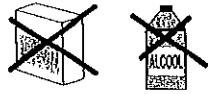
#### GUIDANCE ON TRANSPORTING THE APPLIANCE/STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS FOR LONG PERIODS OF INACTIVITY

The following instructions must be followed prior to moving the appliance or if the appliance is to be left un-used/stored for a long period.

- Switch off the appliance and unplug.
- Detach the drainage hose and drain over a bowl until all of the water is removed.
- Repeat the same operation with the water inlet hose.

#### SUGGESTED:

If transporting the appliance refit the transit brackets by following in reverse order the instructions given in chapter 5.

If the fault should persist, contact a Candy Service Centre. For prompt servicing, give the model of the washing machine, to be found on the label placed on the cabinet inside of the porthole or on the guarantee certificate.

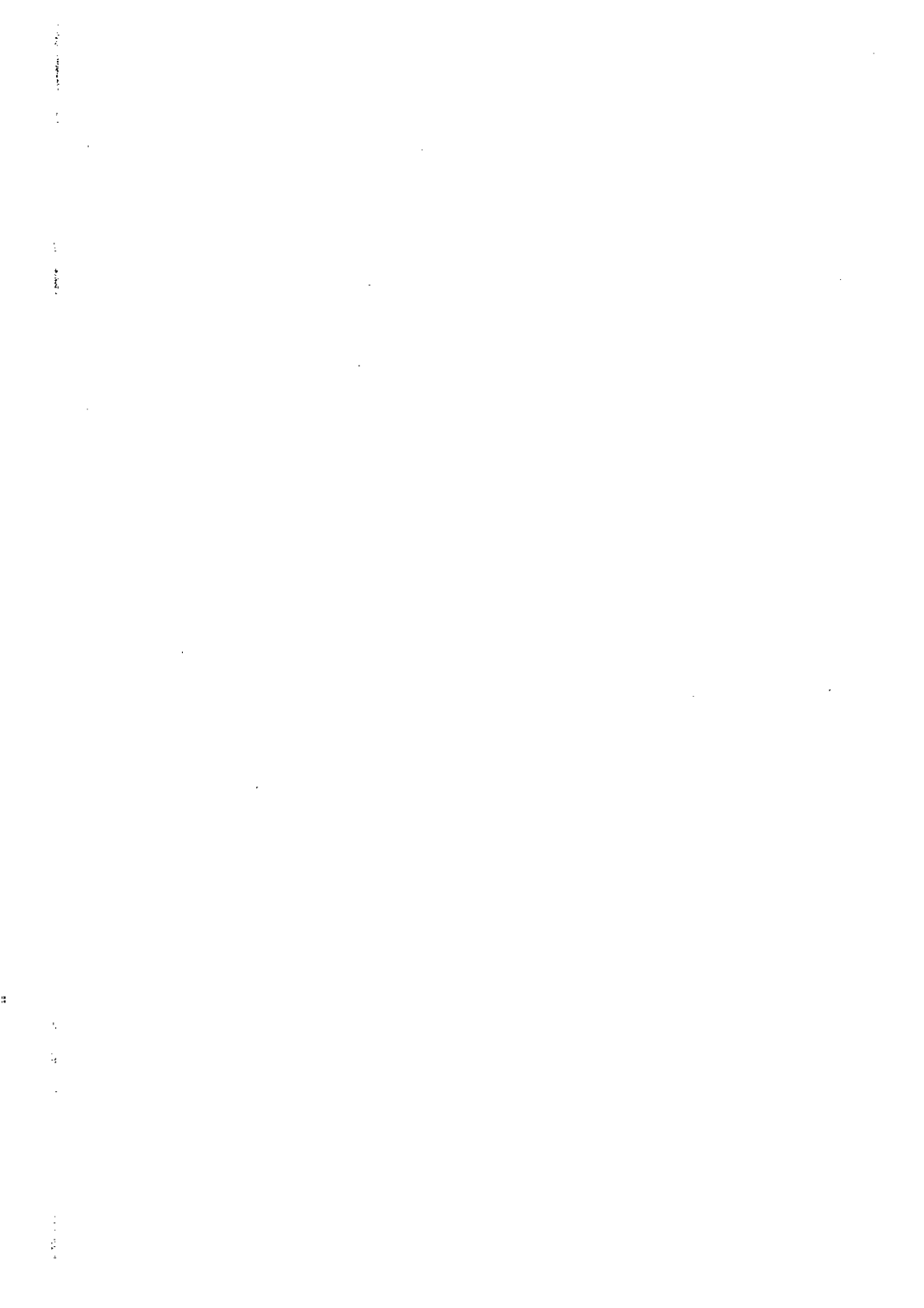
#### Important

1 The use of environment friendly detergents without phosphates may produce the following effects:

- The discharge rinse water may result cloudier due to the presence of zeolites in suspension. This does not compromise the efficiency of the rinses.
- The presence of white powder (zeolites) on the washing at the end of the washing cycle. This does not remain incorporated in the fabric and does not alter the colour.
- The presence of foam in the last rinse water which is not necessarily a sign of inadequate rinsing.
- The non-ionic surface-active agents present in the composition of washing machine detergents are often difficult to remove from the washing itself and, even in small quantities, may produce visible signs of the formation of foam.
- Carrying out further rinses, in cases such as this, is not useful.

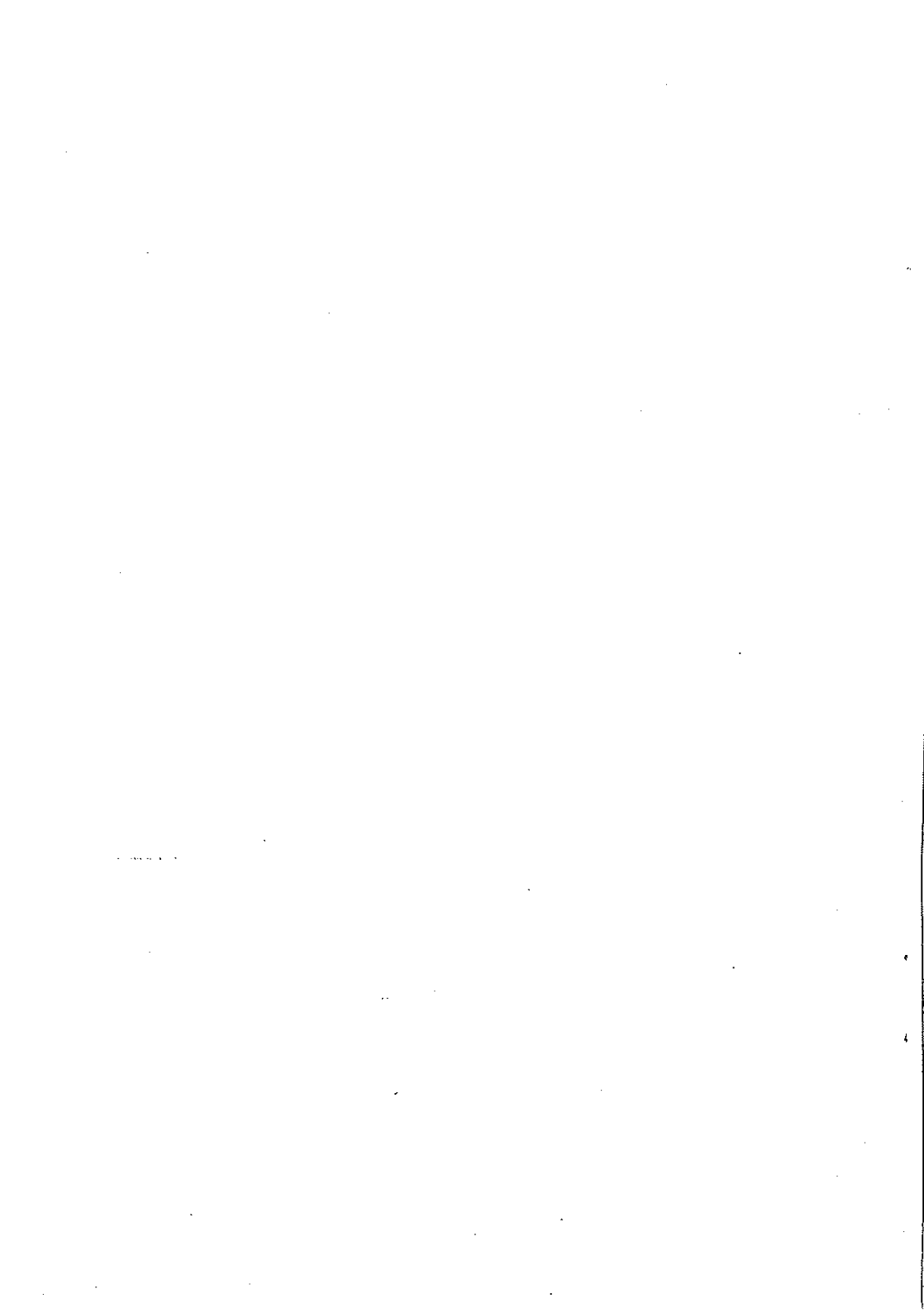

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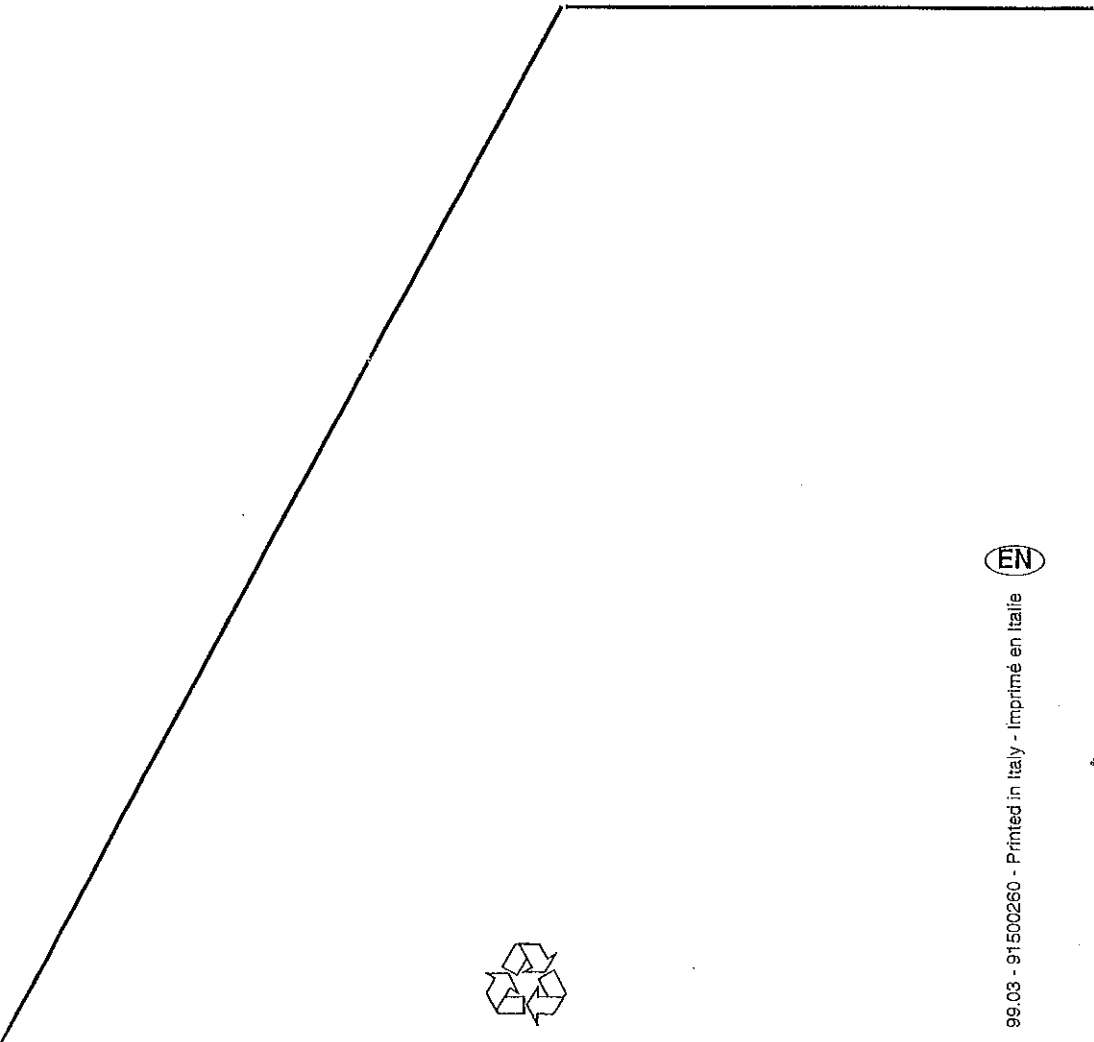
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
