## **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

### SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

This manual contains important safety instructions that should be followed during the installation and maintenance of the UPS. Please read this manual thoroughly before attempting to install or operate this UPS.

#### WARNING:

- To prevent the risk of fire or electric shock, install the UPS in a temperature and humidity controlled room, free of conductive contaminants.
- Operate the UPS only from a properly grounded AC supply.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove the cover, as it has no user-serviceable parts inside. Some components are live, even when AC power is disconnected. For service, contact a qualified technician.
- To reduce the risk of fire, use the proper rating when replacing the fuse.

#### **CAUTION:**

Although your UPS has been designed and manufactured to assure personal safety, improper use can result in electrical shock or fire. To insure safety, please observe the following rules:

- Turn off and unplug your UPS before cleaning. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. A dry cloth is recommended to remove dust from the surface of your UPS.
- Do not install or operate your UPS in or near water.
- Do not place UPS on an unstable cart, stand, or table.
- Do not place UPS under direct sunlight or close to heat emitting sources.
- Do not place UPS power cord in any area where it may get damaged by heavy objects.
- Follow all warnings and instructions marked on the UPS. Do not attempt to service the UPS, as it has no user-serviceable parts inside. Refer all repairs to qualified service personnel.

#### ATTENTION:

Turn off and unplug your UPS from the outlet and contact qualified service personnel if:

- The power cord or plug is damaged.
- Liquid has been spilled on the UPS.
- The fuse blows frequently.
- The UPS does not operate even when user follows the operating instructions.

**CONDITIONS OF USE:** The input receptacle must be within 6 feet (1.8 meters) of the UPS.

Your UPS provides conditioned power to connected equipment. Maximum load must not exceed that shown on UPS rating label. If uncertain, consult your distributor or Liebert.

Placing magnetic storage media on top of the UPS may result in data corruption.

This equipment can be operated by individuals without previous training.


### **INTRODUCTION & SYSTEM DESCRIPTION**


Congratulations on your choice of the Liebert PowerSure Personal Uninterruptible Power System (UPS). It provides conditioned power to microcomputers and other sensitive electronic equipment.

**NOTE:** This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment uses, generates and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference with radio communications. However, there is no guarantee that interference will not occur in a particular installation. If this equipment does cause harmful interference to radio or television reception, which can be determined by turning the equipment off and on, the user is encouraged to try to correct the interference by one or more of the following measures:

- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.
- Increase the separation between the equipment and the receiver.
- Connect the equipment into an outlet on a circuit different from that which the receiver is connected.
- Consult the dealer or an experienced radio/TV technician for help.

### MAJOR COMPONENTS





#### **Normal Operation**

During normal operation, incoming utility power is supplied to the load as shown above. The utility power passes through the EMI/ RFI filters and TVSS circuitry and then through the transfer switch to the connected loads. The battery charger is operational whenever AC power is supplied, even when the unit is switched off. PowerSure Personal continuously monitors the batteries.

#### **Transfer Switch**

In Normal mode the transfer switch passes utility AC power to the connected load. When input utility or frequency is outside acceptable limits, the transfer switch activates and transfers the UPS to battery.

### **Battery Charger**

In normal operation, the battery charger converts utility AC power into regulated DC power to float charge the battery.


#### **Battery**

The PowerSure Personal utilizes valve regulated, nonspillable, lead acid battery. At typical room temperatures and with the UPS float charging, the battery system will last many years.

### Transient Voltage Surge Suppression (TVSS) & EMI / RFI Filters


These UPS components provide surge protection and filter electromagnetic interference (EMI) and radio frequency interference (RFI). They minimize any surges or interference present in the utility line and keep the sensitive equipment protected.




### **MAINTENANCE**

The PowerSure Personal UPS requires very little maintenance. The batteries are valve regulated, nonspillable, lead acid, and require that they be kept charged to obtain their designed life. The UPS continuously charges the batteries when connected to the utility supply.

When storing the UPS for any length of time, it is recommended to plug in the UPS for at least 24 hours every four to six months to ensure full recharge of the batteries.

### **FUSE REPLACEMENT PROCEDURES**



**CAUTION:** Before changing the supply fuse, turn off the UPS, and unplug the input cord from the AC input power supply and from the UPS.

- Remove the fuse holder by inserting a flat blade screwdriver into the slot and pulling out as indicated in the figure above.
- 2. Remove the input fuse.
- 3. Remove the spare fuse from its position by using the screwdriver to push it out.
- 4. Place spare fuse in the input fuse position, and replace the fuse holder. The fuse holder will lock into position.
- Reconnect the input power lead to the UPS, and the input power lead to the input AC supply.
- 6. Restart the UPS. The UPS is ready for normal operation.



### **COMMUNICATIONS**


The PowerSure™ Personal UPS contains a standard DB-9 receptacle located on the rear of the UPS unit. Several signals are provided on this port and are assigned as follows:

PIN	ASSIGNMENT DESCRIPTION
1	Low Battery (open collector)
2	No connection
3	No connection
4	On Battery Mode Shutdown (5-12 DC)
5	On Battery Mode Shutdown Return
6	Utility Fail / Normally On (open collector)
7	Low Battery (open emitter)
8	Utility Fail (common) (pins 6 & 9)
9	Utility Fail / Normally Off (open collector)

\*Maximum voltage and current on pins 1, 6, 7, 8, 9 is 60V DC; 5.0 mA.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If the UPS fails to operate properly, turn off the unit and repeat the steps in the installation section of this manual. If the problem persists, refer to the chart below:
