

HOOKING UP YOUR TV (BASIC ANTENNA/CABLE TV CONNECTIONS)

CABLE INPUT/CONVERTER **7**our Cable TV input into your home may be a single (75 ohm) cable, or a Converter Box installation. In either case the connection to the TV is very easy. Just put the threaded end of the cable signal to the TV's antenna plug and screw it down tight.




Cable TV Converter **Box Connection**

To select only the channel numbers on your Cable system see "Auto Program" (page 4). If you use a Cable Converter box, set the TV to the same channel as the converter's CH 3/4 switch (on the rear of the converter.)




or DOWN ■ buttons on the remote (or the Channel ▲ or ▼ buttons on the TV) to pick any of the onscreen menu features.


lighted onscreen feature.


Press the STATUS/EXIT button on the remote to clear the screen after an adjustment.


You can also just wait a few seconds after you finish the feature adjustment and the MENU will disappear from the screen automatically.




If you pass the feature you want, press the CUR-SOR UP or DOWN button on the remote to move back through the MENU.

The MENU list is a continuous loop. Once you come to the last item in the list, scrolling down will bring you back to the start of the list again.

The onscreen menu will time out and disappear from the screen when you finish, or you can press the STATUS/EXIT button to clear the menu from the screen.
