This tool is for optimization of touch performance for the touch screen to meet the 1% TPE accuracy specification.

- 1. Be sure that the USB cable is not connected to the PC.

Simply plug in the USB cable to the monitor and computer and power up. The computer will automatically recognize and operate the PT1520MU and LX1200 monitor.

Should you desire enhanced features and calibration for 1% TPE accuracy load 3M<sup>®</sup> MT 7.11 touchscreen driver located on the enclosed CD in the "PT1520MU, LX1200, 2000, XP" link. The enhanced features include drag and drop, touch activation on lift off, enhanced touch accuracy, etc.
