

- Insert two AA size (UM-3) batteries (not included) into the Battery Compartment following the diagram inside the compartment and replace the Battery Compartment cover.




BATTERY PRECAUTIONS


OPERATION

LISTENING TO THE RADIO



Rotate the VOLUME/ POWER control clockwise to turn the power

Slide the BAND switch 1 to select AM or FM. Rotate the TUNING control 2 to tune in a station.



Rotate the VOLUME/ POWER control to adjust the volume. Rotate the VOLUME/ POWER control counterclockwise until a click is heard to turn the unit off.

FM: Extend the antenna wire for better FM reception.

AM: Turn the unit for better AM reception.
