



Adult assembly is required for battery replacement. Tool required for battery replacement: Phillips screwdriver (not included) Wipe this toy with a clean cloth. Do not immerse. This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Please do not take this toy apart.

# **Battery Replacement**

For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with two, new "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries.



- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove it.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert two, new "AAA" (LR03) alkaline batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and then back on.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.


## Battery Safety Information

+ ( 1,5V × 2 "AAA" (LR03) -

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

Press the top or bottom of the button for fun learning "updates"!

- Learn opposites! Press the square side of the button for "stop"; press the triangle side for "go".
- Press the top of the button + to (ک turn volume up; press the bottom of the button - to turn volume down

**Hint:** You can turn volume up or down while other sounds are playing! When power is turned off and then back on, the sound level will reset to the original setting.

- Press for music. Can you sing along?
  - Press a number button to hear it

- When finished playing with this toy, slide the power switch OFF O.
