





3 Find and store frequencies

- 1. Press 📥, 🕗, 🛧, 🥗, or 🌮. The service search starts in two seconds.
- 2. Press ENT when you find an interesting frequency (not applicable for marine or weather service banks). The bank number and **StorE** appear.
- 3. If you want to change storage banks, enter the new bank number.
- **4.** Press **ENT** to store the frequency. The channel and frequency flash twice. To cancel the operation, press **TUNE/CLEAR**.

Program known frequencies

Refer to <u>www.radioreference.com</u> for a list of frequencies in your area.

- 1. Press PGM. *PGM* appears. Enter the channel number (1–200) where you want to store a frequency, then press **PGM** again.
- **2.** Use the number keys and \bullet to enter the frequency.
- **3.** Press **ENT** to store the frequency into the channel.
- 4. Press SCAN to begin scanning stored/programmed frequencies.
