IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using your Vacuum basic safety precautions should always be observed, including the followina:

- 1. Read all instructions before using your vacuum.
- 2. Use the system only for its intended use.
- To protect against a risk of electric shock, do 3. **not** immerse any part of the system in water or other liquids.
- 4. Never yank cord to disconnect from outlet; instead, grasp plug and pull to disconnect.
- 5. Do not allow cord to touch hot surfaces.
- Do not run appliance over cord. 6.
 - Do not operate the system with a damaged cord or plug, or if the appliance or any other . part of the system has been dropped or damaged. To avoid the risk of electric shock. do not disassemble or attempt to repair the vacuum. Return the system to EURO-PRO . **Operating LLC** (see warranty) for examination and repair. Incorrect re-assembly or repair can cause a risk of electrical shock or injury to persons when the vacuum is used.

- **Do not** pull cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord. or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Use only extension cords UL-rated or cUL at 15 amperes. Extension cords rated for less amperage may overheat. Care should be taken to arrange the cord so that the cord cannot be pulled or tripped over.
- Turn off all controls as applicable before unplugging from electrical outlet.
- **Do not** handle plug or vacuum with wet hands or operate without shoes.
- Do not put any objects into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked. Keep free of dust, lint, hair and anything else that may reduce air flow.
- Store your appliance indoors in a cool, dry area.
- Keep your work area well lit.
- ٠ Keep end of hose, wands and other openings away from your face and body.
- Use only on dry surfaces.


The filter is washable. It should, however, be replaced every three (3) to six (6) months to ensure peak performance of your vacuum.

Make sure that **THE** filter has been completely air dried for 24 hours before re-installing back in the vacuum.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Motor Thermostat

IMPORTANT: This unit is equipped with a motor protective thermostat. If for some reason the vacuum cleaner should overheat, the thermostat will automatically turn the unit off. Should this occur:

- Push the On/Off button once.
- Disconnect the plug from the power source.
- Check the source of overheating problem. (i.e. clogged hose or filter)

- If clogged hose or filter is found, unclog the hose and replace the filters.
- Wait at least 45 minutes before attempting to reuse the vacuum.
- After unit has cooled down for 45 minutes, plug in the cleaner and push the On/Off button. The vacuum should start again.
- If the vacuum still does not start, contact customer service at 1 (800) 798-7398.

IMPORTANT: If th

<u>NT</u>: If the suction opening in the unit or the nozzle is BLOCKED, switch off the vacuum cleaner and remove the blocking substance before you start the unit again.

1. **Do not** operate the vacuum cleaner too close to heaters, radiators or cigarette butts.



3. Before you start vacuuming, make sure to remove large or sharp objects that might damage the dust cup.






Inserting the Vacuum Handle into the Hand Vac

• Push down on the vacuum handle release button then insert the vacuum handle into the opening above the hand vac handle. (Fig. 1)

Handle Release Button



• To remove the vacuum handle, press down on the vacuum handle release button and pull the pole up while securely holding the hand vac handle. (Fig. 2)




Attaching the Floor Nozzle to the Hand Vac

- Insert the floor brush into the air intake opening.
- To remove the floor nozzle from the hand vac, pull the floor nozzle straight out from the hand vac. (Fig. 3)



Attaching the Crevice Brush to the Hand Vac

 Hold the end of the crevice brush. Insert the crevice brush into the air intake opening of the unit. (Fig. 4)



Winding & Unwinding the Power Cord


This unit is equipped with a convenient cord storage feature. The power cord winds around the two cord holders at the back of the unit. The top one has a quick cord release feature. Turn the cord holder to the left or the right to remove the power cord. (Fig. 6)

On/Off Switch

The On/Off switch has two different positions.

- Push on the "I" side to turn the vacuum ON.
- Push on the "O" side to turn the vacuum OFF.

Using the Unit as an Upright

- Ensure that the dust cup filter is installed in the dust cup container.
- Unwind the power cord and plug into the 120V outlet.
- Press the On/Off switch to the On position and vacuum.

Note: When vacuuming deep pile carpets or hard to vacuum carpets, lower the angle of the vacuum handle (see illustration at right) for easier maneuverability.

Important: Do

NOT use the

vacuum without the filter in place.

Using the Unit as a Hand Vacuum

- Ensure that the unit is unplugged before removing parts, or performing maintenance.
- Press the vacuum handle release button and pull handle to remove.
- Pull the floor nozzle out from the hand vac.
- Attach the crevice brush to the end of the hand vac if desired.
- Press the On/Off switch to the on position to vacuum.


Changing & Cleaning the Dust Cup Filter

To achieve the best performance, empty the dust cup container and clean the dust cup filter after each use.

 To remove the dust cup container, press down on the dust cup release button and pull off the dust cup container. (Fig. 7)



2. Empty the dust from the dust cup container. (Fig. 8)



3. Pull off the dust cup filter. (Fig. 9)



- 4. Rinse the dust cup filter in cold water, and then wait until it air dries completely before replacing it back into the dust cup container. **Do not** use a washing machine to clean the dust cup filter. **Do not** use a hair dryer to dry it. **Air dry only.**
- 5. Replace the dust cup filter carefully into the dust cup container. **NEVER** operate vacuum cleaner without dust cup filter in place.
- 6. Attach the dust cup container to the vacuum.

Note: It is recommended that the dust cup filter be replaced every three (3) to six (6) months to ensure peak performance of the unit.

Caution: The suction hole must be open and free of any obstructions at all times. Otherwise, the motor will overheat and could become damaged.
