

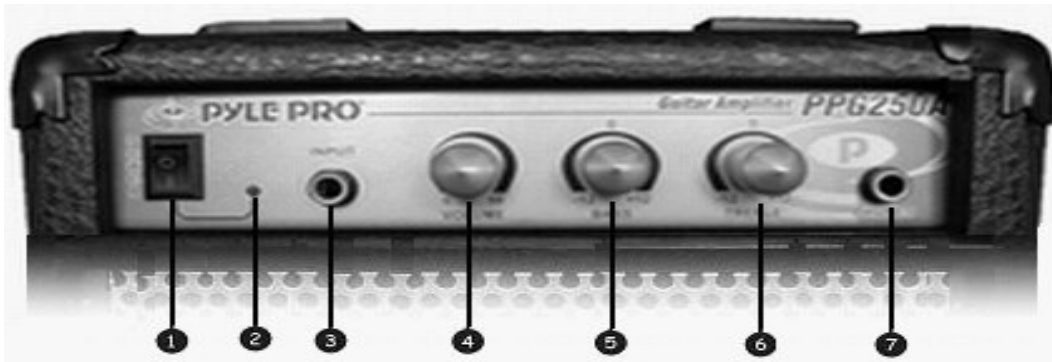

# PPG250A Guitar Amplifier



- 1) **Power Switch:** Switches amplifier on/off.
- 2) **Power LED:** Illuminates when power is switched on.
- 3) **Input Jack:** Connect your instrument to this jack.
- 4) **Volume:** This sets the volume gain level.
- 5) **Bass:** This control adjusts the low frequency level.
- 6) **Treble:** This control adjusts the high frequency level.
- 7) **Phones Jack:** This is your headphone connection. Inserting the headphones disables the internal speaker (great for practicing).



- 1) **Voltage Selector:** 110/220 Volt Selectable Switch.
- 2) **Power Cord:** Connect the included power cord here.

## Troubleshooting

### Distorted Sound:

- ✓ Check if the amplifier is overdriven. If it is, you will have to turn the level down.
- ✓ Check signal source.

### Signal sounds "discolored":

- ✓ Check and adjust the EQ settings.
- ✓ Ensure you are using quality cables.
- ✓ Check signal source.

### No Sound:

- ✓ Check connections.
- ✓ Try a different cable.
- ✓ Check level on amplifier.
- ✓ Confirm amplifier is getting a signal.
- ✓ Make sure nothing is plugged into the Phones jack.

### Intermittent Output:

- ✓ Check connections.
- ✓ Try a different cable.
