

**Batteries:** Insert as indicated two alkaline batteries, type R6, UM3 or AA. Remove the batteries if exhausted or if they are not to be used for a long time.

Mains adaptor: Connect a mains adaptor to the 3V DC socket. The adaptor must supply 3V DC  $\odot$   $\odot$ , minuspole  $\odot$  to the 1.3 mm centre pin of the 3.4 mm socket.

**Remarks:** If any digit in the display is missing or the display does not function at all, after changing the batteries, reset the display with a ballpen through the hole on the back of the set.

# **RADIO RECEPTION**

### 9/10 KHz switch for AM (=MW)

In North and South America the separation between two adjacent channels is 10 KHz, while in all other countries it is 9 KHz. The 9/10 KHz switch should therefore first be set in the correct position:

- 10 KHz if you are using the set in North and South America
- 9 KHz if you are using the set in any other country

## Radio

- Set RADIO/TAPE to RADIO.
- Connect headphones to n. The headphone lead will function as FM-aerial.
- · Select the wave band using AM/FM. The display shows 'FM' or 'AM'
- In case of FM, set FM ST/FM to the desired position.
- Tune automatically, manually or by means of the **PRESET** buttons to a radio station.
- Adjust the sound with VOLUME and DBB (bass).
- The set is switched off when RADIO/TAPE is in position TAPE and no cassette player button is pressed.

## Automatic tuning

- Keep TUNING ▲ or ▼ pressed until the frequency on display keeps on changing; then release the button.
- Tuning stops when a strong transmitter has been found.
- If the transmitter found is not the desired one, simply repeat this operation.

#### **Manual tuning**

Vanual tuning is useful when you already know the frequency of the ransmitter (e.g. from your programme guide).

- Keep TUNING ▲ or ▼ pressed.
- As soon as you approach the required frequency, stop tuning by briefly pressing the **TUNING** button.
- Then press briefly each time ▲ or ▼. In this way the frequency is changed step-by-step until finally the right frequency has been reached. One step is 0.05 MHz (50 kHz) on FM.

Telefred transmitters - PRESEI

The **PRESET** buttons allow you to store the frequencies of up to 10 ransmitters in the memory.

#### Storing transmitter frequencies

Select the wave band using AM/FM.

- Using **TUNING**  $\blacktriangle$   $\bigtriangledown$ , tune either automatically or manually to the frequency to be stored (as described above).
- To store the frequency shown, press STORE.
- Within 10 seconds, select the desired memory location using the PRESET buttons. For the preset locations '6'...'10', first press '+5' and after that one of the buttons '1'...'5'. The frequency is now stored in the memory. A stored frequency is only erased from the memory by storing another frequency in its place.

#### funing to a preselected transmitter

Press the desired PRESET button. For the preset locations '6'...'10', first press '+5' and after that one of the buttons '1'...'5'.

#### irasing the memory

Move the **9/10 KHz** switch to the other position and back again. The memory will now be erased and the **PRESET** stations will have to be reset.

# PLAYING BACK CASSETTES

- Set RADIO/TAPE to TAPE.
- Connect headphones to G.
- Open the cassette holder and insert the cassette in it with the open part facing the buttons.
- Set METAL-CrO<sub>2</sub>/NORMAL selector to:
- -METAL-CrO2 for CHROME (IEC II) or METAL (IEC VI) cassettes
- -NORMAL for NORMAL (IEC I) cassettes
- To start playback, press PLAY ◀►.
- During playback you can reverse the tape direction using < DIR►.</li>
- Adjust the sound with VOLUME and DBB (bass).
- To stop, press STOP and the set is switched off.

Fast Winding: Press FAST WIND ← or →. To stop, press STOP.

# AUTO REVERSE


 The tape direction will be automatically reversed whenever the player reaches the end of the tape. So the cassette is played continuously until you press STOP (or until the batteries are exhausted).

## MAINTENANCE

- Clean the magnetic head after every 50 hours of operation or, on average, once a month by playing through a cleaning cassette.
- Do not expose the set and cassettes to rain, moisture, sand, or to excessive heat from e.g. heating equipment or in motor cars parked in the sun.

The type number will be found at the bottom of the set and the serial number in the battery compartment.

This set complies with the radio interference requirements of the European Community.
