Function Keys

thes	Selects the thesaurus mode and goes to the ENTER a word screen. In a thesaurus entry, goes to the next entry.
lists	Shows the menu where you can choose to view the spelling bee word list, SAT ^{®*} word list or <i>My Word List</i> . From an active word, adds that word directly to <i>My Word List</i> .
timer	Opens the reading timer.
games	Shows the Games menu.
solver	Goes to the Crossword Solver screen.
back	Goes back or erases a typed letter.
help	Shows a help message.
? conf	Types a ? to stand for any letter. At a thesaurus entry, shows the Confusables [®] for a word. In games, ends a round.
delete	Types an * to stand for any series of

Types an ***** to stand for any series of letters. In games, gives a hint.

Key Guide

clear

Clears a search or stops the demo.

enter

Enters a word or scrolls to the right. **Navigation Key**



In lists, press up (▲) or down (▼) to scroll. At entry screens, press ▲ to type an apostrophe, ▼ to type a period, and right (►) or left (◄) to move the cursor. When the cursor is at the right-most position, press ► to type a space. At a clear ENTER a word screen, press ▲ or ▼ to adjust the screen contrast.

✓ Help is Always at Hand

You can view an appropriate help message at any screen by pressing **HELP**. To go back to the previous screen, press **BACK**.

✓ Follow the Arrows

The flashing arrows at the right of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to view more words.

✓ About Automatic Shutoff

If you forget to turn off this product, it will automatically turn off in about two minutes. When you turn it on again, operation resumes with your current settings.

Installing the Batteries

This unit uses 2 AAA batteries. You must insert the batteries before getting started. The batteries should be changed when the screen contrast is too light even after adjustment. Please have a small Phillips screwdriver at hand before you follow the steps below.

- 1. Turn the unit off and turn it over.
- 2. Unscrew the back cover and slide it off in the indicated direction.
- 3. Install the new batteries following the markings in the compartment.
- 4. Replace the back cover.

Warning! If the batteries wear out completely, or if you take more than a few seconds while changing the batteries, any user entered information may be erased. You should always keep written copies of your important information.

Battery disposal: Do not dispose of batteries with normal household waste. Please obey your local regulations when disposing of used batteries.

Battery Precautions

Viewing a Demonstration

Unless disabled, a demonstration automatically appears when you turn on this unit.

1. Press 🙂.

2. To stop the demonstration, press CLEAR.

To Disable or Re-enable the Demo

- 1. Press CLEAR.
- 2. Press THES.
- 3. Type **d.
- 4. Press ENTER.
- 5. To re-enable the demonstration, repeat the above steps.
- ✓ To Adjust the Screen Contrast
 - 1. Press CLEAR.
 - 2. Press THES.
 - At the ENTER a word screen, use ▲ or ▼ to lighten or darken the screen contrast.

Note: You can adjust the screen contrast only when "ENTER a word" is on the screen.

To Check the Spelling of a Word

- 1. Type a word or misspelling at the ENTER a word screen.
- 2. Press ENTER.

If the word is spelled correctly, you see the message *Correct word*. If the word is spelled correctly and has a thesaurus entry, the entry is displayed. If the word is spelled correctly except for capital letters or accents, you see the message *Attention* followed by the correct form of the word. If the word is misspelled, a list of possible corrections is displayed. A flashing *T* to the right indicates that the word has at least one thesaurus entry. A flashing *?* to the right indicates that the word has Confusables.

- 3. Press ▼ to view more corrections.
- 4. Press ▲ to scroll up.
- 5. Press ENTER to see a word's thesaurus entry.
- 6. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Finding Thesaurus Entries

Most thesaurus entries include a brief definition and a related list of available synonyms, antonyms and ClassmatesTM (words related by subject). **Note:** If a word has no thesaurus entry, *Correct word* appears and then the word is displayed on the screen.

Note: You can see the thesaurus entry (if any) of a word on the screen by pressing **ENTER**.

- 1. Press THES.
- 2. Type a word. For example, type fond. To delete letters, use BACK. To type a space, press ►. To edit a word, press ◄ and then type to insert characters.

Press \checkmark to type a period or \blacktriangle to type an apostrophe. **Note**: You cannot begin a word with a punctuation mark or space.

3. Press ENTER.

Note: If the text is too long to fit on the screen, press ENTER or ► to see it all. A flashing ? to the right indicates that the word has Confusables.

- 4. Press ▼ repeatedly to view any synonyms, antonyms and Classmates.
- 5. To go to the next thesaurus entry, if any, press THES.

To go to the previous thesaurus entry, if any, press **BACK**.

6. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Viewing Confusables®

Confusables are words such as homonyms and spelling variants that people often confuse. When you see a flashing question mark to the right of a word, that word has Confusables. Try this example.

- 1. Press CLEAR.
- 2. Press THES.
- **3. Type blue and then press ENTER.** A flashing question mark appears to the right of the screen.
- 4. Press ?.

Each Confusable is followed by a word that explains its meaning.

- 5. Press \triangledown or \blacktriangle to view the Confusables.
- 6. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Finding Parts of Words

You can find parts of words by typing question marks and asterisks in place of letters. Each question mark stands for any single letter. Each asterisk stands for any series of letters. You can use question marks to help solve crossword puzzles and similar word games by typing them in place of missing letters.

- 1. Press THES.
- 2. Type a word with ?s and *s in it. For example, con?er*.
- 3. Press ENTER.

A *T* next to a word indicates that the word has a thesaurus entry. A ? next to a word indicates that the word has Confusables.

- 4. Press ▼ repeatedly to view more words.
- 5. To see a word's thesaurus entry, if any, press ENTER.

If a word has more than one entry, press **THES** to see additional meanings.

6. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Using the Reading Timer

The *Spelling Ace® Pro* includes a timer which you can use to time your reading and other homework assignments.

1. Press TIMER.

A clock is displayed.

2. Press ▼ or ▲ until you set the time you want.

You can set hours and minutes. The hours field is flashing. Press \blacktriangleright or \blacktriangleleft to move between the hours and minutes fields. You can also type the time you want. The **Q-P** keys input numbers. For example, press \blacktriangleright , **E** and then **P** to set *30* minutes.

3. Press ENTER.

The count mode menu is displayed.

- 4. Press ▼ or ▲ until you see Count Up or Count Down, then press ENTER. The timer begins counting up or counting down, depending on what you selected. The timer makes a sound to alert you when time is up. Press any key to stop it.
- 5. Press CLEAR to stop the timer.

You are asked to confirm that you want the timer to stop.

6. Press Y to stop the timer or press N to continue.

SAT Word List

The Spelling Ace[®] Pro includes a SAT word list which is a list of words used in the Scholastic Aptitude Test.

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see SAT Word List.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. To look up a word, begin typing the letters of the one you want. For example, type col to see the word *collaborate*.
- 5. Press ENTER or THES to see the thesaurus entry for the word, if available.

Bee List

The Spelling Ace[®] Pro also includes the Bee list, which is a list of words you might find in a spelling bee.

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see Bee List.
- 3. Press ENTER.

A list of skill levels is displayed.

- 4. Press ▼ or ▲ until you see the skill level you want, then press ENTER.
- 5. To look up a word, begin typing the letters of the one you want. For example, in the *Wizard* skill level, type lie to see the word *lieutenant*.
- 6. Press ENTER or THES to see the thesaurus entry for the word, if available.

Using My Word List

My Word List can contain up to 40 words of your choice for study or review.

To Add a Word to the List

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see My Word List.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Press ▼ until you see Add a word.
- 5. Press ENTER.
- 6. Type the word you want to add.
- 7. Press ENTER to add the word.

If you typed a word that is not in the *Spelling Ace*[®] *Pro*, you will see *Add anyway* (Y/N)?. Press **Y** to add the word or **N** to cancel.

8. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

To View Your List

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see My Word List.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Press ▲ until you you see View list.
- 5. Press ENTER.

6. Press \blacksquare or \blacktriangle to view the words in your list.

A *T* next to a word indicates that the word has a thesaurus entry. A ? next to a word indicates that the word has Confusables.

Adding Words from the ENTER a word Screen

1. Type a word at the ENTER a word screen and press LISTS.

Add: "your word" is displayed.

2. Press ENTER.

To Delete a Word From the List

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see My Word List.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Press ▼ until you see Delete a word.
- 5. Press ENTER.
- 6. Press ▼ to choose the word you want to delete, if needed.
- 7. Press ENTER to delete the word.

To Erase the Entire List

- 1. Press LISTS.
- 2. Press ▼ until you see My Word List.
- 3. Press ENTER.
- 4. Press ▼ until you see Erase list.
- 5. Press ENTER.
- 6. Press Y to erase the list, or press N to cancel.

Using the Crossword Solver

You Spelling Ace® Pro also comes with a crossword solver.

- 1. Press SOLVER.
- 2. Type a pattern of letters and blanks. For example, type ?c?o???.

Type ? in place of any single missing letter. Type * in place of any series of letters.

3. Press ENTER.

The list of words that match the pattern is displayed.

- 4. Press ▼ repeatedly to view the list.
- 5. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Having Fun with Spanish and French

Have fun learning Spanish and French by reading the list of helpful phrases.

- 1. Press GAMES.
- 2. Press ▼ or ▲ until you see Fun with Spanish or Fun with French and then press ENTER.
- Press ▼ or ▲ to scroll through the list of English phrases and press ENTER when the one you want is highlighted.

The Spanish or French translation is displayed, depending on which list you picked.

Press $\mathbf{\nabla}$ or \mathbf{A} to see the entire message, if necessary.

4. Press CLEAR when you are finished.

Playing the Games

To Choose a Game

- 1. Press GAMES.
- 2. Use ▼ or ▲ until you see the game you want and then press ENTER.

To Choose the Skill Level

You can play the games at skill levels from Beginner to Wizard.

- 1. Press GAMES.
- 2. Press ▼ or ▲ until you see Set Skill Level and then press ENTER.
- Use ▼ or ▲ to see the skill level that you want and then press ENTER to select it. Press BACK to leave the skill level unchanged.

To Choose the Game Words

- 1. Press GAMES.
- 2. Use ▼ or ▲ until you see Set Game Words and then press ENTER.
- **3. Select one of the following:** *All words* to use random spelling and thesaurus words.

SAT words to use words from the SAT word list. Bee List to use words from the Bee List. My Word List to use words from My Word List. Enter your own to use words that you enter before each round.

✓ Understanding the Skill Levels

Depending on the game, the skill levels change the level of difficulty, the number of guesses, or the minimum number of letters in a word.

✓ Getting Help in the Games

During any game you can read instructions by pressing **HELP**. You can get a hint by pressing ***** or reveal the game word by pressing **?**. **Note**: If you reveal the game word, you lose the round.

Hangman

Hangman challenges you to guess mystery words one letter at a time. Each letter is hidden by a question mark. The number of wrong guesses appears at the right of the screen. Press **ENTER** or ***** to reveal a letter.

Anagrams

Anagrams asks you to form a word from the letters of another word. Each anagram must be the minimum size (number of letters) that flashes before each round. Each letter can be used only as many times as it already appears. Any remaining anagrams are displayed. Type an anagram and press **ENTER**. Use ▼ or ▲ to view the anagrams you have entered. Press ***** to jumble the letters.

Word Jumble

Word Jumble tests your skill at unscrambling letters. Unlike Anagrams, each letter needs to be used. The number to the right of the letters shows how many words can be made with the letters in order to win. Type your answer and press **ENTER**. To re-jumble the letters, press *****.

Word Builder (Scrabble® game referee)

Word Builder can help you solve Scrabble[®] and similar word games. Just type a series of letters (or a word) and then press **ENTER**. The number of how many (other) words can be made from your letters (or word) flashes on the screen and then the list is displayed. Use ▼ and ▲ to view the words built from the letters you entered.

Word Blaster

In *Word Blaster*, you try to guess a mystery word. A series of underlines appear and then letters begin to fill in. Press **ENTER** before the word is fully spelled. Type in a guess. If the guess is correct you win. A wrong answer prompts you to try again.

Word Train

In *Word Train*, you and the train take turns typing letters to form a word. Whoever types the last letter wins! Type any letter to start a word. Continue typing letters alternately with the train until a word is formed. To start a new round, press **ENTER**.

Deduction

Deduction displays a mystery pattern represented by the four question marks. To make a guess, type any letters (a-z) in a pattern then press **ENTER**. A letter can be used more than once. After entering your guess, a scorecard appears showing the number of correct letters perfectly located (P) or misplaced (M).

Press ▼ to return to the mystery pattern or type another guess. Press ▲ and ▼ to scroll through your previous guesses. Guess the pattern and you win!

Spelling Bee

Spelling Bee flashes words on the screen for you to try to spell. Just type the word that appeared, trying to spell it correctly, and press ENTER. If you do not spell it correctly, you lose the round.
