2. Insert one battery (CR 2025) making sure the polarity (+ *I* -) matches the marks inside the unit.
3. Replace the cover.
Do not attempt to recharge, short-circuit, disassemble, heat or throw the batteries into the fire.

Using AC Adapter for Player
Insert the DC plug at the end of the adapter cord into the DC IN jack at the right side of the player. Then plug the other end into an AC wall outlet.

This unit has a 20 track programmable memory that allows you to program up to 20 tracks on any disc for playback in any desired order. You may program 20 different tracks or you may also program certain tracks to play more than once. To perform programmed playback, proceed as follows:

1. While in the Stop mode, press the PROGRAM button, the Program menu will appear on the TV


