5. **⏭ :** Press to skip to the next title/chapter/track/picture.

6. **AV OUT:** Audio and Video output.
7. **USB HOST:** Connect the USB cable frame the DPF player.
8. **MS CARD/SD/MMC/XD:** Insert MS/SD/MMC/XD card.
9. **DCIN:** Insert the DC power adaptor to the DPF player.

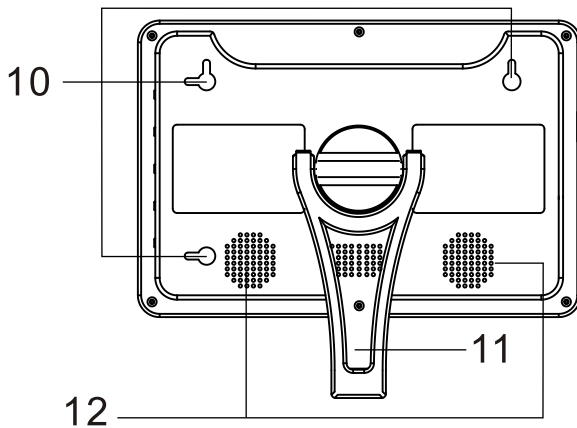

Slide Show:

Press **SLIDE SHOW** to continually cycle through all of the pictures in the device.

Step Show:

Press **STEP SHOW** to display a single picture; each press will advance one picture at a time.

Note: The SLIDE SHOW and STEP SHOW keys will only be valid when a memory card insert in the DPF.

Note: Remove Red Tab to activate battery.

Navigation Buttons:

MENU:

Press **MENU** to return to the main menu.

VOL+/-:

Press the **VOLUME** button to adjust the player's volume.

3. Slide the Power switch to power on, then the product will turn on.

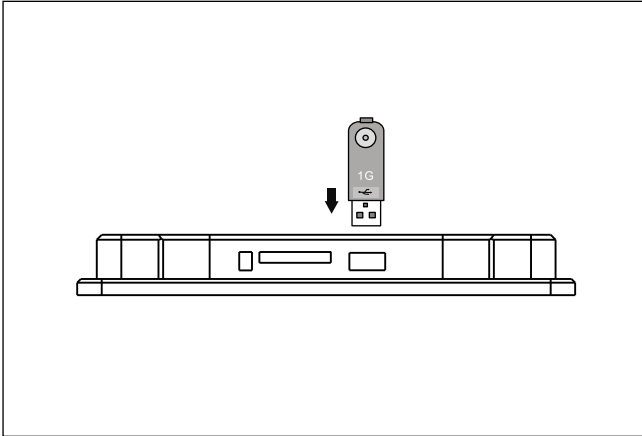
Note: When the product is on, this frame can only recognize one of the external device.

USB: Insert various USB portable flash driver as an extra source.



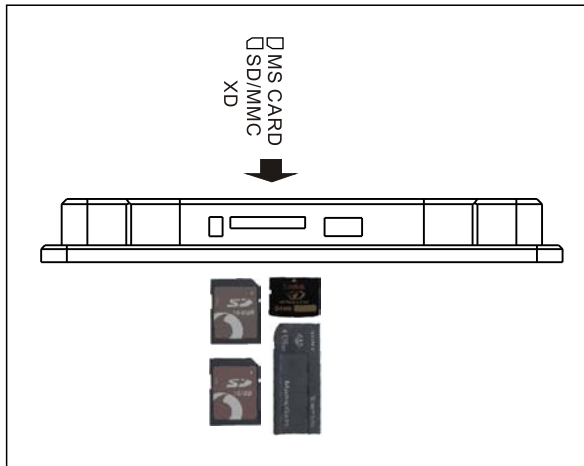

Memory Card insertion

When inserting a memory card into the product, refer to the image to make sure that both the memory card and product are aligned correctly. (The side of the memory card on which the sticker is affixed should face to the front)

Aligning the memory card upside down or to the reverse side may cause damage that is the sole responsibility of the user. (Use SD, Memory Stick, MMC cards, XD card enabled)



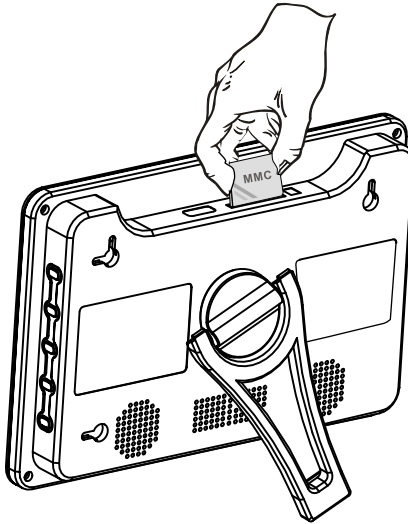
- Note:**
1. MS Duo isn't compatible alone. But it can be supported with the help of MS Duo adapter.
 2. It is recommended that a full format be performed before using a memory card for the first time.
 3. It is recommended that you do not insert a memory card and extra USB memory together at the same time. Otherwise, the device will read USB first, and will not recognise the card .

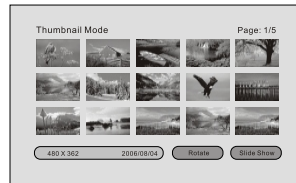
Photo

Select a photograph to view in full size on the frame from the selection of thumbnail images.

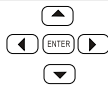
Enter into the Photo List

Press MENU to enter the main menu ,select PHOTO to enter into Thumbnail Mode.

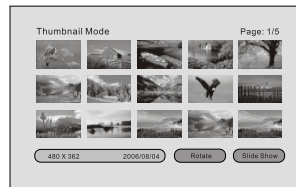
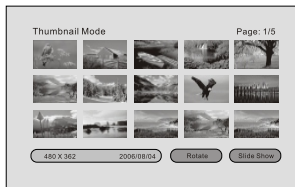
Note: please set up the photo browser on Thumbnail mode first. Then enter into thumbnail mode when pressing the photo button.

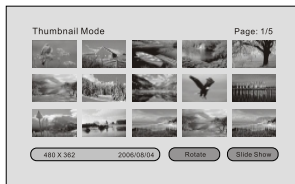

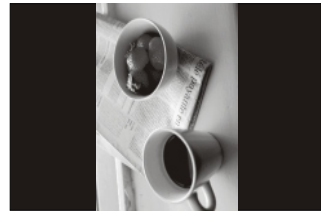

During photo playing mode , press the **ROTATE** button to rotate(clockwise) the photo to the desired position.



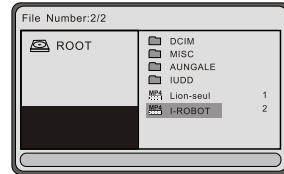

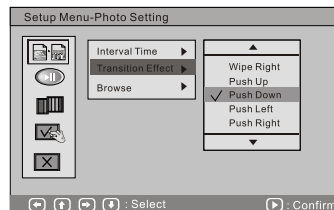
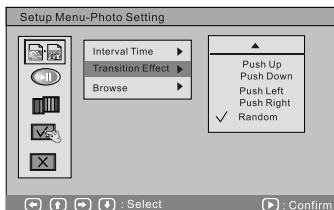
Set the time the image remains on the screen in slide show mode. The interval time can be set to 5 seconds/10 seconds/15 seconds .

You can directly set the picture display effect (Cover up/down/left/right, Uncover up/down/left/right, Wipe up/down/left/right, Push up/down/left/right, random)



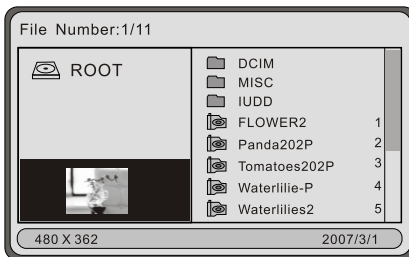
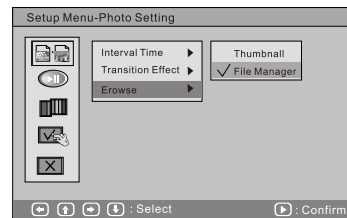
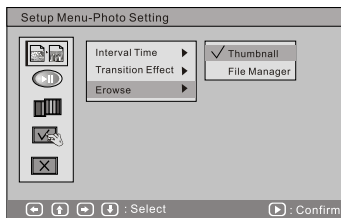

Delete

Note: Pictures deleted cannot be recovered. Thinking over carefully before you confirm to delete.

Using directional keys to select EDIT item in main menu, and press ENTER button to enter into edit mode. Then using directional keys to Delete item in Edit Dialog, and press ENTER button to enter into file list.

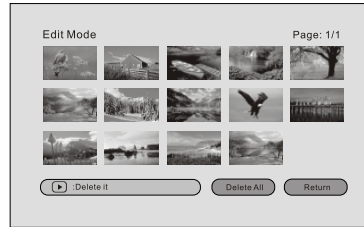
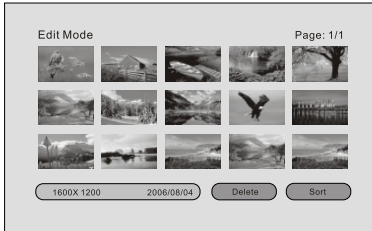

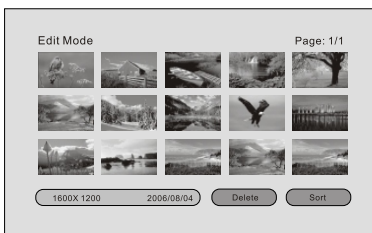

Q&A

This chapter will attempt to troubleshoot common problems that one may experience with the Multimedia DPF. If this guide does not solve your problem, do not dismantle the machine yourself.

Question	Answer
What memory cards are compatible with the digital frame?	Secure Digital Card (SD)/MultiMedia Card (MMC)/XD/ Memory Stick.
Dose Multimedia Digital Photo Frame have built-in memory?	Yes. The player has an internal memory to store media file. You can store 15 pictures at most.
What is the best picture resolution displayed on the screen?	The player's best resolution is 480 X 234.
Can I rotate a picture on the screen?	Yes. Use the ROTATE button on the remote control to rotate a picture. Note: The rotated picture will return to its original orientation after you power off the digital frame.
Can I adjust the colors of the picture?	No. All color settings are preset at the factory. You can only adjust the brightness and contrast of the screen.
Why Digital picture Frame does not advance to next picture?	1. There is only one picture in the frame. 2. You are viewing high-resolution pictures on the card, High-resolution pictures can take some to display. 3. You are in single picture display. 4. The next picture is damaged.
Why is only 15 pictures displayed?	Use the NEXT button to see next 15 pictures thumbnail.
Why picture display seems slow?	You are viewing high-resolution pictures, high-resolution pictures can take some time to display.
Why Digital Picture Frame doesn't display any pictures?	Make sure your memory card is inserted properly and that the pictures on it are in JPEG format. Pictures may be saved in a DCIM folder. Make sure that you have selected the "PHOTO" icon in main menu.
Why the video out is abnormal?	Make sure AV-out cable is plugged ok . Make sure the TV mode of AV-output is the same as TV's.
Can't I see the file list?	You are in thumbnail mode. Please set setup Menu-Photo Setting. Browse item to File Manger.
Can't the product read the card?	Make sure you have inserted the USB portable flash driver.

No power

Ensure the power button is on
Ensure the power cord is not damaged

can not read WMA music

this unit only supports WMA with a bit rate: 32Kbps - 192 bps,

Could not read the card

1. Please copy the content in your card to your PC, then format your card, then past your photos/mosaic/movies in your card again, then insert the card to DPF to read it.
2. Ensure the card is not damaged
3. Ensure the card is connected to the DPF correctly
4. Ensure the card has content(photo/music/movie), if no content in card, the screen will display "no playable file"
5. Do not insert your card and USB together at same time. Otherwise one of device can not be recognized

Could not read the USB portable flash driver

Remote control not working

1. Ensure the batteries are inserted
2. Ensure the batteries "protective plastic" is pulled out.
