The Phone Filters comply with part 68 of the FCC Rules. On the back of this equipment is a designator that contains the FCC registration number and ringer equivalence for this equipment. If requested, this information must be provided to the telephone company. The equipment uses the following standard connections and codes: USOC-RJ-11.

The Phone Filters also comply with part 1950 of the UL certifications, and part 22.2 of the CSA certifications.

The Ringer Equivalence Number (REN) shown on the filter is used to determine the quantity of devices which may be connected to the telephone line. Excessive RENs on the telephone line may result in another device not ringling in response to an incoming call. The sum of the RENs should not exceed (5). To be certain of the number of devices that may be connected to a line, as determined by the total RENs, contact the local telephone company.

If the equipment causes harm to the telephone network, the telephone company will notify you in advance that temporary discontinuance of service may be required. But if advance notice is not practical, the telephone company will notify the customer as soon as possible. Also, you will be advised of your right to file a complaint with the FCC if you believe it is necessary.

The telephone company may make changes in its facilities, equipment, operations or procedures that could affect the operation of the equipment. If this happers the telephone company will provide advance notice in order for you to make necessary modifications to maintain uninterrupted service.

If the equipment is causing harm to the telephone network, the telephone company may request that you disconnect the equipment until the problem is resolved.

The equipment cannot be used on public coin phone service provided by the telephone company. Connection to party lines is subject to state tariffs. (contact the state public utility commission, public service commission or corporation commission for information).






Installing the StormPort Modem is easy!





Connect the StormPort power supply.






Note: You can also connect to two (2) computers, one (1) on the USB port and one (1) on the Ethernet port.
