





Your demo model must be installed using the following manual fill method.


Place the Unit into position on the sales floor, preferably on an end cap next to a Whirlpool 3-Speed washer.



With pliers, remove the yellow plug at the base of the washer in the back. The plug must be completely removed for the self-leveling legs to be released.




Insert leveling legs into correct holes at each front corner of washer until nuts touch washer. Do not tighten nuts until step 6.




Tilt washer forward, raising back legs 1" off of floor to adjust rear self-leveling legs. Gently lower washer to floor.

floor to adjust rear self-leveling legs. Gently lower washer to floor. Check levelness of the washer by placing a carpenter's level on the top of the washer, first




side to side; then front to back.


If washer is not level, screw the front legs up or down to adjust and repeat step 4.




Once the washer is level, use wrench to turn nuts on front legs up tightly against washer base. If nuts are not tight against washer base, the washer may vibrate.



Verify that the drain plug is secured in the drain port as shown.




Manually fill the basket (using a bucket or garden hose) with 20-23 gallons of water (A). Fill to top of gasket on basket. Set the Water Options dial to "Without Water." (B)\*




<sup>\*</sup> If you are running the demonstration model without any water at all, you must add at least 1 pint of water to the basket for proper operation. Check regularly for evaporation and repeat as needed.


Push the Timer dial in (Washer is now in OFF position)




With a screwdriver, turn the Drain / Agitate Switch on the back of the washer to "Agitate"



Load the 200 colored chips into the machine. (See Page 1 for how to order your free demo swatches.)








Plug-in the unit using a 20 amp 3-pronged, electrically grounded extension cord not longer than 50 feet.




Turn the lights on with the Light rocker switch on the back of the machine.

Pull the timer on.







# **To Drain Unit**


Water may be siphoned into a drain or 25-gallon container

on wheels.


To change from plug to drain hose, turn machine off and put option dial to "One Speed Continuous" (A). Turn the timer dial to HIGH speed (B).



With a screwdriver turn the Drain/Agitate switch to "Agitate" and turn the machine on.



While machine is agitating, remove plug cap and put drain hose on.
Some water may drip out or spill. Turn machine
OFF and turn
Drain/Agitate switch to
DRAIN. Direct a drain



hose into a drain (or a 25-30 gallon trash container with wheels also works).

### **Demonstration Tip**

Only use the poly-cotton swatches provided by Whirlpool Fulfillment in your demonstrations. These poly-cotton swatches have been tested to sustain many hours of agitator demonstrations. Other fabrics, when left standing in water, or agitating for long periods of time, will become mildewed and weak, as well as cause the water to cloud.

# Care for the See-Through Washer

- Keep the viewing glass clean by wiping down with a soft cotton cloth.
   DO NOT USE PAPER TOWELS. THEY WILL SCRATCH THE SURFACE.
- It is important to keep the water in the demonstration model clean and clear for the best visibility inside the washer. When you notice the water is becoming cloudy or dirty, it is time to change the water.
- Limited contact with the water helps keep it cleaner longer. The Point-of-Sale piece that lays on the washer-top is intended to help keep customers from opening the lid.

#### **Demonstration Tip**

For the cleanest water and most effective demonstration, change the water inside the washer once or twice a month. Frequency of water changes will be determined by the type of water in your city.

# **Operating Instructions**

You and your customers have three demonstration options to choose from



All Speeds Continuous – preferred operation mode

- Set Demonstrations Options dial to "All Speeds Continuous"
- Pull Timer on




All Speeds Once – demonstrate each mode once

- Set Demonstrations Options dial to "All Speeds Once"
- Pull Timer on (will operate until timer reaches OFF position)
- Push to start or restart



One Speed Continuous – demonstrate one mode only


- Set Demonstrations Options dial to "One Speed Continuous"
- Set Timer dial to desired demonstration speed High, Low, Extra Low, Hand Washables
- Pull timer on




#### **Demonstration Tip**

If you are running the demonstration unit non-stop for more than 4 hours, set the Options Dial to "All Speeds Continuous."


