




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Assemble Base Halves around the cord. Refer to Fig 3.
- 2. Secure assembled base to the Fan Housing with two 5.
- 3. Secure Power Cord as shown in Fig 4 & 5.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Set the fan on a dry level surface.
- Plug cord into any standard 120V AC outlet.
- 3. To turn the fan on, press the desired SPEED button « I II III » on the Control Panel.
- 4. To oscillate the fan head, press the OSCILLATION button « > » on the Control Panel. Press a second time to stop oscillation. To turn the fan off, push the off button « **O** ».
- To activate the timer feature turn the Timer Control « ① » clockwise to vour desired duration (0-120 minutes). For continuous running turn the Timer Control « ① » to « I ». To turn the fan off, turn the Timer Control « ① » to « **O** » or push the off button « O » on the control panel.


