√ Follow the Arrows

The arrows at the right of the screen show which arrow keys you can press to view more.

Changing Languages

The massage language is the language of entry screams, help information, part-of-speech labels, and other messages. The entry language is the language in which you enter words at entry screams.

- ► To Change the Message Language 1. Press MENÜ.
- Press B to highlight Message Language and then press EINGABE.
 Or go to the menu and press E/D.
- ▶ To Change the Entry Language

- Press E/D repeatedly.
 The entry screen toggles between the German and English dictionaries.

✓ If You Misspell a Word

Don't worry, you will automatically go to a list of corrections. Press 3 to highlight a correction and then press EINGABE to see its translation.

Finding Translations

To translate words, simply enter them at the appropriate entry screen (German or English).

✓ Accepting & Capitalising Letters

You do not need to type accents or capitals in words. (If you enter a word without its accent or capital letter, you will go to a list of the multiple forms of the word.)

If you want to type an accent or capital, first type the letter to be accented or capitalised and then repeatedly press to until the desired result acceurs.

Selecting from Translations

Another way to find a translation is by highlighting a word while in a translation. You can only select words that have dictionary entries. Try this example:

- 1. Type a word.
- 2. Press EINGABE to go to its translation.
- Notice the highlight. You can turn off highlight by pressing ZURÜCK.
- Press the arrow keys to highlight a word you want to look up.
- 5. Press EINGABE to go to its

✓ Understanding Definitions

Definitions include part-of-speech labels in rounded brackets. Words in squared brackets signify specialised usages.

Finding Phrases

You can find German or English phrases by typing any keyword in a phrase. For example, typing find will show to find favor with somebody, find out, and more. You can pease MENU and search the list, or you can type a keyword at the entry acresor.

- Searching the Phrase List
 Press MENU.
- Highlight German Phrases or English Phrases.

 - Start typing a word in a phrase.

✓ Seeing a Whole Phrase

√ Selecting Multiple Forms

Some words have more than one spelling or part of speach. When you try to view the translations or inflections of these words, a list of the different forms appears. Highlight the word you want to view and then press EINGABE.

Finding Inflections

You can view inflections of nouns, verbs, and modifiers. If you need grammar guidance for the many verb inflections, press HILPE while in an inflection to read all about how to use that particular inflected form.

- 1. Type a word.
- 2. Press FLEKT.
- Proce the arrow keys to view the
 - inflections.

 4. If the word is a verb, press FI FKT
 - repeatedly to view another tense.
 - Press HLFE at verb inflections to view descriptions of the inflections as well as usage examples.

√ Tips for Viewing Inflections

 Press FLEKT at definitions to view th inflections of the word you looked up.

 Highlight a word in a definition and then press FLEKT to view its inflections.

Finding Letters in Words

If you are not sure how to spell a word, type a question mark in place of each unknown letter, or an # in place of any number of letters.

To type an #, press 💬 and then press 🕦

Type a word with 7's in place of unknown letters (e.g., at the German entry screen: h7ng/6.
