





#### STANDARD INSTALLATION


■ The TV can be installed in various ways such as on a wall, or on a desktop etc.





■The TV is designed to be mounted horizontally.

Ensure that you connect the earth ground wire to prevent possible electric shock. if grounding methods are not possible, have a qualified electrician install a separate circuit breaker.



Do not try to ground the unit by connceting it to telephone wires, lightening rods or gas pipes.

# a. Desktop Pedestal Installation


This is the default installation way of the TV.


#### b. Wall Mount: Horizontal installation

(1) Secure the wall brackets with the bolts(not provided as parts of the product, must purchase separately) on the wall. Match the height of the bracket that is mounted on the wall. The wall bracket is of nomal dimension. Please see the position of the wall brackets bolts as follow picture. The actual dimension of the wall brackts bolt should according to the products.







(2) Remove the table stand of the TV when install the TV on a wall as follow:




(3) For proper ventilation, allow a clearance of 10" on each side from the wall.






# **NOTES OF WALL INSTALLATION**

- (3) Don't cover the TV with curtain or paper.
- (4) Leave ventilation space to avoid the following:




# Top panel diagram

- 6. VGA Input:PC analog signal input
- 7. YPbPr: Color difference components input and relevant video input
- 8. **S-VIDEO:** Color and brightness difference components input.
- 9. AV Output
- 10.VGA/AUDIO: VGA audio input.


- 11. **EARPHONE** Output (3.5mm)
- 12. **ANT 75 ohm:** Connect the antenna to the antenna input.
- 13. **HDMI Input:** Digital signal input from HDMI video connector
- 14/15. **VIDEO/R/L**1/2: external AV signal input and relevant right/left sound channel.
- POWER(DC IN) Connect to Mains Adapter

# **Remote Controller**

- 1 **POWER**: Sets your TV to power on or standby mode.
- ② **MUTE**: Press to mute the sound. Press again or press VOL+ to unmute.
- ③ 0--9 Press 0~9 to select a TV channel directly while watching TV. The channel will change after 2 seconds. Applicable for entering page number in teletext mode and so on.
- (4) Return to the previously viewed program.
- (5) **CH +/-:** Press to scan through or to select a channel.
- (6) V +/-: Press to increase / decrease the sound level.
- 7 /- Press this button to enter a program number for different digit. eg. -/ - / ---
- (8) **DISPLAY**: Press to display the source and channel's info.
- (9) (**△**/ **▼**/ **◄** / **▶**/ENTER )

Allows you to navigate the on-screen menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.

- (10) **SOURCE**: Press to list the source items.
- (1) SLEEP: Select amount of time before TV turn itself off automatically.
- (2) EXIT: Exits from the menu or sub-menu and menus and adjust the system settings to your preference.
- (3) **MENU**: Allows you to navigate the on-screen menus.
- P.MODE: : Press to cycle through the different picture settings
- MTS: Press to select the MTS mode.(for example,Nicam, BTSC,MONO,STEREO .eg)
- (6) S.MODE: Press to cycle through the different sound settings.


#### **Battery Installation:**

Remove the battery compartment lid on the rear of the remote control by sliding the lid down, then off. Put two AAA batteries inside the battery compartment with their + and - ends aligned as indicated. Do not mix old and new batteries or different types of batteries Replace the battery compartment lid. Slide the lid until you hear it click into place.

### **Using the Remote Control:**

Unless stated otherwise, the remote control can operate all the features of the TV. Always point the remote control directly at the remote sensor in the front of the TV.

# Install and connect TV





#### Set your TV

To put your TV in a firm place which can bear the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please don't expose the TV near water or heating place (such as light, candle, heating machine), do not block the ventilation at the back of TV.

#### **Connect Antenna and power**





#### Turn On TV

3. Press the power button of the TV the indication light will turn to green. If the indicator is in standby mode (thelight is red), press the power button on the remote control or top of the TV.

**NOTE** Picture for reference purposes only.

#### **Description of Operation**

#### 1. Power on/off

After power is connected, press power on/off button, and the power indicator will be on; if the indicator is red, it indicates that the TV set is in the standby state. Press "Power" button on the remote control, and the power indicator will turn green, so the TV set is on. Please disconnect power supply before leaving the TV out of use for an extended period of time.

Note:

- (1) In the TV signal mode, when there is no signal for 5 minutes or more, the TV set will automatically access the standby state. If restart is required, please press "power" button or CH " $\nabla/\Delta$ " button on the remote control.
  - (2) Try not to repeat switching on/off the unit repeatedly within a short time.

#### 2. Input switching

Press "Source" button to select the input signal with the switching sequence as TV - AV (AV1 - AV2) - S-VIDEO - YPBPR - HDMI - PC

#### 3. Volume control

Press the functional buttons on the panel or "VOL▲ or VOL▼" button on the remote control to increase or decrease Volume. The volume control menu will be displayed on the screen.

#### 4. Mute

Press "Mute" button on the remote control to switch off sound, and the mute mark will be displayed on the screen; press "MUTE" button or VOL ▲ button once again to cancel mute.

#### 5. Screen display of input signals

Press "DISPLAY" button on the remote control, and the current input signals will be displayed on the screen. In several seconds, such display information will disappear automatically.

#### 6. Sleep timer

Press "SLEEP" button on the remote control to be able to set the waiting time for the TV set to automatically turn to the standby state. The current sleep time will be displayed on the screen (unit: minute); to repeatedly press "SLEEP" button, you can select different times, with the switching sequence as:

#### 7. Picture mode

Press "P.MODE" picture mode button on the remote control to be able to select from different picture modes, at the sequence of Normal – Soft – Dynamic – User.

#### 8. Fast review

While watching TV, press "RECALL" button on the remote control to be able to return to the TV program you previously watched. If you select no other program after the unit is switched on, it will be invalid to press this button.

#### 9. Operation menu

This TV set allows you to adjust any settings by selecting from the menu screens. *Menu button* 



Press this button to display main menu, including **Picture**, **Sound**, **OSD**, **Function**, **Channel** menu. You can select them by pressing the "◀ / ▶" buttons, and enter the submenu by pressing "▲ / ▼" key. The selected item will change to highlight colour. Press Menu to exit sub-menu.

#### Picture menu




When the source input is "TV", "AV", "S-Video", "YPbPr", or "HDMI", the **Picture** menu appears . You can choose **Contrast,Brightness,Tint**, **Sharpness** and **Tint**(in NTSC system) items by pressing "▲/▼" Buttons. You can adjust the item selected by pressing "◄/▶".

In **Color Temp.** item: you can switch between items as "Normal", "Warm", "Cool"

In ASPECT item: you can choose "16:9", "4:3".

In **PICTURE MODE** item: you can choose "Normal", "Soft", "Dynamic", "User".

#### SOUND



Enter this menu, you can select **Bass, Treble, Balance, Sound Mode** and **AVC** items by pressing

"▲ / ▼" Buttons. you can adjust the item selected by pressing "◄/▶".

In **Sound Mode** item: you can switch between items as following.

Normal-----News-----Music-----User

In **AVC** item: you can switch between On and Off.

#### Osd menu



Enter this menu, you can select OSD Language, OSD H-Position / OSD V-Position and Duration items by pressing "▲ / ▼" buttons.

**Language** item: You can select different language displayed on OSD.

**H-position** item: Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the OSD Horizontal position.

**V-position** item: Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the OSD Vertical position.

**Duration** item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select duration item , press" ◀ / ▶" button to adjust the duration of menu.

**Halftone** item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select halftone item , press "◀ / ▶" button to adjust the halftone of menu.

Memory Recall item: press "▲ / ▼" button to select memory item, press "▶" button and reset to default setting automatically.

#### FUNCTION menu





Enter this menu, you can select **Sleep Timer**, **Advance**, **Subtitles**, **Parent Control** items by pressing "▲ / ▼" buttons.

1. In **Sleep Timer** item, You can select different times, with the switching sequence as:

- 2. In Advance item, Press "◀/▶" button to enter submenu, as below figure.
- 2.1. In **DLC** item Press "◀/▶" button to set the Black Level Extension function, Which can choose "On", "Off" modes.
- 2.2. In **3D NR** item, Press "◀/▶" button to set the noise reduction function of TV set, which can choose "On", "Off" modes.
- 3. In **Subtitles** item , You will see as following CC1→CC2→ CC3→CC4→T1

  ↑ OFF ← T4 ← T3 ← T2 ← J
- 4. Parent Control press " ◀/▶" to enter the sub menu of Function.

#### PARENT CONTROL



While you select **Parent Control** item in **Function** menu, the correct password is needed to enter the sub menu. Usually, the default key is the num "0000". Once you input correct password.

**Change Password** item: select this item to enter Change password menu.

V-CHIP item: switch between On and Off.

TV Rating item: To enter TV Rating setting menu.

Press "▲ / ▼"or" ◀ / ▶" to highlight item, press <ENTER> button to change settings,and press menu to exit.

Auto Scan 12

In this menu you can complete the tune function. Select the Auto Scan item and press "◀ / ▶" button to begin search program. After finished search, the program will go to Channel NO.1. The picture will appear and the sound will be out.

#### 1.Channel

You can select the channel by pressing "◀ / ▶" button.

#### 2. Source

In this item, you can set source amount Air, CATV-STD, CATV-IRC, CATV-HRC.

#### 3. Add / Erase

Channel No. is available when this item is set to Add.

#### 4. Auto Scan

Press "◀ / ▶" button to start search program automatically from V-L to UHF, the searched program will be stored orderly.

#### PC menu



Specially when you set the source input as "PC", the first Menu Page will appears, named PC menu . You can choose **Brightness**, **Contrast** items by pressing "▲ / ▼" Buttons. You can adjust the item selected by pressing "◀/▶".

1. In **Aspect** item: Press "◄/▶" button to adjust the aspect of picture, which can choose "**16**: **9**" or "**4**:**3**" modes.

#### Color TEMP




**Color Temp** menu: Press "◀/▶" button to select the **Color.Temp** item , which can choose "NORMAL , WARM, COOL, USER" modes.

User-R: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust red of picture.

User-G: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust green of picture.

User-B: When you set the Color Temp as "User", Press "VOL+/-" button to adjust blue of picture.

#### Geometry



This menu is only for PC monitor mode (VGA input).

#### 1. H-Position / V-Position

Press the "◀ / ▶" buttons to adjust the picture Horizontal and Vertical position.

#### 2. Clock

Press the "◀ / ▶" to adjust the sampling ratio of picture. It can affect the display size of picture.

#### 3. Phase

When necessary, you can adjust the sampling phase of picture. It can make the picture clear.

#### 4. Auto Adjust

Select auto Adjust to adjust the screen position automatically. It will take a few seconds.

#### Note:

- **1.** If the set is cold, there may be a small "flicker" when the set is switched on. It is normal. There is nothing wrong with the set .
- **2.** Some dot defects may appear on the screen, like red. green or blue. Spots, However, this will have no impact or effect on the monitor performance.
- **3.** Do not press the LCD screen with your finger for a long time as it may incur some damage to the screen.

# **HELP**

No Power	Check the AC cord of TV is plus in or not. If still no power, please Pull out the plug and replug in after 60 seconds. And open the TV again.
Signal receive not properly	To cause double image or phantom if there has high building or high mountain round -TV. You can adjust image effect by manually operation: consult instruction of vernier regulation or change the direction of external antenna.  If you use the indoor antenna . under certain circumstance, receive will be more difficult .So you can change the direction of the antenna to adjust the image effect . If can't change image receiving effect either, you have to use external antenna.
No picture	Check the antenna at the back of TV is connected properly or not.  Try to select other channels and check whether the TV problem itself or not
Video is ok ,but without audio	Increase the volume. Check the TV is in mute mode or not , and please press the mute button to make sound resume.
Audio is ok, but color error or no picture.	Increase contrast and brightness.
snow statics picture and noise	Check the antenna at the back of TV is connected or not .
Level broken line	Maybe has electrical appliance interfere, such as hair drier, vacuum cleaner and so on, please turn off these kinds of electrical appliance.
Dual-Image or "simulacrum" The TV no response with the Remote.	Perhaps the location for the antenna is not good. Use the tall beamed antenna can be improved quality of the display image.  Operate the remote direct to the remote sensor on the TV.If still no response for the TV, please check if the plastic bag on the remote take or not. And checkif the location for the battery is correct. Change the new battery.  The TV will shift to the STAND BY if no response from the remote in the few minutes.
NO Video In. (PC Mode)	Please check if the display cable connect to the VGA correcte . Please check if there has the bend on the display cable.
Vertical twinkling (PC Mode)	Enter the main menu, Use the clock regulator for the Video display noise to eliminate the vertical line.
horizontal ripping (PC Mode)	Adjust the Audio sound horizontal in the main menu to clear the horizontal ripping line.
The screen is too bright or too dark (PC Mode)	Adjust the contrast ratio or brightness in the main menu.
PC Function no response	Check the computer setting in the state of compatible display resolution
Ripping line in RCA connecting	Please use good quality connecting cable.
Problem still exist	Unplug the power cable and wait for 30 seconds, then connect. If there is some problem with our TV, do not repair it by yourself, please contact with the customer service center.

Note: There will be complete picture and the brightness will come down if the TV is in the static picture for too long time, So please do not keep the TV in a state of same Menu or same picture that has much difference in brightness and contrast ratio for too long time.
