

### 1 2nd Row Fold Flat Seatback

To fold down the rear seat, pull up on the lever on the outboard side of the seat cushion and let the seatback rotate downward into the load floor position. To return to the upright position, rotate the seatback upward until the seatback latches. The seatback will click when it is locked into position.

### 2nd Row Seat Recline

To adjust the second row seatback to the desired position, while seated, pull the release lever up and push the seatback rearward.




