Important safety instructions

- 1 Read these instructions.
- **2** Keep these instructions.
- 3 Heed all warnings.
- 4 Follow all instructions.
- **5** Do not use this apparatus near water.
- **6** Clean only with a dry cloth.
- 7 Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- **8** Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat
- 9 Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- 10 Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- **11** Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- 12 Use only with the cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over.



13 Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.

- 14 Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the apparatus, the apparatus has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.
- 15 To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this device to rain, moisture, dripping, or splashing, and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on it.
- 16 An apparatus with a three-prong, grounding-type plug is a Class I apparatus, which needs to be grounded to prevent possible electric shock. Make sure that you connect this Class I device to a grounding-type, three-prong outlet.
- **17** The wall plug is the disconnecting device. The plug must remain readily operable.
- **18** Batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire, or the like.





3 Dock	Unfold the dock to insert the adapter and iPod.




Front with cradle open



# Item	Description
1 Volume up/down buttons	Press to increase or decrease the volume.
2 Power button	Press to turn your speaker system on or off. When your speaker system is turned on, the LED (below the power button) lights.
③ iPod dock	Insert your iPod into the correct adapter, then insert the iPod and adapter into this dock.


# Item	Description
Battery compartment	Insert batteries into this compartment.
2 DC IN	Connect the AC power adapter to this jack and to a power outlet.
3 AUX IN	Connect an audio device to this jack.
4 Stand	Unfold the stand to set your speaker system in an upright position.

Setting up your MP3 speaker system

Installing the batteries

To install the batteries:


1 Remove the battery compartment cover.



- 2 Insert four AA batteries into the battery compartment. Make sure that the + and symbols on the batteries align with the + and symbols inside the battery compartment.
- **3** Replace the cover.

Connecting the AC power adapter

 Connect the AC power adapter to the DC IN jack on the back of your speaker system.





Using your MP3 speaker system

Inserting an iPod


To insert an iPod:

1 Make sure that batteries are installed in the speaker system or the AC power adapter is connected to the speaker system and a power outlet.


Notes

Battery life is about eight (8) hours. You can use the AC power adapter when the batteries are depleted.

2 Press the open dock button on the front of your speaker system to unfold the dock.




3 Select the correct adapter, then insert it into the iPod dock. Adpaters are labeled with the names of the iPod models.



4 Insert the iPod into the adapter.

5 Pull the stand out to set the speaker system upright.



- **6** Press the power button. The LED lights.
- 7 Press the volume up or volume down button to adjust the volume.
- **8** Press the power button again to turn off your speaker system.

Connecting an audio device

You can connect an audio device to the AUX in jack.

To connect an audio device:

Make sure that batteries are installed in the speaker system or the AC power adapter is connected to the speaker system and a power outlet.

Notes

Battery life is about eight (8) hours. You can use the AC power adapter when the batteries are depleted.

- 2 Connect a 35mm audio cable to the AUX in jack on the back of your speaker system and to the audio out jack on the audio device.
- **3** Pull the stand out to set the speaker system upright.



- 4 Press the power button. The LED lights.
- **5** Press the volume up or volume down button to adjust the volume.
- **6** Press the power button again to turn off your speaker system.



Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution	
My iPod is in the dock and playing, but I can't hear any music.	 Make sure that the speakers are turned on. When the speakers are turned on, the power LED lights red. Adjust the volume level on the speakers using the volume buttons. Adjust the volume from the iPod controls. Turn off the Sound Check feature on your iPod. Make sure that batteries are installed and have a charge, or make sure that the AC adapter is connected to the speaker system and an power outlet. 	
There isn't an adapter for my iPod.	 If you have a newer iPod, use the universal dock adapter that came with your iPod when you purchased it.

If you notify Insignia during the Warranty Period of a defect covered by this warranty that requires service, terms of this warranty apply.

How long does the coverage last?

The Warranty Period lasts for 1 year (365 days) from the date you purchased the Product. The purchase date is printed on the receipt you received with the Product.

What does this warranty cover?

During the Warranty Period, if the original manufacture of the material or workmanship of the Product is determined to be defective by an authorized Insignia repair center or store personnel, Insignia will (at its sole option): (1) repair the Product with new or rebuilt parts; or (2) replace the Product at no charge with new or rebuilt comparable products or parts. Products and parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Insignia and are not returned to you. If service of Products or parts are required after the Warranty Period expires, you must pay all labor and parts charges.
