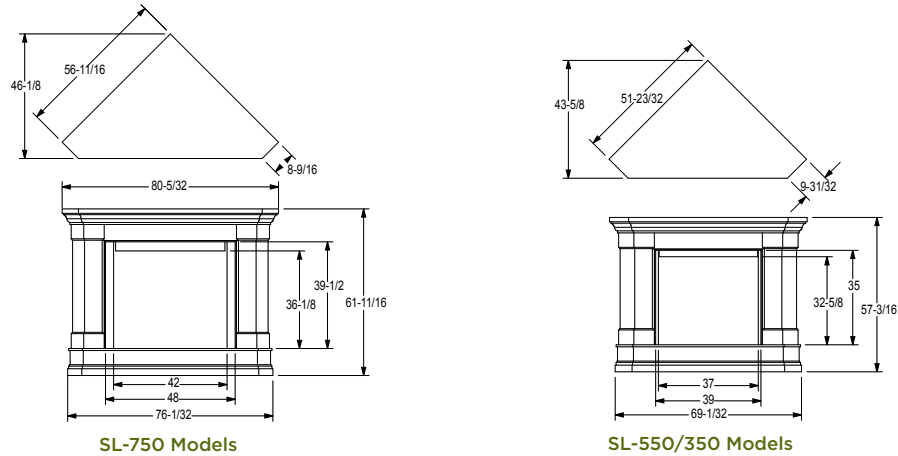
Kenwood Flush Mantel and Optional Raised Hearth Base



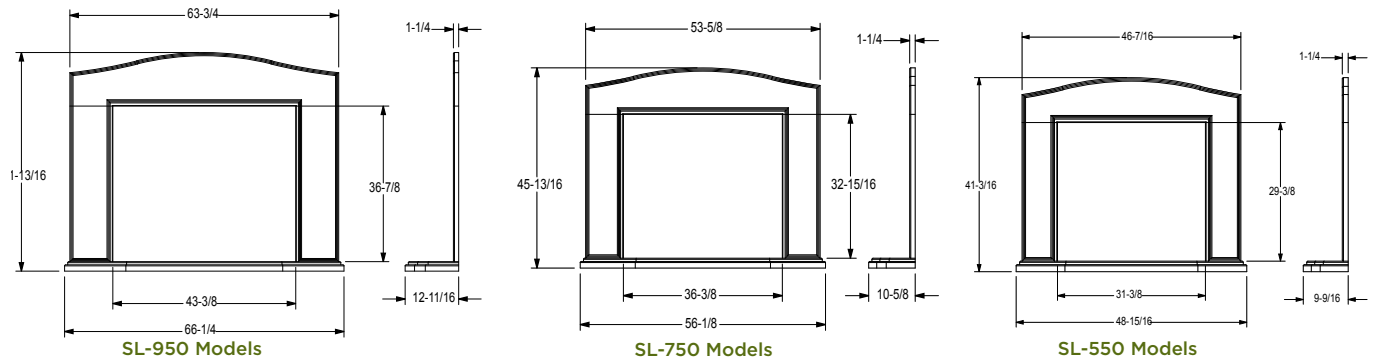
Kenwood Flush Cabinet and Optional Raised Hearth Base

Our exclusive, state-of-the-art, "green friendly" IntelliFire ignition system reduces gas consumption and thermogenerator wear by providing a pilot flame only when needed. It also supplies a back-up battery system to run the fireplace during a power outage.

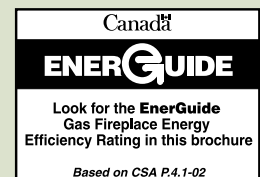
AFUE - AFUE rating is more typically used with appliances, like your furnace, that continually cycle on and off to maintain a constant temperature.
