← Hold down to signal other walkie talkies on the same channel.

 \bigcirc — Slide up \bigcirc to open the wings.

— Hold the walkie talkie 3-4 inches from your face and press put to talk to another person on the same channel. Speak into microphone on the bug's head while holding down put, then release when you are finished.

OFF — Rotate to turn the radio on and off, and to adjust the volume.

A or \bigvee — Press to select one of the 14 channels on which to transmit. You must be on the same channel to talk to another person.



ABOUT THE BATTERIES

- Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the battery compartment cover from the bug's belly.
- 2. Insert batteries as shown.

Channel Lock — If you want to lock the selected channel, remove the CHANNEL LOCK jumper from inside the battery compartment to prevent accidental channel changes.



3. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw.

If you do not press a button or no signal is received within about 10 seconds, an energy saving system activates to reduce power consumption and lengthen standby time.

Family Radio Service (FRS) is a license-free, two-way, shortrange voice radio service that lets you communicate on channels. The walkie talkie has 14 channels and auto-squelch. It provides clear communication for over half a mile, and its lightweight, handheld design and the attached plastic clip let you conveniently carry it almost anywhere. It is appropriate for ages 8 and up.

BATTERY INFORMATION

- · Dispose of old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (standard, alkaline or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different
- · If you do not plan to use the walkie talkie for a month or longer, remove the batteries. Batteries can leak chemicals that can destroy electronic

CARE

Keep the walkie talkie dry; if it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately. Use and store the walkie talkie only in normal temperature environments (not extreme hot or cold temperatures). Handle the walkie talkie carefully. Wipe it with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new. If your walkie talkie is not performing as it should, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Do not open your walkie talkie to make internal adjustments. It is set up to transmit a regulated signal on one of 14 assigned frequencies. It is illegal to alter or adjust the settings inside the walkie talkie to exceed those limitations. Any adjustments to your walkie talkie must be made by a qualified technician using the proper test equipment. To be safe:

- · Never open your walkie talkie's case.
- · Never change or replace anything in your walkie talkie except the

Your walkie talkie contains a low power transmitter. When power is pressed, radio frequency (RF) signals are emitted. The device is authorized to operate at a duty factor not to exceed 50%. In August 1996, the Federal Communications Commissions (FCC) adopted RF exposure guidelines with safety levels for handheld wireless devices.
