

## 1.4 Introduction

The Avenview VGA-VS-8X1 8x1 VGA/Component/S-Video/Composite Switch with Audio receives and amplifies up to 8 VGA inputs, perfectly switches the desired input to the VGA equipped monitor or receiver. The switch supports VGA video up to 350MHz. The switch re-transmits the signal without degradation and the longest transmission is up to 65m (210ft). Therefore, VGA-VS-8X1 offers the most convenient and cost effective means for swift switch of high quality PC graphics and HDTV videos with crystal clear audio in the market. With equipped audio switch, VGA-VS-8X1 is ideal solution for boardroom, showroom, and exhibition. The control of VGA-VS-8X1 is versatile and easy through the IR remote control, the push button on front panel, or the RS-232 control on rear panel.


#### **1.7 Before Installation**

- Put the product in an even and stable location. If the product falls down or drops, it may cause an injury or malfunction.

### **Section 2: Installation**

Follow these instructions for installation of VGA-VS-8X1:


- 1. Ensure VGA-VS-8X1 and all other source devices are turned off
- 2. Connect VGA / Component / S-Video / Composite display / projector to the output of VGA-VS-8X1
- 3. Connect the VGA / Component / S-Video / Composite source devices to input of VGA-VS-8X1
- 4. Plug power adapter to 5V DC power jack of VGA-VS-8X1
- 5. Use IR Remote control or push button on the front panel to switch between inputs, or connect a computer through RS232 port to switch the input sources.
