

- 2. The Sharp Built-in Trim Kit must be installed in accordance with the full set of instructions listed and meet the regulations laid down by electrical authorities, building regulations and the requirements of state and local government authorities.
- 3. The microwave oven must be unplugged before installation of the Sharp Built-in Kit.
- 4. For safe use of the microwave oven, DO NOT modify or alter any part of this kit.
- 5. The kitchen cabinetry that houses the microwave oven must be constructed to allow the microwave oven to operate to Australian Standards 3350.1-2002, 60335.1, 3350.2.25-2001 and 60335.2.25.

CARE AND CLEANING

Use a mild stainless steel cleaner applied with a soft damp cloth. Wipe in the stainless steel grain direction. DO NOT USE CAUSTIC CLEANERS, ABRASIVE OR HARSH CLEANERS OR SCOURING PADS.



Cabinetry Ventilation

An opening on the upper cavity panel must be cut for air circulation. This opening should be placed at the rear–minimum 600mm x 100mm.

Sharp Microwave Oven & Built in Trim Kit Installation Procedure



1. The cavity must be made to the specifications set out in Sharp's kitchen cabinetry requirements for built in microwave ovens. Mark the centre of the cabinet base panel. Sit the Base Assembly into the kitchen cabinet and align the base centre alignment cut with the centre mark you have just marked on the cabinet base. Ensure the front edge of the trim kit base is flush with the front edge of the cabinet base front edge. Use the 2 button head screws provided and screw into position.



3. Insert the microwave oven power cord through the power cord hole. Do not plug the cord into the powerpoint in the adjacent cabinet until the installation process is complete. Sit the microwave oven onto the base assembly and the feet locate into the feet indents. Ensure the cord is not sitting between the microwave and the base assembly.




2. Position the Fascia Assembly into position with the female clips attached correctly. Once it is in its correct position (see Cabinet Specifications in this manual), screw the female clips into position using the 6 gauge screws provided.




4. Remove the plastic protective coating from the Sharp Trim Kit Fascia. Fit the Fascia Assembly into position by pushing it so the male clips engage with the female clips while it is in a vertical position. Plug the microwave into an approved 240 volt 10 amp powerpoint and turn on. Clean with a mild stainless steel cleaner.
