

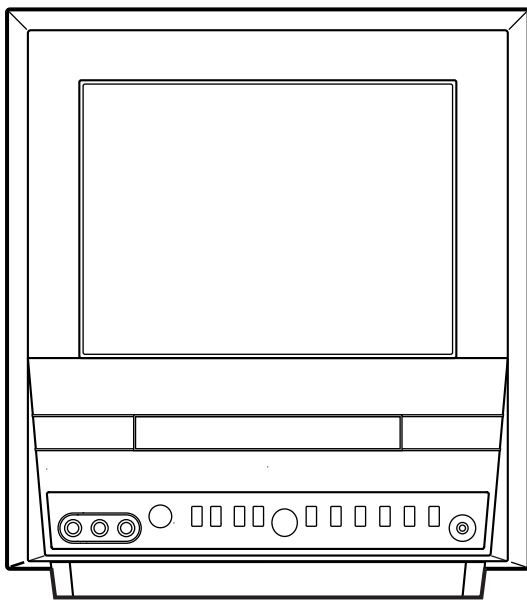

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- 1. Read instructions**-All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.

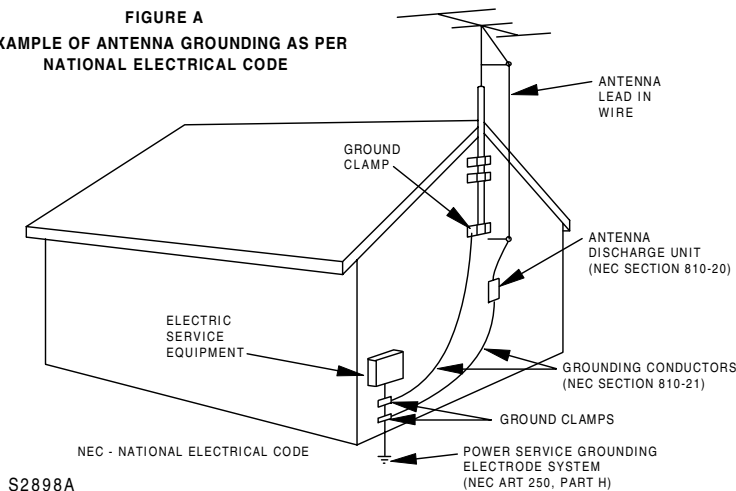

- 9. Ventilation**-Slots and openings in the cabinet and the back or bottom are provided for ventilation and to ensure reliable operation of the unit and to protect it from overheating, and these openings must not be blocked or covered. The openings should never be blocked by placing the unit on a bed, sofa, rug, or other similar surface. This unit should never be placed near or over a radiator or heat register. This unit should not be placed in a built-in installation such as a bookcase or rack unless proper ventilation is provided or the manufacturer's instructions have been adhered to.
- 10. Power Sources**-This unit should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply to your home, consult your appliance dealer or local power company. For units intended to operate from battery power, or other sources, refer to the operating instructions.
- 11. Grounding or Polarization**-This unit is equipped with a polarized alternating-current line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other). This plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If the plug should still fail to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized plug.

12. Power-Cord Protection—Power-supply cords should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items placed upon or against them, paying particular attention to cords at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the appliance.

13. Outdoor Antenna grounding—If an outside antenna or cable system is connected to the unit, be sure the antenna or cable system is grounded so as to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges. Article 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA No. 70, provides information with respect to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna-discharge unit, connection to grounding electrodes, and requirements for the grounding electrode. (Fig. A)

14. Lightning—For added protection for this unit receiver during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the antenna or cable system. This will prevent damage to the unit due to lightning and power-line surges.

15. Power Lines—An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines or other electric light or power circuits, or where it can fall into such power lines or circuits. When installing an outside antenna system, extreme care should be taken to keep from touching such power lines or circuits as contact with them might be fatal.

16. Overloading—Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.

17. Object and Liquid Entry—Never push objects of any kind into this unit through openings as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill liquid of any kind on the unit.

18. Servicing—Do not attempt to service this unit yourself as opening or removing covers may expose you to dangerous voltage or other hazards. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

19. Damage Requiring Service—Unplug this unit from the wall outlet and refer servicing to qualified service personnel under the following conditions:

LOCATION

For safe operation and satisfactory performance of your unit, keep the following in mind when selecting a place for its installation:

- Shield it from direct sunlight and keep it away from sources of intense heat.
- Avoid dusty or humid places.
- Avoid places with insufficient ventilation for proper heat dissipation. Do not block the ventilation holes at the top and bottom of the unit. Do not place the unit on a carpet because this will block the ventilation holes.
- Install the unit in a horizontal position.
- Avoid locations subject to strong vibration.
- Do not place the unit near strong magnetic fields.
- Avoid moving the unit to locations where temperature differences are extreme.

AVOID THE HAZARDS OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK AND FIRE

- Do not handle the power cord with wet hands.








- Depending on your antenna system, you may need different types of Combiners (Mixer) or Separators (Splitter). Contact your local electronics store for these items.

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FEATURES

TV Mode

- **181 channel capability PLL frequency synthesizer tuner with direct station call**
(A converter may be necessary to view scrambled cable channels.)
- **Infrared remote control**
- **Trilingual on screen menu display selectable in English, Spanish, or French**
- **Sleep Timer**
Allows you to have the unit automatically turn off at a desired time.
- **Auto Shut Off Function**
If there is no air signal input from the antenna terminal and no operation for 15 minutes, the TV will turn itself off automatically.

DVD Mode

- **Dolby Digital sound**
This unit can handle Dolby Digital surround sound having 5.1 channels when connected to a Dolby Digital decoder.
- **Still/fast/slow/step playback**
Various playback modes are available including still pictures, fast forward/reverse, slow motion and step frames.

This unit can shuffle the order of tracks to play them in random order.

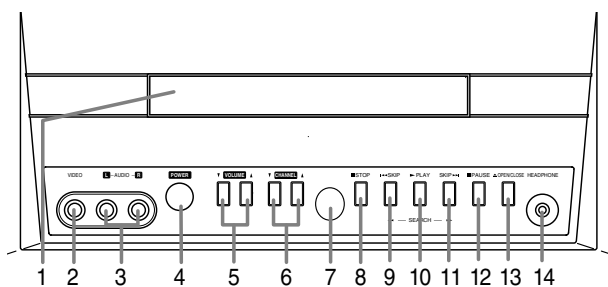

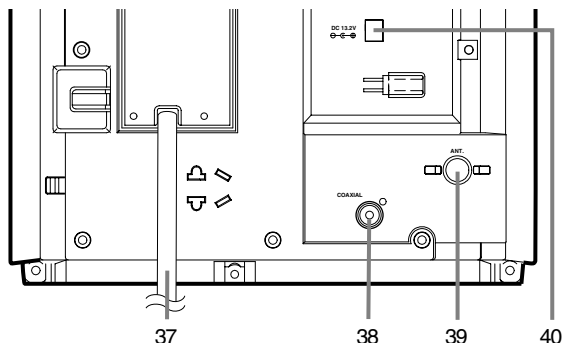

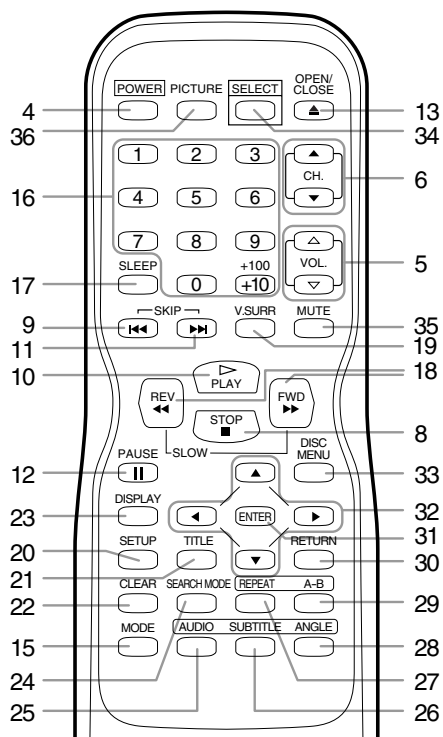

1. Disc loading tray

2. VIDEO input Jack [page 11]

Connect to the video output jack of a video camera or VCR.

3. AUDIO L/R input Jacks [page 11]

Connect to the audio output jacks of a video camera or VCR.

4. POWER Button [page 14]

Hit to turn the power on and off.

5. VOLUME (VOL.) ▲ / ▼ Buttons

Press to control the volume level for the DVD and TV.

6. CHANNEL (CH.) ▲ / ▼ Buttons [page 14]

Press to select memorized channel.

Press to change to TV mode when in DVD mode.

7. Remote Sensor Window

8. ■ STOP Button [page 19]

Stops operation of the disc.

9. ◀◀ SKIP Button [page 21]

Plays back from the beginning of the current chapter or track.

◀◀ SEARCH Button (Front Panel)

[page 20]

During playback or in the pause mode, press and hold button down for a few seconds to change reverse playback speed.

10. ▶▶ PLAY Button [page 19]

Starts playback of the disc contents.

Hit to change to DVD mode when TV mode.

11. SKIP ▶▶▶ Button [page 21]

Plays back from the beginning of the next chapter or track.

SEARCH ▶▶▶ Button (Front Panel)

[page 20]

During playback or in the pause mode, press and hold button down for a few seconds to change forward playback speed.

12. II PAUSE Button [page 20]

Pauses the current disc operation.

13. ▲ OPEN/CLOSE Button [page 19]

Hit to insert a disc into or remove it from the tray.

14. HEADPHONE Jack

To connect headphone (not supplied) for personal listening.

15. MODE Button [pages 22-24]

Activates program playback or random playback mode when playing CDs.

16. Number Button

TV Mode: [page 14]

Hit two digits to directly access the desired channel. Remember to hit [0] before a single digit channel.

+100 Button-

Hit to select cable channels which are higher than 99.

DVD Mode: [page 21]

Hit to enter the desired number.

+10 Button-

Hit to enter the desired numbers which are higher than 9.

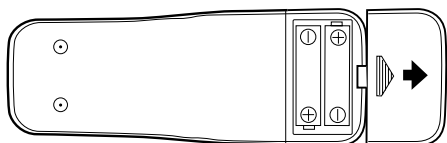
- 17. SLEEP Button** [page 15]
Sets the sleep timer.
- 18. REV ◀◀ Button** [page 20]
Hit to fast reverse the Disc. Hit [PAUSE III], then hit this button to begin slow motion playback. Hit this button repeatedly to change the reverse speed of slow motion.
- FWD ▶▶ Button** [page 20]
Hit to fast forward the Disc. Hit [PAUSE III], then hit this button to begin slow motion playback. Hit this button repeatedly to change the forward speed of slow motion.
- 19. V.SURR (VIRTUAL SURROUND) Button** [page 24]
Hit to set virtual surround on/off.
- 20. SETUP Button** [pages 16, 26-28]
Hit to enter or exit the setup menu of TV or DVD.
- 21. TITLE Button** [page 19]
Displays the title menu.
- 22. CLEAR Button** [pages 21-22]
Hit to clear or cancel a setting currently entered.
- 23. DISPLAY Button**
TV Mode:
Hit to display the channel number on the screen. If you hit it again, the channel number will disappear.
DVD Mode: [page 25]
Displays the current status on the TV screen.
- 24. SEARCH MODE Button** [page 21]
Hit to locate a desired point.
- 25. AUDIO Button** [page 23]
Hit to select a desired audio language or sound mode.
- 26. SUBTITLE Button** [page 23]
Hit to select a desired subtitle language.
- 27. REPEAT Button** [page 22]
Repeats playback of the current disc, title, chapter or track.
- 28. ANGLE Button** [page 24]
Hit to change the camera angle to see the sequence being played back from a different angle (if available).
- 29. A-B Button** [page 22]
Repeats playback of a selected section.
- 30. RETURN Button** [page 21, 24]
Returns to the previous screen in the setup menu.
- 31. ENTER Button** [pages 14, 19]
Hit to accept a setting.
- 32. ▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ Buttons**
TV Mode: [page 14]
Press to select a setting mode from the menu on the TV screen.
Press to select or adjust from a particular menu.
DVD Mode: [page 19]
Press to select a menu item.
- 33. DISC MENU Button** [page 19]
Calls up the DVD menu.
- 34. SELECT Button** [pages 11, 19]
Hit to change to TV mode, external input mode or DVD mode.

NOTE: When you select the DVD mode by this button, press [PLAY >] or [OPEN/CLOSE ▲] first. Otherwise, the DVD features are not operated.

- 35. MUTE Button**
Mutes the sound.
(Volume level display turns LIGHT RED from LIGHT BLUE.)
Hit it again or press [VOL. Δ / ▽] to restore sound.
- 36. PICTURE Button** [page 15]
Hit to enter picture adjustment mode.
- 37. Power cord**
Connect to a standard AC outlet (120V/60Hz).
- NOTE:** Remove the power cord from the hook to avoid breaking a wire before you connect to a standard AC outlet.
- 38. COAXIAL Jack (DVD Audio Only)**
Connect to the digital input of an external amplifier or decoder.
- 39. ANT(ENNA). Jack**
Connect to an antenna, cable system, or satellite system.
- 40. DC 13.2V Jack**
Connect to the Car Battery Cord.

INSTALLING THE BATTERIES

- 1) Open the battery compartment cover by pressing the cover on the remote unit in the direction of the arrow.
- 2) Insert 2 "AA" penlight batteries into the battery compartment in the direction indicated by the polarity (+/-) markings.
- 3) Replace the cover.

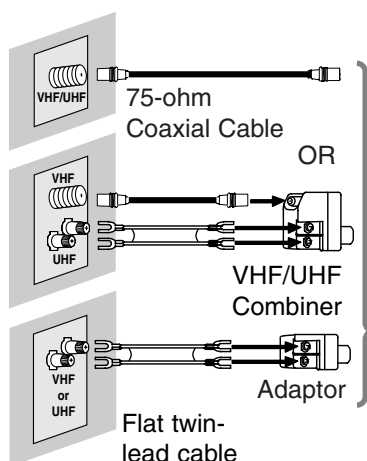
- Be sure to follow the correct polarity as indicated in the battery compartment. Reversed batteries may cause damage to the device.
- Do not mix different types of batteries together (e.g. Alkaline and Carbon-Zinc) or old batteries with fresh ones.
- If the device is not to be used for a long period of time, remove the batteries to prevent damage or injury from possible battery leakage.
- Do not try to recharge batteries not intended to be recharged; they can overheat and rupture.

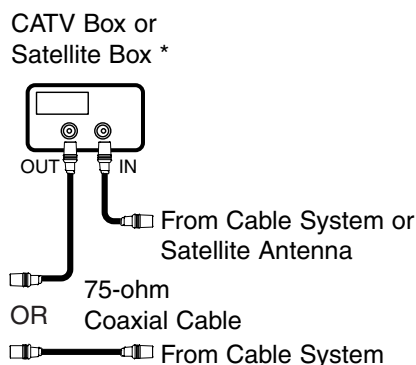
ANTENNA/CABLE CONNECTION

*Some cable TV systems use scrambled signals and require a special converter to receive these channels. Consult your local cable company.

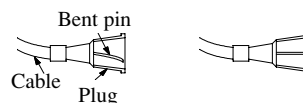

Note to CATV system installer:

This reminder is provided to call the CATV system installer's attention to Article 820-40 of the NEC that provides guidelines for proper grounding and in particular, specifies that the cable ground shall be connected to the grounding system of the building as close to the point of cable entry as practical.

NOTE:

- Before plugging the an antenna into the ANT. jack of the unit, check that the pin is not bent. If it is bent, straighten the pin as illustrated, then plug the pin into the ANT. jack of the unit.

VHF/UHF COMBINED ANTENNA

A VHF UHF 75 ohm combination antenna can be connected to ANT. jack of the unit.

VHF/UHF SEPARATE ANTENNAS

In some areas it will be necessary to use an outdoor antenna.

CABLE WITHOUT CONVERTER/DESCRAMBLER BOX

Use this connection if your cable system connects directly to the unit without a converter box.

CABLE WITH CONVERTER/DESCRAMBLER BOX OR SATELLITE BOX

If your cable service supplies you with a converter box or if you use a satellite system, you can use the basic connection shown above.

Channel selection must be made with the converter box or satellite box. This means that channels cannot be changed using the remote control of this unit.

NOTE:

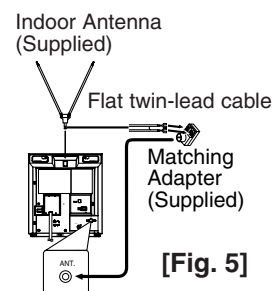
- For your safety and to avoid damages to the unit, unplug the antenna cable from the ANT. jack before moving the unit.

INDOOR ANTENNA

The Indoor Antenna (supplied) is detachable. Insert the stem of the antenna into the hole on the upper-back portion of the unit. Connect the Indoor Antenna to the unit as shown in the diagram. For the best reception, fully extend the Indoor Antenna and make the necessary adjustments. (Avoid touching the top section when adjusting.)

NOTE:

- The connection of an Indoor antenna may not always give acceptable TV reception.



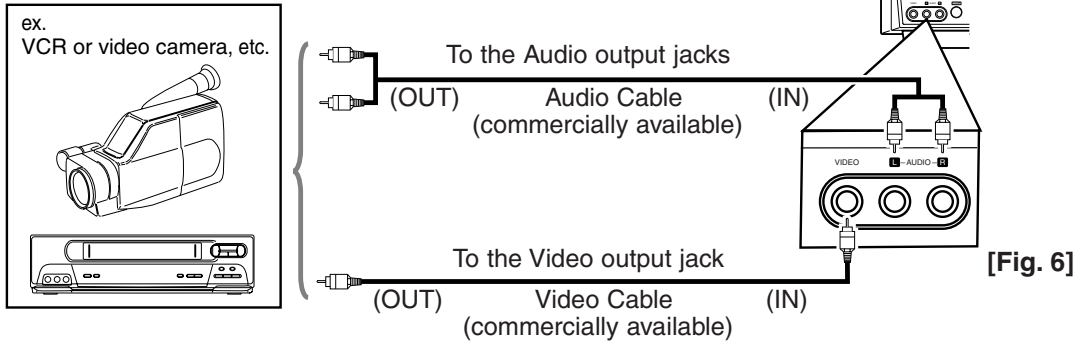

CONNECTING TO EXTERNAL INPUT JACKS

When you watch a program recorded on another source (VCR or video camera), use the AUDIO/VIDEO input jacks on the front of the unit.

Connect the AUDIO/VIDEO output jacks of another source to the AUDIO L/R and VIDEO jacks of this unit.

Then hit [SELECT] until "AUX" appears on the screen.



NOTE:

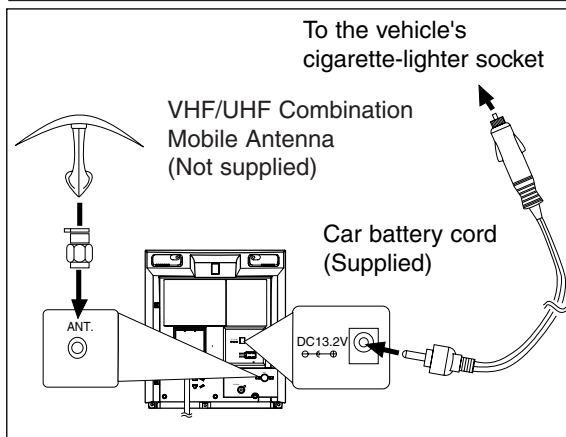
- When you connect a monaural VCR (another source) to this unit, connect the Audio output jack of the monaural VCR (another source) to the AUDIO L jack of this unit. The audio will output in both L and R channel equally.

MOBILE CONNECTION

WARNING: The driver should never watch the unit while operating a motor vehicle.

CAUTION:

- When used in moving vehicle, be sure that the unit is secure at all the times to prevent injury. Consult a professional installer.
- If you use the unit with the vehicle's engine off, recharge the vehicle's battery after about every 4 hours of use to prevent it from running down. After you finish using the unit be sure you unplug the car-battery cord from the cigarette-lighter socket.
- Do not use this unit while driving.
- Do not leave this unit in a car.
- This unit is not designed for use in a car.



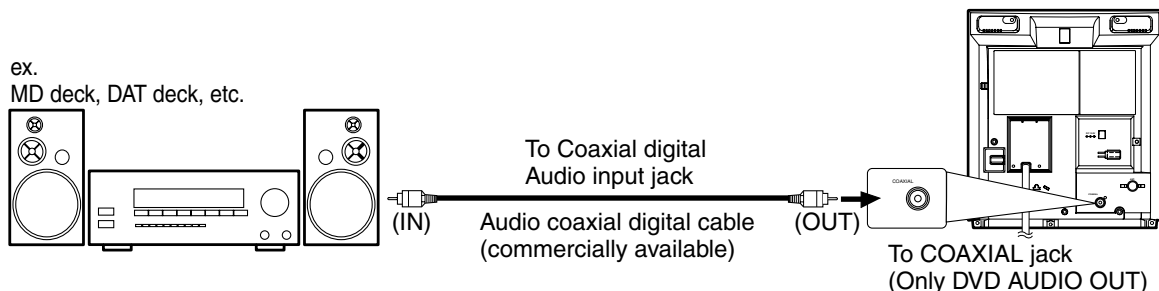
- 1) The supplied indoor antenna is adequate when your vehicle is stationary. For best reception on the road, use a high-quality VHF/UHF mobile TV antenna.
- 2) Attach the car battery cord to the DC13.2V(12V) connector on the back of the unit. Then, connect the other end to your vehicle's cigarette-lighter socket.

NOTES:

- Be sure your vehicle has a 13.2-volt (12-volt), negative-ground electrical system.
- Be sure you use only the supplied car battery cord. Using another cord could damage the unit.
- Be sure the socket is free of ashes and other debris.
- Be sure to push the car battery cord's plug completely into the cigarette-lighter socket.
- Always unplug the car battery from the cigarette-lighter socket before you unplug it from the unit.
- You must disconnect the car battery cord from the unit before you can use the AC power.
- Be sure to replace the fuse with only the same type, 6A, 250V.

CONNECTING TO A STEREO AMPLIFIER EQUIPPED WITH DIGITAL INPUT JACKS (for DVD)

Use an audio coaxial digital cable (commercially available) for the audio connections.
Connect to an amplifier equipped with digital input jacks such as MD Deck or DAT Deck.

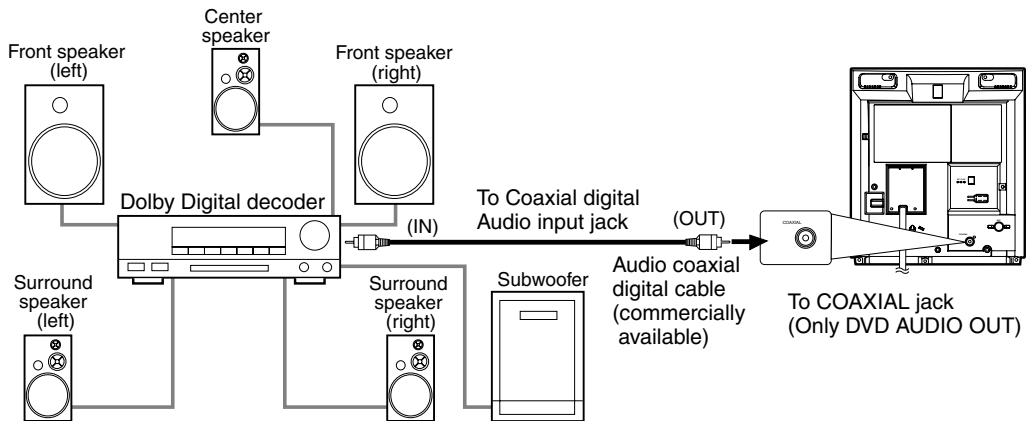

By hooking the unit up to a Dolby Digital decoder, you can enjoy a more convincing, realistic ambience with powerful and high-quality surround sound as enjoyed in movie theaters.

Use audio coaxial digital cables (commercially available) for the audio connections.

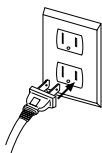

NOTE:

- If some digits appear in the corner of the screen, hit [POWER] without unplugging the power cord.

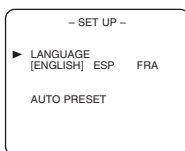

Hit [POWER] to turn on the unit.

3 Select the On Screen Language

Press [▲ / ▼] to point to “LANGUAGE”, then hit [ENTER] to select “ENGLISH” or “ESP”=Spanish or “FRA” =French. “[]” indicate the selected language.



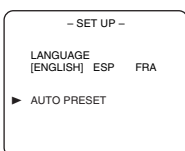
4 Begin auto preset

Press [▲ / ▼] to point to “AUTO PRESET”, then hit [ENTER].

The tuner scans and memorizes all active channels in your area.

NOTES:

- The unit distinguishes between standard TV channels and cable (CATV) channels.
- The unit may memorize TV channels as CATV channels if reception condition is poor. If this happens, try “AUTO PRESET” action again when reception conditions are better. Refer to “CHANNEL RESETTING” on page 16.



5 After scanning

The tuner stops on the lowest memorized channel. You can select the desired channel directly with the **Number buttons** or [CH. ▲ / ▼].

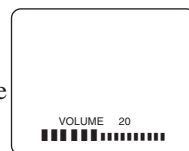

PICTURE CONTROL

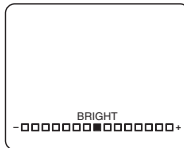

- If there is a power failure of any kind, the unit will retain its memory for this feature.

DEGAUSSING

TV

This television has a degaussing circuit that will clear up color errors on the TV screen that are caused by any excess magnetism which happens to get too close to the TV. This circuit is designed to operate once when the set is first plugged in. **If minor color errors are seen in some locations on the screen, please unplug the TV for approximately 30 minutes.** When the TV is plugged back in, the degaussing circuit will operate once to clear them up. Repeat this procedure any time the TV screen is accidentally magnetized or when the TV is moved or relocated.

SLEEP TIMER

TV

The Sleep Timer function turns off the unit without using [POWER] after a desired period of time.

1 Call up the Sleep Timer Setting

Hit [SLEEP] so that "SLEEP TIMER" appears.

2 Set sleep time

Hit [SLEEP] repeatedly until your desired sleep time appears.

Each additional hit will increase the time by 30 minutes up to 120 minutes.

After 5 seconds, the Sleep Timer setting will disappear automatically.



NOTE:

- When you disconnect the unit from the AC outlet, or if you have a power failure, the sleep time will be lost.
- To confirm the time left for sleep timer, hit [SLEEP] once and the display appears for 10 seconds.

TO CANCEL THE SLEEP TIMER

Getting started

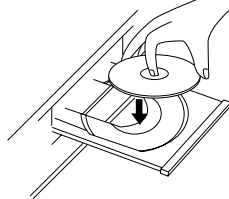
- Turn on the power of amplifier and any other components, if necessary.

1 Hit [POWER].

- The power will turn on.

2 Hit [OPEN/CLOSE ▲] to open disc loading tray.

3 Place the chosen disc in the tray, with the label facing up.



4 Hit [PLAY ▷].

- The tray will close automatically and playback will then start from the first chapter or track of the disc.
- Closing the disc tray manually or hitting [OPEN/CLOSE ▲] also starts playback.
- If the playback does not start automatically, hit [PLAY ▷].
- When you playback a DVD which features a title menu, it may appear on the screen. In this case, refer to "TITLE MENU".

5 Hit [STOP ■] to stop playback.

NOTES:

- When the DVD mode has been switched to the TV mode, the DVD mode shuts down first and then the TV picture and sound appears in about 4 seconds. Similarly, when [POWER] is hit to turn off in the DVD mode, this mode shuts down first and then the unit's power is turned off.
- A "prohibited icon" may appear at the top-right on the TV screen during operation, warning that a prohibited operation has been encountered by the DVD or the disc.
- With DVDs that use titles for playback program signals, playback may start from the second title or it may skip these titles.
- During the playback of a two layered disc, pictures may stop for a moment. This happens when the 1st layer switches to the 2nd layer. This is not a malfunction.



GENERAL FEATURES

DVD-V

DVD may contain menus to navigate the disc and access special features. Press appropriate **the Number buttons** or use [▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶] to highlight your selection in the DVD main menu and hit [ENTER] to confirm.

NOTES:

- Select DVD mode by hitting [SELECT]. Then press [PLAY ▷] or [OPEN/CLOSE ▲] before you operate the DVD functions.
- Unless stated, all operations described are based on remote control use. Some operations can be carried out using the menu bar on the TV screen.

1 Hit [DISC MENU].

- The DVD main menu will appear.

2 If the feature is not available, ⓧ symbol may appear on the TV screen.

3 If disc menu is available on the disc, audio language, subtitle options, chapters for the title and other options will appear for selection.

4 Press [▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶] to select an item and hit [ENTER] to confirm selection.

TITLE MENU

DVD-V

1 Hit [TITLE].

- The title menu will appear.

2 If the feature is not available, ⓧ symbol may appear on the TV screen.

3 Press [▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶] to select an item and hit [ENTER] to confirm selection.

CALLING UP A MENU SCREEN DURING PLAYBACK

- Hit [DISC MENU] to call up the DVD menu.
- Hit [TITLE] to call up the title menu.

- Contents of menus and corresponding menu operations may vary between discs. Refer to the manual accompanying the disc for details.

RESUME

DVD-V CD

1 During playback, hit [STOP ■].

- Resume message will appear on the TV screen.

2 Hit [PLAY ▷], playback will resume from the point at which playback was stopped.

- To cancel resume, hit [STOP ■] twice.
- If the unit is turned off, resume function will be cancelled.

PAUSE

1 During playback, hit [PAUSE II].

- Playback will pause and sound will be muted.

2 To continue playback, hit [PLAY ▷].

- For Audio CDs, approximate speed is ×16.
- When you use buttons on the front panel, press and hold [SEARCH ◄◄ / ►►] for a few seconds.

3 To return to normal playback, hit [PLAY ▷].

SLOW FORWARD / SLOW REVERSE

1 During playback, hit [PAUSE II].

2 Press [FWD ►►] or [REV ◄◄].

- “►► 1” or “◄◄ 1” appears on the screen.

3 To select another speed, repeat step 2 until your required speed appears on the screen.

- Slow forward or reverse speed varies with the disc. Approximate speed is 1 (1/16), 2 (1/8) and 3 (1/2).
- When you use buttons on the front panel, press and hold [SEARCH ◄◄ / ►►] for a few seconds.

4 To return to normal playback, hit [PLAY ▷].

SEARCH FUNCTION

TRACK SEARCH

CD

There are three ways to begin playback on an Audio CD at a specific track.

Using the Number buttons

1 Press the Number buttons to enter the desired Track Number.

- Playback will start at the selected track.
- For single digit tracks (1-9), hit a single number (eg. track 3, hit [3]).
- To play track 26, hit [+10], [2], [6].

Using [SEARCH MODE]

1 Hit [SEARCH MODE].

- The Track search display appears.

2 Within 30 seconds, select a desired track number using the Number buttons.

- For single digits hit [0] first, if the total track of the disc is more than 10.
- Playback will start at the selected track.

Using [SKIP ◀◀ / ▶▶]

During playback, hit [SKIP ▶▶] to move the next track. Hit it repeatedly to skip subsequent tracks. Hit [SKIP ◀◀] to go back to beginning of the current track. Hit it repeatedly to go to the previous tracks.

- If [SKIP ◀◀ / ▶▶] is pressed while the playback is paused, the playback will be paused again after skipping to the next track.

NOTE:

- [SKIP ◀◀ / ▶▶] are not operative when playback is stopped.

TITLE / CHAPTER SEARCH

DVD-V

1 Hit [SEARCH MODE] once for the Chapter search, twice for the Title search during playback.



2 Enter the desired chapter/title number using the Number buttons.

- Playback will start at the selected chapter or title.
- Hit [CLEAR] to erase the incorrect input.
- For single digits hit [0] first, if the total chapter or title of the disc is more than 10.

TIME SEARCH

DVD-V

CD

1 During playback, hit [SEARCH MODE] three times (CD: twice) to display the Time Search on the TV screen.

2 Within 30 seconds, enter a desired disc time using the Number buttons.

- Playback will start at the specified time.
- Hit [CLEAR] to erase the incorrect input.
- When there is no need to enter a number, "0" appears automatically. For example, "0 : 0 : . . ." appears in the Time Search display if the total time of the track or title is less than 10 minutes.

Use markers to memorize your favorite places on a disc.

1 Hit [SEARCH MODE] four times (CD: three times) during playback.

3 When you reach the desired point, hit [ENTER].

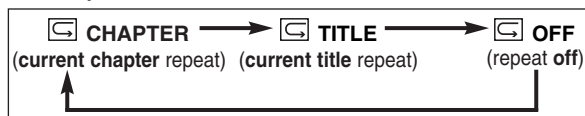

- The A-B repeat section can only be set within the current title (for DVDs) or current track (for Audio CDs).
- A-B repeat is not available with some scenes in DVD.
- To cancel the A point which was set, hit [CLEAR].
- A-B repeat playback does not function during title, chapter, track or all repeat playback.

PROGRAM

CD

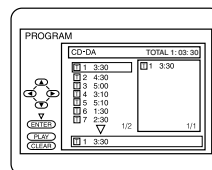
You may determine the order in which tracks will play.

1 In stop mode, hit [MODE].

- The “PROGRAM” screen will appear.

2 Press [▲ / ▼] to select a track, then hit [ENTER].

- Hit [CLEAR] to erase the most recently entered program.



3 Repeat step 2 until you have selected all the tracks you want to play in the program.

4 Hit [PLAY ▷] to play the programmed tracks.

NOTES:

- While the program is being played back, the STOP works as follows.
- Hit [STOP ■] once and then [PLAY ▷] again, playback will restart from the point where [STOP ■] was hit. (Program continued)
- Hit [STOP ■] twice and then [PLAY ▷] again, playback will restart from the track in the usual way. (Program canceled)
- Up to 99 tracks can be entered.
- To erase all tracks in the program at once, select “ALL CLEAR” at the bottom of the list at step 2.

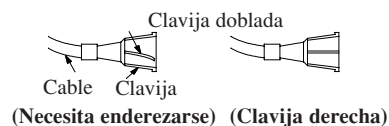

Nota para el instalador de sistemas CATV

Esta nota tiene la finalidad de llamar la atención del instalador de sistemas CATV para que tenga en cuenta el Artículo 820-40 del NEC, el cual proporciona consejos para hacer una conexión a tierra apropiada y, en particular, especifica que la tierra del cable deberá estar conectada al sistema de puesta a tierra del edificio, tan cerca del punto de entrada del cable como sea posible.

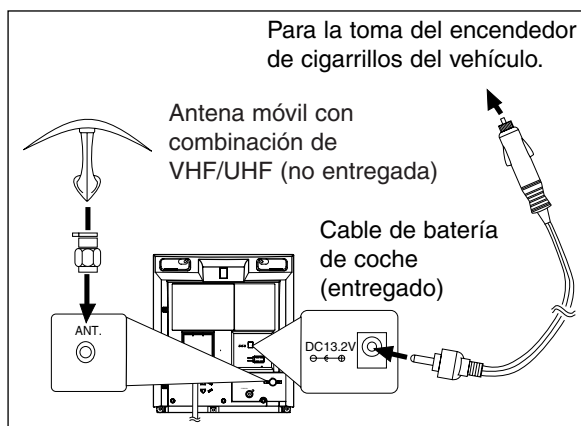

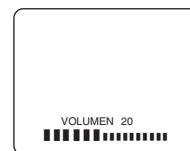

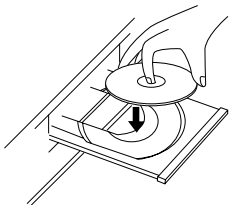
