

Notes on installation

English

- The unit is designed for 12V DC, negative ground operation system only. Before installing the unit,
- make sure your vehicle is connected to DC 12V negative ground electrical system.
- The Negative battery terminal must be disconnected before making connections, which can reduce damaging the unit due to short circuit.
- Be sure to connect the color coded leads correctly according to the diagram. Incorrect connections may cause the unit malfunction or damage the vehicles electrical system.
- Be sure to connect the speaker (-) leads to the speaker (-) terminal.

 Never connect the left and right channel speaker cables each other or to the vehicle body.
- panels. Blocking them will cause heat to build up inside and may result in fire.

After the completion of the installation and begin to play the unit (including replacing the battery), please press the RESET button on the front panel with pointed objects (such as ball-point pen) to set the unit to initial status.

⊕ The manual conforms to Mp3and CD; If no MP3 on some models, you should ignore them. While enjoying Mp3 and CD, the display will automatically identify the discs and indicate the corresponding words.

- Do not attempt to modify the unit, modifying the unit may cause an accident.
- Stop the vehicle before carrying out any operation that could interfere with your driving.
- Do not work in extreme high or low temperature inside the vehicle is between +60°C and -20°C before turning your unit on.
- To enjoy optimum sound and images while playing, handle the discs as follows:
 - Handle the disc by its edge to keep the disc clean, and do not touch the surface.




—— Do not use your CDs with paste residue or ink attached.



— Do not use CDs with labels or stickers attached. which may leave a sticky residue while beginning to peel off. (Shown as picture)




 Clean the discs with an optional cleaning cloth .Wipe each disc from the center out. (Shown as picture)


- 1.Operating the unit for the first time or after replacing the car battery, you must reset unit ,press (RES) button whit a pointed object (such as a ball point pen) to set the unit to initial procedure.
- ★ Note: when some errors occur in the LCD display you can also press RESET button to resume to normal And it will erase the clock setting and some memorized functions.



Press 2 (PWR) button to turn on the unit, and press it again to turn off the unit.

★Note : After the unit is off, if the volume level is higher than it is in initial setting, it will resume, to initial status; if it is lower than that in initial status, it will store in the status which you set.

- 3.For Volume Control 3, rotate, vol knob clockwise to increaes the sound level, and rotate it anticlock wise to decrease the sound level.
- 4.Repeatedly press 4 (SEL)button to select the desired mode in the following order:



- *Note :After selecting the desired mode, you can adjust the curren level by rotating the (VOL) knob.
- ★Note: If you don it adjust 3 VOL) knob within 5seconds after selecting the desired mode the unit will automaticall return to the current mode being disp layed.





Turning Loudness On/Off



5.Press (LOUD) button to increase the low frequency, This can improve the sensitivity for your ears And ¡LOUD; appears in the LCD when the loudness mode is activated. (See the picture) press it once more to shut down the LOU function.





6. While listening to the popular music classic musec and rock music ,you can adjust the sound quality to make it perfect by pressing 6 (P-EQ) button the procedure is as follows.

Pop mode is selected when 6 (P-EQ) button is first pressed and ¡POP¡ appears in the display. (Shown as picture)



★CLASSIC mode is selected when pressing 6 (P-EQ)button at the second time, and ¡CLAS;appears on the LCD (Shown as picture)



★ROCK mode is selected when pressing 6 (P-EQ) button at the third time and ROCK appears in the display. (shown as picture)



★Press 6(P-EQ) button at the forth time to turn off the P-EQ system.

Note:Bass mode and Trble mode rerurn to initial setting when P-EQsystem is on ¡BASS;and ¡TREBLE;disappear



7.Press 7 (LOC) button to select strong or weak station reception ★It is set to LOC mode when (LOC)button is first pressed ¡LOC¡appears and only local station is available (Shown as picture).



★ It is switched to DX mode when (LOC) button is pressed again Both distance and local stations can be received.




8. Time Displaying: Press (DSP) button and the current time is displayed, and it returns to original status a fter 5 seconds or press the button again.

Time Adjusting: press and hold (SEL) button until the two points in the middle of the clock stop blinking, you can rotata (VOL) knob adjust hours and minutes.


4.Press **I**(ST) button to select M-ONO mode or STEREOmode.


★ When the range of the operation of the card remote control becomes short or no functions while operating Replace the battery with a new button cell, Make sure the battery polarity before replace 1.Pull out the Battery Holder while pressing the Stopper ①

9.Tuning /Selecting Tracks FastRewind /Forward

——During radio mode, continously press (19) SEEK - Or FEEK + button to manul search a station downward or upward respectively; if press and hold (19) SEEK + button for more than 3 seconds, the radio will automatically station downward or upward respectively unit it finds a station.

——During the playing mode, press and hold [9\19] [14-4-0] [15-4-1] button to fast rewind or fast forward for you to reach your desired track quickly, when discontinuously, press




DETACHING THE FRONT PANEL



Before detaching the front panel. Be sure to press (b). Press (c), then ture the front panel to the level, slide it to the left, and pull it off to wards you.

REPLACING THE FRONT PANEL



First, insert the left side of the front panel into the main unit. Push the right side of the front panel until it locks firmly into the main unit, at one time, insert the right side of the front panel into the main unit.

PRECAUTIONS



Do not touch the contacts on the ront panel or on the unit body, since this may result in poor electrical contact, If dirt or dust get on the contacts, wipe them with a clean, dry cloth.

Simple Troubleshootong Guide



Problem	Cause/Solution
No power	★ Check and make sure whether the fuse is blown, replace with the proper value if necessary.
Some errors occur in the LCD or no function when pressing the button.	★ Press the RESET button.
Unable to receive stations.	★ Check and make sure whether the antenna is inserted or the antenna is properly connected. if so, insert the antenna or connect it properly.
Poor effect on receiving a station.	 ★ Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended or broken: if broken. Replace the antenna with a new one. ★ The broadcasting signal is too weak. ★ The antenna is poorly grounded, check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded at its mounting location.
ACDs cannot be loaded.	★ ACDs is loaded in the mechanism.
The stereo indicatori is flashing.	 ★ Tune in the frequency accurately. ★ The broadcasting signal is too weak. (Set to the MONO mode) (page 12)
No picture.	★ The CDs is dirty or damaged
The picture noise appears.
