Welcome to the Rio Cali, your portable solution for MP3 and WMA digital audio playback. The Rio Cali features a lighted LCD, an expandable memory slot, and an FM radio tuner. The Rio Cali uses a AAA battery that provides many hours of playback. Follow these steps to get started:

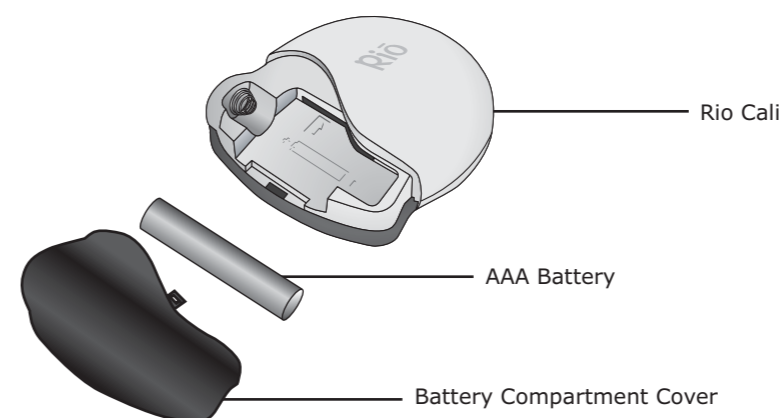
1 Unpack

Make sure your package includes the following:



2 Insert Battery

- Slide open the battery compartment cover on the side of the Rio Cali.
- Insert the supplied AAA battery. Ensure the battery is inserted properly by matching the + and - symbols on the battery with the symbols on the Rio Cali.
- Replace the battery compartment cover.



3 Install Software

- Place the installation CD label-side up into the computer's CD-ROM drive. Rio installation software launches automatically.
- Click Rio Music Manager INSTALL NOW and follow the on-screen instructions.
- Reboot the computer when the installation is complete.

NOTE:

If Rio installation software does not display automatically, follow these steps to begin the installation manually:

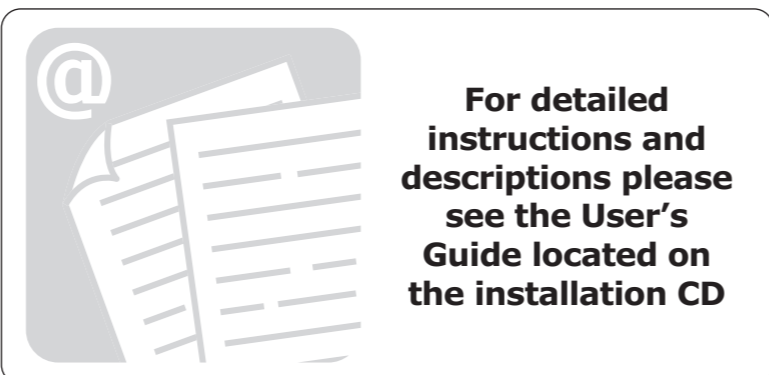
- Double-click the My Computer icon on the Windows desktop.
- Double-click the CD-ROM icon.
- Double-click the Install icon.
- Go to Step 2.

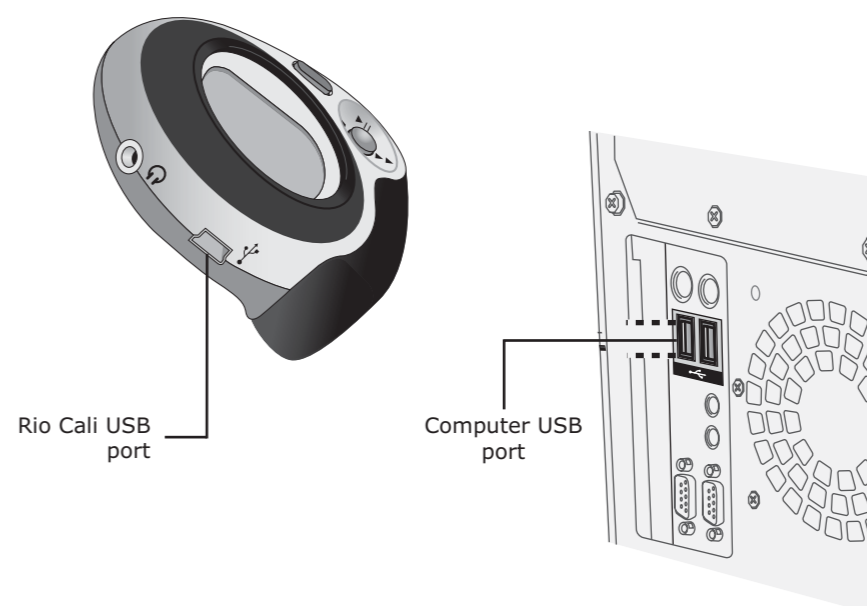
PC

- Microsoft® Windows® 98 SE, 2000, Me, or XP
- 233Mhz Pentium® II processor or higher with 64MB RAM
- USB port
- CD-ROM drive
- Internet connection recommended



4 Connect USB

- Insert the supplied USB cable into the USB port on the bottom of the Rio Cali.
- Connect the other end of the USB cable to the USB port on your computer.



5 Save and Transfer Tracks

Use Rio Music Manager to save (rip and encode) tracks from audio CDs and convert them to digital audio formats.

Saving tracks to your PC

- Insert an Audio CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- Launch Rio Music Manager.
- Click the CD-ROM icon located in the Device List. Rio Music Manager will scan the disc for audio files.
- Use any file selection technique (see below and right) to select tracks.
- Click to begin saving tracks.

Transferring tracks to your Rio Cali

- Launch Rio Music Manager.
- Confirm your Rio Cali is connected to your computer. (See Step 4.)
- Click Media Library icon located in the Device List.
- Use tabs to sort tracks based on Albums, Artists, Genres, Songs, or Playlists.
- Use any file selection technique (see below) to select tracks.
- Click to transfer the selected tracks onto the player.

Selection Techniques

Selection Type

Single track, album, or artist.
Multiple tracks, albums, and/or artists.
All tracks, albums, and artists.
All tracks except currently selected tracks.

Technique

Left-click.
SHIFT+click or CTRL+click.
CTRL+A.
Select Edit, Invert Selection.
