

## 2. Installing Battery

Your device is powered by one AAA battery (not included). To install or replace it:

- 1. Turn your product off and turn it over.
- 2. Slide open the battery cover by pushing in the direction of the arrow.
- 3. Install the battery following the +/- markings in the battery compartment.



• **Important**: Be sure that the battery is installed correctly. Wrong polarity may damage the device.

4. Replace the battery cover.

#### **Battery Precautions**

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Never recharge batteries that come with the device.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the device before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.

- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Do not expose batteries to direct heat or try to take batteries apart. Follow the battery manufacturer's instructions for battery use.


- Always remove a weak or dead battery from the device.

Insert the earphones into the earphone jack (3.5mm).





SWITCH ON: Slide the power switch to the ON position.




SWITCH OFF: Slide the power switch to the OFF position.



## 11.1 Adjusting Screen Contrast




