Hardware Installation

1

1. Locate your notebook's CardBus slot(s).
2. With your notebook on, slide the Adapter into the unused 34mm or 54mm ExpressCard bus slot.

Note: Do not plug any devices into the Adapter until you have completely finished the driver installation.

3. The "New Hardware Wizard" will launch and recognize the Adapter.

4. Windows OS automatically installs the correct driver.
5. Installation is now complete and the Adapter is ready to use.

Verifying Proper Installation

Check the “Windows Device Manager” to confirm that your Adapter has been properly installed.

1. Right-click on “My Computer” and select “Manage”.
2. Select the “Device Manager” tab.
3. Click the (+) sign next to “Disk drives”. The “Disk drives” will now include one entry that reads “Generic USB Card Reader USB Device”.
4. There will also be an entry under “Universal Serial Bus Controllers”, which will include an entry that reads “USB Mass Storage Device”.
