**Power Button** — Press the power button once to turn on your computer. Press the power button again to initiate Hibernation.

Instant Internet, Search, E-Commerce, and E-mail **Buttons** — These buttons provide a one-stop connection to the Internet, Search, E-Commerce, and E-mail. (Varies by model.)

**Volume Buttons** — Control the volume with the volume buttons below the touchpad of your computer. Press "+" to increase the volume. Press "-" to decrease the volume.



### STATUS LIGHTS

Your computer has status lights located at the bottom center of the keyboard. Some of the lights are visible when the display panel is open or closed.



**Power** — Illuminates when the computer is on, and blinks when the computer is in Sleep mode.



**Charging** — Illuminates when the battery is charging: Flashes when the battery is low.



**AC Adapter** — Illuminates when you plug in the AC Adapter. When the AC Adapter is plugged in and the battery life is under 100%. the battery is charging.



Num Lock — Illuminates when the Number Lock is on. You can use the embedded numeric keypad to enter numbers.



**Caps Lock** — Illuminates when the Caps Lock is on. When used, letters are typed in uppercase.



**Scroll Lock** — Illuminates when the Scroll Lock is on; text that takes up more that a full screen scrolls up the screen line-by-line.

### **TOUCHPAD**

The pointer on the screen follows your finger movements on the touchpad. You can use your finger as a pointer to draw lines or point to items on the desktop. To simulate a mouse-click, press the left touchpad button which is located directly below the touchpad. To doubleclick on an item, move the pointer over the item and press the left touchpad button twice.
