

BATTERY REPLACEMENT: Use a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to open battery door. Insert 4 AA alkaline batteries (not included) as shown. Replace battery door and screw shut. For longer life use only alkaline batteries. Dispose of batteries safely. Replace batteries when the glitter stream is flowing too slow.

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

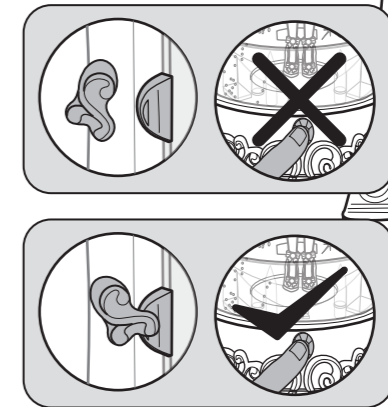
2. Place inside.



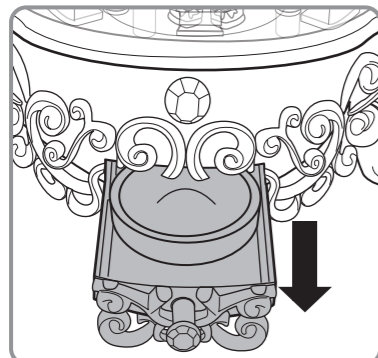

Close the door.

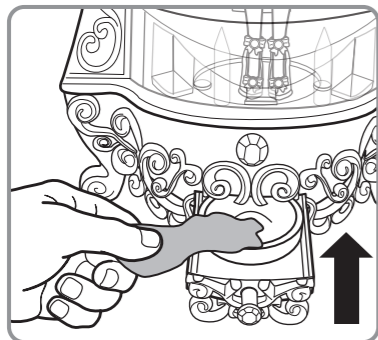

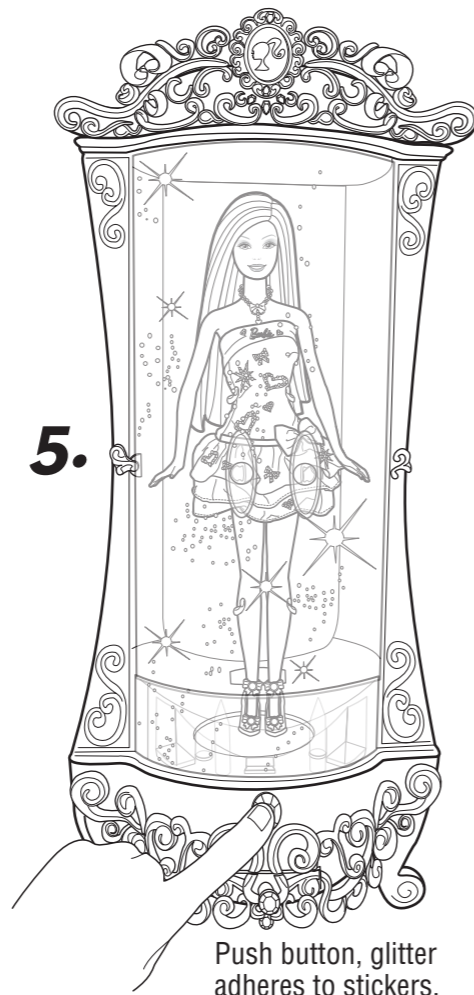


Open the glitter packet and load with glitter.

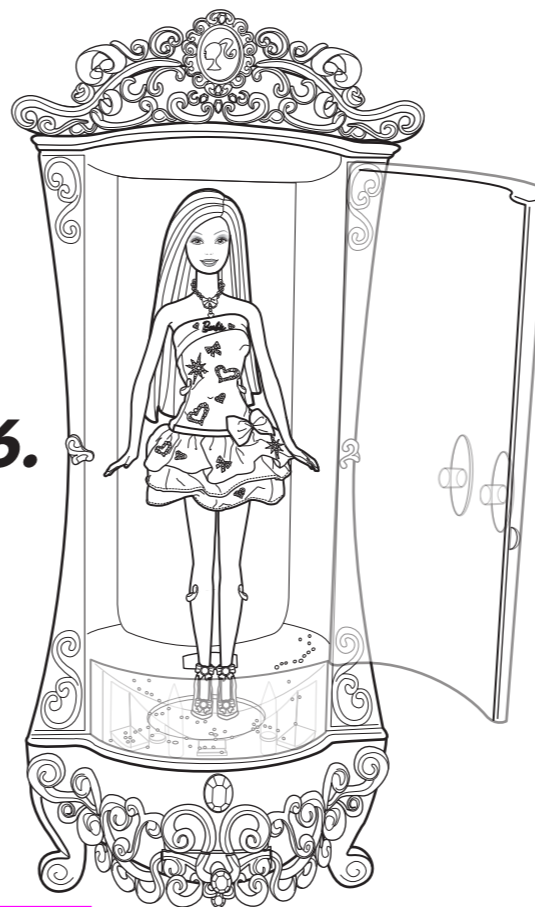

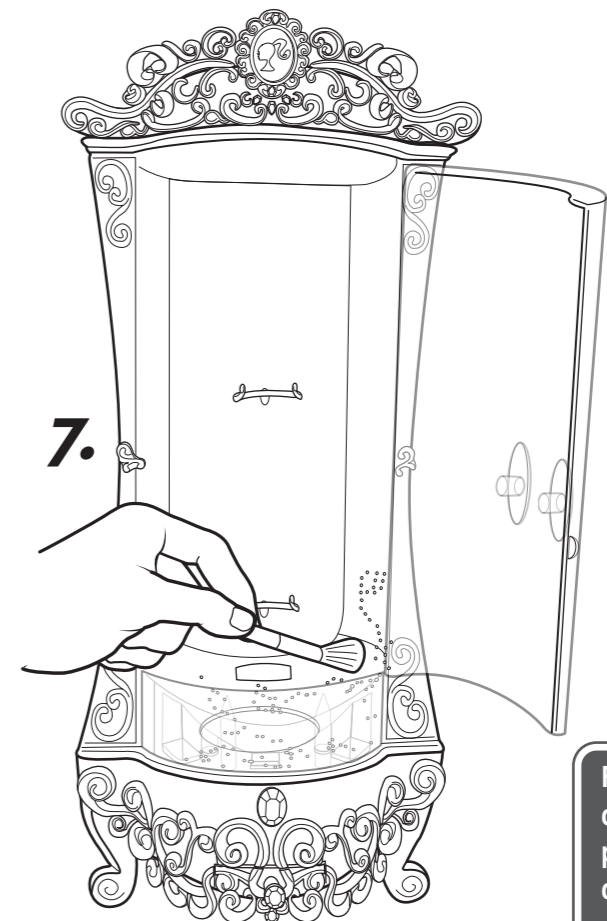
Push button, glitter adheres to stickers.
