

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PR150/300 & IP150 Separate Drain for Upper Driptray

 Raise and lock driptray assembly (see FIGURE 1).

2. Clean out and dry driptray with a rag or paper towel, remove strainer if applicable (see FIGURE 2 and FIGURE 3).

3. Remove insulation from driptray drain line assembly (see FIGURE 4).

4. Cut PVC drain as shown in FIGURE 5. **BE**CAREFUL TO SECURELY HOLD DRAIN LINE
TO AVOID DAMAGE TO UPPER DRIPTRAY!!!

 Deburr edge of PVC and re-plumb and clamp with new flexible tube/clamp supplied in kit (see FIGURE 6). MAKE SURE THAT THE INSULATION COVERS ALL EXPOSED TUBING/CLAMP!

- 6. Re-route new drain tube to floor drain. MAKE SURE THAT THERE ARE NO KINKS IN NEW DRAIN LINE!
- 7. Re-install driptray strainer if applicable.
- 8. Check driptray, fittings, and lines for leaks.
- 9. Lower upper driptray assembly.
