

SYSTEM DATE/TIME SETTING

From designated digital telephones only.

With the handset in cradle Press FNC kev

Dial 9#. FNC LED flashes, changing the mode

to time adjustment mode.

Adjust the hours and minutes with the dial pad. Dial# to move the display cursor to the right.

Dial* to move the display cursor to the left.

Press the HOLD key. Clock display is recorded, changing the date adjustment mode. Adjust the day of the week using the

RECALL kev.

Dial # to move to the Day Adjust the Day with the dial pad

Dial the Month using the RECALL key

Dial # to move to the Year Adjust the Year with the Dial pad Press FNC key to save the settings

NOTE: To set the time only press the FNC key instead of the HOLD key after adjusting the time.
