








The following calculations assume the top of the panel is aligned with the top of the adjacent cabinetry:


#### width of the panel

Measure **A** (the width between adjacent door/drawer fronts) and write it in the first box below, then complete the equation.



### height of the panel

Measure  ${\bf B}$  (door/drawer height (or equivalent)) and write it in the first box below, then complete the equation.




Note: when the top of the DishDrawer<sup>®</sup> has to be lower than the adjacent cabinetry, the panel can be increased in height.


### **Front Panel material**

- Adequately sealed to withstand moisture (122°F/50°C @ 80% RH)






## **5** REMOVE PANEL BRACKET & DETACH BADGE




### 6 ROUTE BADGE THROUGH PANEL














