


## Manual abstract:

If the fuse cover is lost or damaged, the plug must not be used until a replacement available from the appliance manufacturer is obtained. If the plug has to be changed because it is not suitable for your socket, or becomes damaged, it should be cut off and an appropriate plug fitted following the wiring instructions below. Do not connect either wire to the earth terminal which is marked by the letter E or by the safety earth symbol or coloured green or green-and-yellow. Use a 5A BS1362 fuse which is approved by ASTA or BSI. Always replace the fuse cover after changing the fuse.
