

### **For Windows Vista Users**

- 1 Connect the Wireless G USB Adapter into a USB port.
- 2 Insert the Resource CD in your CD-ROM.
- When Found New Hardware Wizard appears, select Locate and install driver software (Recommended).
- Select Don't search online.
- **5** A screen appears informing you that Windows is searching for the driver software in the Resource CD. Click Next.
- 6 When a message appears informing you that Windows cannot verify the driver software, click Install the driver software Anyway.
- Click Finish. A new icon appears in the Notification area 🙀



8 Right-click in the Notification area of the Taskbar and then select Connect to a network.



9 Select a network to connect to and then click Connect. Enter the security key when required.

### For Windows XP

#### Do not connect WL230USB until the Utility is completely installed.

- 1 Insert the Resource CD in your CD-ROM. This opens the WL230USB Wireless B+G Utility Setup. If the Setup did not open automatically,
- 2 select Start > Run. Enter d:\setup.exe, where d is the CD-ROM drive.
- Click Next.
- 4 Click Next.
- 6 Click Next. The Setup Status displays the installation progress.
- 6 Click Finish.
- Connect WL230USB to an available USB port. This opens the Found New Hardware Wizard.
- 8 Select No, not this time and then click Next.
- **9** Select Install the software automatically (Recommended) and then click Next.
- 10 Click Continue Anyway when the Hardware Installation dialog box appears.
- 11 Click Finish.
- A new icon appears in the System tray 🛂 . Double-click this icon to open WL230USB Wireless B+G Utility.
- Click Site Survey.
- Select an ESSID and then click Join. The Privacy Configuration dialog box opens when a Network key is required. Enter the Network key, confirm the Network key, and then click OK.
