

## DT04-12U1 12.1" Liquid Crystal Display TV

## **Front View**



# **Making Connections**

#### **Connecting to Antenna/Cable TV**



- Connect one end of the VHF/UHF
   (Antenna) or CATV cable to ANT
   Jack (VHF/UHF IN Jack) on the back
   of the TV.
- Connect the other end of the VHF/UHF (Antenna) or CATV cable to the Antenna or CATV socket.

# A/V and Channel Setup

### **Watching Broadcast or Cable TV**

- After you have made the appropriate power and source connections, press the power button to turn on your television
- 2. Press the **SOURCE** button to select TV.
- 3. Press the **MENU** button on the control panel to enter the OSD menu.
- 4. Press the  $\mathbf{CH} \triangle$  button to select the TV setting.
- 5. Press the **MENU** button.
- 6. Press the  $\textbf{CH} \, \triangle$  button to select TV/CATV.


#### Selecting A/V Sources

- 1. Make sure your TV is turned on and a device such as a DVD player is connected.
- Press the SOURCE button on the control panel to select different source signals. TV/CATV channel number, AV1 or AV2 appear on the screen.




#### Connecting to a VCR, VCD, DVD Player, or Video Game Console

#### **Connecting the Power Adapter**



- 1. Connect the power cord to the power adapter as illustrated.
- 2. Plug the power adapter connector into the DC-IN input jack on the rear panel of the TV.
- 3. Insert the three-pronged plug at the other end of the power cord into a power outlet.

**Auto Channel Setup** 

- 1. Press the **MENU** button to enter the OSD menu.
- 2. Use the channel buttons on the control panel to select the "TV Setting" menu.
- 3. Press the **MENU** button to enter the TV Setting menu.
- 4. Press channel buttons to select Auto Program.
- 5. Press the **MENU** button to enter the Auto Program Setting submenu.
- 6. Press channel buttons to select ON or OFF and press the MENU button .
- 7. Your television will begin automatically memorizing the available channels.
