



Keep children, bystanders, and animals 50 feet (15 meters) away. If approached stop unit immediately.

OPERATOR SAFETY

- Always wear safety eye protection.
- Always wear long pants, long sleeves, boots, and gloves. Wearing safety leg guards is recommended. Do not go barefoot or wear sandals. Stay clear of spinning line.

- Secure hair above shoulder length. Secure or remove loose clothing or clothing with loosely hanging ties, straps, tassels, etc. They can be caught in moving parts.
- Do not operate this unit when you are tired, ill, or under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or medication.
- Wear hearing protection if you use this unit for more than 1-1/2 hours per day.
- Never start or run inside a closed room or building. Breathing exhaust fumes can kill.
- Keep handles free of oil and fuel.

UNIT / MAINTENANCE SAFETY

- Disconnect spark plug before performing maintenance except carburetor adjustments.
- Look for and replace damaged or loose parts before each use. Look for and repair fuel leaks before use. Keep in good working condition.
- Replace trimmer head parts that are chipped, cracked, broken, or damaged in any other way before using the unit.
- Make sure unit is assembled correctly as shown in this manual.
- Make carburetor adjustments with lower end supported to prevent line from contacting any object.
- Keep others away when making carburetor adjustments.
- Use only recommended POULAN PRO accessories and replacement parts.

FUEL SAFETY

- · Mix and pour fuel outdoors.
- Keep away from sparks or flames.
- Use a container approved for fuel.
- Do not smoke or allow smoking near fuel or the unit.
- Wipe up all fuel spills.
- Move at least 10 feet (3 meters) away from fueling site before starting engine.
 Stop engine and allow to cool before re-
- Stop engine and allow to cool before removing fuel cap.

CUTTING SAFETY

- Use only for trimming, mowing, and sweeping. Do not use for edging, pruning, or hedge trimming.
- Inspect the area before each use. Remove objects (rocks, broken glass, nails, wire, etc.) which can be thrown by or become entangled in line. Hard objects can damage trimmer head and be thrown causing serious injury.
- Keep firm footing and balance. Do not overreach.
- Keep all parts of your body away from spinning line and muffler. Keep engine below waist level. A hot muffler can cause serious burns.
- Cutting with the line on right side of the shield will throw debris away from the operator.

TRANSPORTING AND STOR-**AGE**

- · Allow the engine to cool; secure unit before storing or transporting in vehicle.
- Empty the fuel tank before storing or transporting the unit. Use up fuel left in the carburetor by starting the engine and letting it run until it stops.
- Store unit and fuel in an area where fuel vapors cannot reach sparks or open flames from water heaters, electric motors or switches, furnaces, etc.
- · Store unit so line limiter cannot accidentally cause injury. Unit can be hung by the tube.
- Store the unit out of the reach of children If situations occur which are not covered in this manual, use care and good judgment. If you need assistance, call 1-800-554-6723.

SPECIAL NOTICE: This unit is not equipped with a temperature limiting muffler and spark arresting screen which meets the requirements of California Codes 4442 and 4443. All U.S. forest land and the states of California, Idaho, Maine, Minnesota, New Jersey, Oregon, and Washington require by law that many internal combustion engines to be equipped with a spark arrestor screen. If you operate in a locale where such regulations exist, you are legally responsible for installing and maintaining the operating condition of these parts. Failure to do so is a violation of the law. If a spark arrestor is required in your area, contact your Authorized Service Dealer for the proper kit.

ASSEMBLY

WARNING: Make sure your unit is properly assembled and all fasteners are secure.


ADJUST THE HANDLE

- Loosen wing nut or plastic knob on handle.Rotate handle to upright position and tighten in a comfortable position between the trigger and the safety label on the tube. Tighten handle securely.

ATTACH THE SHIELD

WARNING: The shield must be properly installed. The shield provides partial protection from the risk of thrown objects to the operator and others and is equipped with a line limiter which cuts excess line. The line limiter (on underside of shield) is sharp and can cut you.


- Insert bracket into slot on shield.
- Pivot shield until bolt passes through hole in bracket.
- Securely tighten wing nut.
- Remové packing cover from the arbor shaft if so equipped.
- Thread trimmer head onto shaft; tighten securely against dust cup.



FUEL YOUR UNIT

This engine is certified to operate on unleaded gasoline. Gasoline must be mixed with a good quality 2-cycle air-cooled engine oil designed to be mixed at a ratio of 40:1. Poulan/Weed Eater brand oil is recommended. (A 40:1 ratio is obtained by mixing 3.2 ounces of oil with 1 gallon of unleaded gasoline). When mixing fuel follow the instructions printed on the container. Always read and follow the safety rules under FUEL SAFETY.

STARTING



HOW TO STOP YOUR UNIT

Push and hold the stop switch in the STOP or OFF position until the unit has fully stopped.

WARNING: The trimmer head will turn while starting the engine. A hot muffler can cause serious burns.

HOW TO START YOUR UNIT

· Rest engine and shield on ground.

STARTING A COLD ENGINE OR A WARM ENGINE THAT HAS **RUN OUT OF FUEL.**

- Move the switch to the ON position.
- Slowly press the primer bulb 6 times.
- Move choke lever to FULL CHOKE position.
- Squeeze and hold throttle trigger through all remaining steps..
- Pull starter rope handle sharply 6 times.
- Move the choke lever to HALF CHOKE position
- Pull the starter rope handle no more than 6 pulls, until engine runs.
- Allow the engine to run 10 seconds, then move choke lever to OFF CHOKE position.

RESTARTING A WARM ENGINE

- Move choke lever to HALF CHOKE position.
- Pull starter rope handle until engine runs.
- If engine does not start in 5 pulls, follow instructions in STARTING A COLD ENGINE

USING YOUR UNIT

OPERATING POSITION




Cut from your left to your right.

ADVANCING THE CUTTING LINE


Advance line by tapping the bottom of the cut-ting head lightly on the ground while engine is running at full speed. A metal blade attached to the shield will cut the line to the proper length.

REPLACING THE LINE

- Press the lock tabs and remove the cover.
- · Remove the lock ring, tap button, and



- · Check the indexing teeth on the spool and hub for wear.
- · Use a clean cloth to wipe the inner/outer surfaces of the spool and hub.
- · Use only .080 inch (2 mm) diameter line.
- · Cut two lengths of line approximately 20
- Insert line into the small hole in the spool.



- Wind the line evenly and tightly onto the spool; wind indirection of arrow found on spool. Leave 4-6 inches (10-15 cm) of line unwound.
- Insert line into the line exit hole in the hub.
 Push spool into hub. Press spool down, then turn it to catch spool tabs under gear tabs
- · Re-install the tap button, lock ring, and cov-
- Pull the end of the line to set spool in the operating position.

SERVICE

We recommend all service and adjustments not listed in this manual be performed by an Authorized Service Dealer.

CARBURETOR ADJUSTMENTS

Your carburetor is equipped with limiter caps. Carburetor adjustments is a complicated task. We recommend that you take your unit to an Authorized Service Déaler. Damage will occur if you turn the needles beyond the limiter stops.

IGNITION TIMING

The ignition timing is fixed, non-adjustable.

SPARK PLUG

Replace the spark plug yearly using a Champion RCJ8Y plug. Spark plug gap is .025".

TROUBLESHOOTING

Engine will not start.

- Fuel tank empty.
- Engine flooded
- · Spark plug not firing.
- Fuel not reaching carburetor.
- Carburetor requires adjustment.

Engine will not idle properly.

- · Carburetor requires adjustment.
- Throttle trigger screw too tight.

Engine will not accelerate, lacks power, or dies under a load.

Engine smokes excessively.

- Air filter dirty.

Line does not advance or breaks while cuttina

Line welds onto spool.

- Line size incorrect
