For TravelMate 5000

Follow these steps to connect Acer EasyPort:

- 1 Remove the cap from the orange power jack on the back of the EasyPort, next to the connector cable.
- 2 Insert the cap into the 90W DC-in jack on the front of the EasyPort.
- 3 Plug the EasyPort power cord into the orange power jack on the back of the EasyPort.
- 4 Connect the EasyPort power cord (1) and cable to the computer (2).
- 5 Plug the power adapter that came with your notebook into the 135W DC-in jack (3) on the EasyPort.



Follow these steps to connect Acer Easyport

- 1 Connect the cable to the computer (1).
- 2 Plug the power adapter that came with your notebook into the 90W DC-in jack (2) on the EasyPort.
