- If the screen suddenly flashes erratically or the backlighting fails, please contact your dealer or service center for repair. Do not attempt to repair the monitor yourself.








Figure.1. Installing and Removing the Base

#### **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Carefully place the monitor face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc) to prevent any damage to the monitor.
- 2. Align the base with the opening of the stand.
- 3. Snap the base into stand. A clear click sound will affirm that the base is connected correctly.
- 4. Verify that the base is securely attached to the stand by looking at the release button of the base is fully engaged in the slot of the stand.

#### REMOVAL:

- 1. Carefully place the monitor face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc) to prevent any damage to the monitor.
- 2 Press the release button as indicated
- 3. Follow the arrow direction to remove the base.


#### **POWER**

#### **POWER SOURCE:**

- 1. Make sure that the power cord is the correct type required in your area.
- 2. This LCD monitor has an Internal universal power supply that allows operation in either 100/120V AC or 220/240V AC voltage area (No user adjustment is required.)
- 3. Connect the AC-power cord one end to your LCD monitor's AC-input socket, the other end to wall-outlet.

# SETTING THE MONITOR ON THE WALL DISSEMBLING THE STAND BASE:


- 1. Disconnect all the cables and cords from the Monitor to prevent damage.
- 2. Carefully place the monitor face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc) to prevent any damage to the monitor.
- 3. Press the release button as indicated, follow the arrow direction to remove the base.
- 4. Remove the three (3) screws so that the stand cover can be removed.
- 5. Remove the three (3) screws so that the hinge assembly can be removed.



(For reference only)

#### WALL MOUNTING THE MONITOR:

- 1. Purchase a VESA compatible wall bracket: VESA 100x100, 4 holes, M4, 10 mm, 8 kg.
- 2. Locate your ideal Monitor position on the wall.
- 3. Fix the wall bracket firmly on the wall.
- 4. Secure the Monitor to the bracket using the 4 mount holes on the back and center of the Monitor.



#### Note:

- Please read the instructions of your specific wall bracket to properly wall mount the Monitor.
- The pitch of the mounting holes is 100 mm horizontally and 100 mm vertically.
- The screws type required is metric: M4, 10 mm length.
- The Monitor stand base can be screwed on a table or a hard surface using the hole on the back of the stand base.

\*Installing the LCD Monitor requires special skill that should only be performed by qualified service personnel. Customers should not attempt to do the work themselves. Hanns.G bears no responsibility for improper mounting or mounting that results in accident or injury. You can ask qualified service personnel about using an optional bracket to mount the Monitor to the wall.

#### MAKING CONNECTIONS

#### **CONNECTING TO A PC**

Turn off your computer before performing the procedure below.

- 1. Connect one end of the VGA cable to the back of the monitor and connect the other end to the computer's VGA port.
- 2. Connect one end of the DVI cable to the back of the monitor and connect the other end to the computer's DVI port.
- 3. You must use the enclosed dual-link DVI cable for 120 Hz and 3D functionality.
- 4. Connect one end of the HDMI to DVI cable (optional) to the back of the monitor and connect the other end to the computer's DVI port.
- 5. Connect one end of the HDMI cable (optional) to the back of the monitor and connect the other end to the computer's HDMI port.
- 6. Connect the audio cable (optional) between the monitor's HDMI Line Out and the external audio amplifier unit.
- 7. Plug one end of the AC power cord to the LCD monitor's AC input socket, and the other end to Wall outlet.
- 8. Turn on your monitor and computer.




Figure.2. Connecting to a PC

#### ADJUSTING THE VIEWING ANGLE

- For optimal viewing it is recommended to look at the full face of the monitor, then adjust the monitor's angle to your own preference.
- Hold the stand so you do not topple the monitor when you change the monitor's angle.
- You are able to adjust the monitor's angle from -5° to 15°.




Figure.3. Monitor Angle

#### **NOTES:**

- Do not touch the LCD screen when you change the angle. It may cause damage or break the LCD screen
- Be careful not to place fingers or hands near the hinges when tilting the monitor, otherwise pinching can result.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**




Figure.4. Control Panel Buttons

Press the power button to turn the monitor on or off. The other control buttons are located on the front panel of the monitor (See Figure 4). By changing these settings, the picture can be adjusted to your personal preferences.

- The power cord should be connected.
- Connect the Signal cable from the monitor to the VGA card.
- Press the power button to turn on the monitor. The power indicator will light up.

#### FRONT PANEL CONTROL

#### • Power Button:

Press this button to switch ON/OFF of monitor's power.

#### • Power Indicator:

Blue — Power On mode. Orange — Power Saving mode.

#### • MENU:

- 1. Turn the OSD menu on.
- 2. Enter sub menu when OSD menu is ON.

#### • Adjust **▲ ▼**:

- 1. Invalid when the OSD menu is off.
- 2. Navigate through adjustment icons when OSD is ON or adjust a function when function is activated.

#### • [ i ] Button:

- 1. Press this button will start  $\lceil$  Auto Adjust $\rfloor$  function when the OSD menu is off. (The auto adjustment function is used to optimize the  $\lceil$  horizontal position $\rfloor$ ,  $\lceil$  vertical position $\rfloor$ ,  $\lceil$  clock $\rfloor$ , and  $\lceil$  phase $\rfloor$ ).
- 2. When the OSD menu is off, press this button for 5 seconds to select one of the following input source  $\lceil VGA \rfloor$ ,  $\lceil DVI \rfloor$ ,  $\lceil HDMI \rfloor$ .
- 3. Exit current menu when OSD is ON.

#### • Hotkeys:

#### 1. Power Lock and Unlock:

Press the 【MENU】 and 【▼】 keys at the same time for 10 seconds to lock or unlock the power button.

#### 2. OSD Lock and Unlock:

Press the **[MENU]** and **[**  $\triangle$  **]** keys at the same time for 10 seconds to lock or unlock OSD buttons.

#### **NOTES:**

- Do not install the monitor in a location near heat sources such as radiators or air dusts, or in a place subject to direct sunlight, or excessive dust or mechanical vibration or shock.
- Save the original shipping box and packing materials, as they will come in handy if you ever have to ship your monitor.
- For maximum protection, repackage your monitor as it was originally packed at the factory.
- To keep the monitor looking new, periodically clean it with a soft cloth. Stubborn stains may be removed with a cloth lightly dampened with a mild detergent solution. Never use strong solvents such as thinner, benzene, or abrasive cleaners, since these will damage the cabinet. As a safety precaution, always unplug the monitor before cleaning it.

H-POSITION	Select the 「H-POSITION」 option to shift the screen image to the left or right. Enter the option and adjust the level. [For VGA only]
V-POSITION	Select the 「V-POSITION」 option to shift the screen image up or down. Enter the option and adjust the level. [For VGA only]
PHASE	Select the $\lceil PHASE \rfloor$ option to automatic optimize image. [For VGA only]

#### PLUG AND PLAY

#### Plug & Play DDC2B Feature

This monitor is equipped with VESA DDC2B capabilities according to the VESA DDC STANDARD. It allows the monitor to inform the host system of its identity and, depending on the level of DDC used, communicate additional information about its display capabilities. The DDC2B is a bidirectional data channel based on the I<sup>2</sup>C protocol. The host can request EDID information over the DDC2B channel.

# THIS MONITOR WILL APPEAR TO BE NON-FUNCTIONAL IF THERE IS NO VIDEO INPUT SIGNAL. IN ORDER FOR THIS MONITOR TO OPERATE PROPERLY, THERE MUST BE A VIDEO INPUT SIGNAL.

This monitor meets the Green monitor standards as set by the Video Electronics Standards Association (VESA) and/or the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and The Swedish Confederation Employees (NUTEK). This feature is designed to conserve electrical energy by reducing power consumption when there is no video-input signal present. When there is no video input signal this monitor, following a time-out period, will automatically switch to power saving mode. This reduces the monitor's internal power supply consumption. After the video input signal is restored, full power is restored and the display is automatically redrawn. The appearance is similar to a "Screen Saver" feature except the display is completely off. The display is restored by pressing a key on the keyboard, or clicking the mouse.

The LED should either turn ON or OFF after hitting the CAPS LOCK key.
Missing one of the primary colors (RED, GREEN, or BLUE)	*Inspect the monitor's video cable and make sure that none of the pins are bent.
Screen image is not centered or sized properly.	* Adjust pixel frequency CLOCK or press i Button.
Picture has color defects (White does not look white)	*Adjust RGB color or select color temperature.
The screen resolution needs to be adjusted	*Use win 2000/ME/XP Right click anywhere on desktop and select <b>Properties&gt;Settings&gt;Screen Resolution</b> . Use the silder to adjust the reslution and click <b>Apply.</b>
No HDMI sound is outputted from monitor's audio line out	*Make sure cable connection is correct.  *Make sure the video input source is "HDMI mode"  *Make sure graphic card output is HDMI with audio.  *Make sure PC audio volume is not mute.

#### Addendum related to Windows 7

When you encounter display problem under Windows 7, you need to do the following:

- 1. Make sure your PC computer (Hardware requirement) can support Windows 7.
- 2. Make sure your video card can run Windows 7.
- 3. If your video card can support Windows 7, need to install the latest Win 7 driver of your video card.

#### Suggest to do the following:

- 1. Install the latest Windows 7 video driver of your video card.
- 2. Try to use the recommended display resolution that is supported by the monitor.
- 3. If the recommended display resolution is not working, try the second recommended display resolution.
