

## Norstar M7310 Station Set

Pressing LINE followed by a digit (1-9) on the Wireless Telephone is equivalent to pressing one of the 9 line keys on the M7310.
Pressing FCN followed by a digit (2-9) on the SpectraLink Wireless Telephone is equivalent to pressing one of the memory buttons on the top of the M7310 set. FCN 1 is reserved for MUTE.
Memory buttons 10-12 on the M7310 cannot be accessed from the SpectraLink wireless telephone.
FCN followed by $\mathbf{0}$, * and \#, is equivalent to pressing one of the three soft keys just below your display.
Pressing LINE * gives you access to your Feature programming. LINE $\mathbf{O}$ allows you to release the phone call.

Wireless Telephone Quick Reference Guide


SpectraLink 6020 Wireless Telephone
On/Off Press and hold END. Two chirps on, one chirp off

Make a call Press START to get dial tone.
Hang up Press END. Be sure to do this at the end of each call.
Answer call Press START. Line indicator comes on steady when the call is answered.
Answer Press HOLD to put your current second call call on hold, or END to hang up. Press LINE + the digit that is flashing.

Hold Press HOLD
Take off Hold Press LINE followed by the digit for the line on hold, which will be flashing.
Mute On/Off Press the MUTE softkey.
Function Pressing FCN while off hook allows you to scroll through menu screens.

User Options Press the CFG softkey while on hook to change handset settings.
