

## Record in Hi-Definition! Video Recording Guide

**1 Turn off the camera and attach the battery pack**

Battery

Set the power/mode switch to **OFF (CHARGE)**

**2 Charge the battery pack**  
Required charging time (approx.): 2 hr. 40 min.

To AC Outlet (110V to 240V)

Blinks while charging. When the lamp goes out, charging is finished.

**3 Open the lens cover**

Lens cover switch

LENS COVER

**4 Open the LCD monitor**

LCD monitor

**5 Set the power/mode switch to ON**

Slide while pressing down the lock button

**6 Select auto recording mode**

AUTO

The mode changes when you press the button

<b>Auto recording mode</b>	<b>Manual recording mode</b>
<b>A</b>	<b>M</b>

**7 Start recording**

REC

Press **REC** button to start recording, and press it again to stop

Picture Quality	Remaining space on the hard disk

Recording	Record-standby

**When the recording is failed...**  
Check the LCD monitor one more time.

**1 Did you select video mode?**

**2 Did you select video recording mode?**

<b>While recording</b>	<b>While playing back</b>

**SELECT PLAY/REC**

The mode changes when you press the button

**1 Follow the procedures 1 to 6 shown in the left side of this sheet**

**2 Select playback mode**

**SELECT PLAY/REC**

The mode changes when you press the button

Selected video file

**3 Move the set lever to ^/~/</> to select the desired file**

**4 Press down the set lever to start playback**

Press down the set lever

**Basic Operations during Playback**

Return to the first scene of the file

Play/Pause

Reverse search

Forward search

Go to the first scene of the next file

# Back-Up Hi-Definition Images (Easy and correct way of copying to a DVD)

## 1. Get ready a recommended disc

Please use the recommended discs stated below.  
Using discs other than those recommended may cause problem when copying to the DVD and when playing back the DVD.

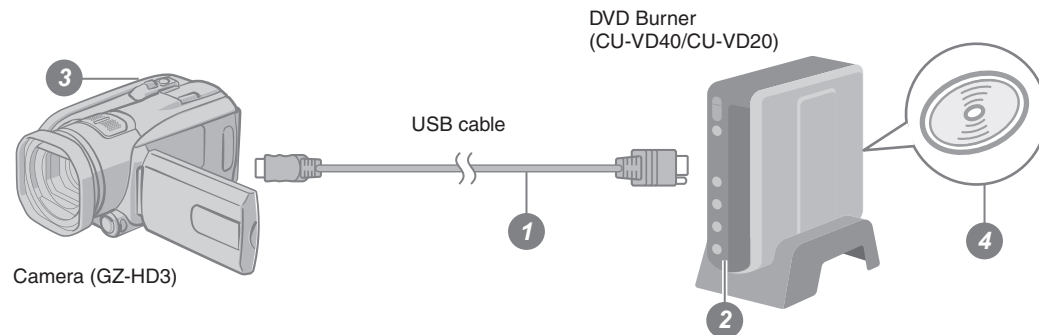
### Recommended discs

	DVD-R	DVD-RW	DVD-R DL (single-sided double layer)
Brand	JVC TDK Verbatim SONY	JVC	JVC Verbatim

### Caution

- Only DVD-R and DVD-RW discs can be used.
- Recording and playback may not function properly if the recording side is scratched or dirty.

## 2. Set up each device before copying



- 1 Connect the USB cable provided with DVD Burner (CU-VD40/CU-VD20)**
- 2 Turn on the DVD Burner**  
After turning on the power, wait for approximately 20 seconds before proceeding to step 3.  
The burner may not function properly within this 20 seconds.
- 3 Turn on the camera (GZ-HD3)**
- 4 Insert a new recommended disc into the DVD Burner**

Next, operate the camera (GZ-HD3). Proceed to step 3. ➔

## 3. Copy all images to the DVD

Perform operations on the camera.

- 1 Confirm that the display on the right appears on the LCD screen of the camera (GZ-HD3)**
- 2 Select “NORMAL BACK-UP”**  
① Select (move up and down)  
② Confirm (press down)
- 3 Select “ALL”**  
① Select (move up and down)  
② Confirm (press down)
- 4 Select “EXECUTE AND FINALIZE”**  
① Select (move up and down)  
② Confirm (press down)

**IMPORTANT**

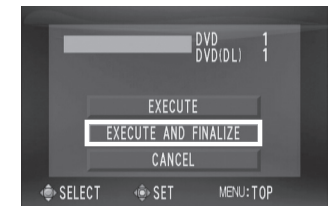
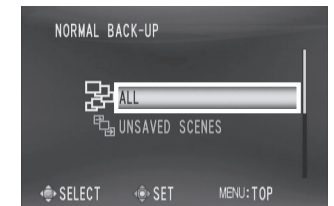
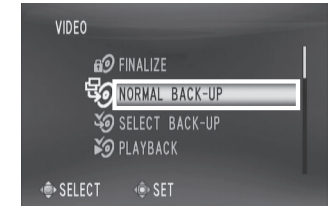
- Playback is not possible if the disc is not finalized.
- Wait for the “copy in progress” screen on the right and the “hourglass” mark to disappear, then turn off the power and disconnect the USB cable.

- 5 Exit**  
Confirm (press down)

### Note

- There are other ways of copying which includes copying only the desired files. For details, refer to the instruction manual of the camera (GZ-HD3).
