

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# **Getting Started**

# Removing the Printer




Fig. 1 Removing the Printer

<u>Always</u> use two people to lift the printer. Place printer on a stable surface with adequate ventilation and operation clearance.

Do not install the printer where it will be:

- Subject to direct sunlight, air currents, magnetic fields, water, or high humidity
- · Close to heaters
- Exposed to vibrations or high dust levels
- Close to an open flame
- Subject to extreme temperature and humidity variations.

Your printer package contain the following items:

- Printer
- 250 sheet cassette
- Power cord
- Envelope adapter
- Utilities and Manual CD-ROM
- Consumables (4 starter toner cartridges\*, OPC belt cartridge, oil bottle, oil syringe, cleaning roller).

\*Starter cartridges are rated at half-life.

# **Installing Toner Cartridges**




Fig. 2 Shake toner cartridge.




Fig. 3 Remove orange protective cover.




Fig. 4 Open front cover.




Fig. 5 Align and insert each cartridge into it's corresponding color slot.

# Installing OPC Belt Cartridge

ote: Never touch the OPC belt's surface; only handle the cartridge by the top handle.

Touching the belt and exposing it to bright light (over two minutes) may cause permanent damage.

If the belt is over exposed to light, there is a chance you may be able to salvage it by placing it in a dark room for several hours.




Fig. 6 Pivot OPC guides up toward the printer's front.




Fig. 7 Pull 2 pins out from sides; remove sheet.




Fig. 8 Align the OPC cartridge's side tabs with the printer's OPC guides. Then, lower cartridge into place and close guides.

Fig. 9 Open the two oil bottle locks by turning out to the sides.




Fig. 10 Insert bottle nozzle down; close locks.

# Installing the Cleaning Roller




Fig. 11 Open cleaning roller locks.




Fig. 12 Align and insert the cleaning roller into place. Close cleaning roller locks.

# **Installing the Paper Cassette**




Fig. 13 Remove cassette cover.




Fig. 14 Adjust length guide.




Fig. 15 Adjust width guide.




Fig. 16 Load media print side up.




Fig. 17 Replace the cassette cover.

#### **Connecting to Printer Ports**




Fig. 19 Connect to appropriate interface.

XANTÉ ColourLaser printers have standard LocalTalk, serial, parallel, and Ethernet ports (fig. 19).

These simultaneously active interfaces can receive jobs from different operating environments without switching hardware.

LocalTalk Connection (Macintosh)




Fig. 20 LocalTalk Connector Boxes, Resistors, and Cable

- 1. Turn off your computer.
- 2. Plug the DIN-8 connector on one LocalTalk connector box into the printer's 8-pin LocalTalk port.

- 3. Plug the DIN-8 connector on the second LocalTalk connector box into the Macintosh's printer port.
- 4. Connect the two LocalTalk connector boxes with the RJ-11 phone cable (standard phone cable).
- 5. Plug the terminating resistors into the open sockets in the connector boxes.

Note: iMacs and Power Mac G4s do not have LocalTalk ports. These computers can be connected using Crossover/patch cables and the Ethernet port or they can be connected to LocalTalk

networks using Ethernet to LocalTalk adapters. Check your user's manual for more information.

#### Parallel Connection (PC)

- 1. Turn of your computer.
- 2. Plug the cable's 36-pin connector into the printer's parallel port and the 25-pin connector into the computer's parallel port.

#### Serial Connection (PC)




Fig. 22 Serial Cables

- 1. Turn off your computer.
- 2. Plug the serial cable's 9-pin male connector into the printer's serial port.

3. Plug the other connector (either a 25-pin or a 9-pin female connector) into the computer's serial port.

Ethernet Connection (PC and Mac)




Fig. 23 Connect to Ethernet port.

- 1. Turn off your computer.
- 2. Connect one end of the CAT 5
  Ethernet cable to your printer's
  Ethernet port.
- 3. Connect the cable's other end to the appropriate port on your network.

# Connecting the Power Cable

Warning!

into a properly grounded AC outlet. *Do not* use and extension cord. Use a surge protected outlet to help prevent power source fluctuations from damaging your printer.

Be sure to plug the printer




Fig. 24 Connect power cord to printer.




Fig. 25 Press the power switch on.




Fig. 26 Start-up page prints (if enabled).

#### **Media Types**

Your XANTÉ printer supports plain paper, transparencies, laser-quality labels, thick paper stock, and envelopes; up to 16 to 24 lb. bond plain paper (60 - 90 g/m²); thick stock: 60 lb. cover or 90 lb. index (163 g/m²).

# **Installing Adobe Acrobat Reader**

#### Adobe Acrobat Reader-PC

You will need to install Adobe Acrobat Reader to view or print your printer documentation.




Fig. 30 Setup Complete; click OK.




Fig. 31 Select Acrobat Reader.




Fig. 32 Click Continue.

### Installation - Windows 98/Me

This section will take you step-bystep through the installation process.

#### **IP Address Configuration**

When using the IP Address interface, use the keys on the front panel to set the address as follows:

- Reset key increases the current number flashing by one.
- Menu key moves to the next number to the right of the current number flashing.

- Test key moves to the next number to the left of the current number flashing.
- Enter key accepts new address (if valid) and returns to I/F:IP Address menu. The menu will display a message if the address entered is invalid.

**Note:** You must turn off the printer and restart it for the new IP address to take effect.




Fig. 40 Read Setup Information. Click Yes.

# Configuring IP, SubNet, and Gateway Addresses

- 1. From the ps\_files folder on the XANTÉ CD-ROM, copy dhcpoff.ps
- 2. Go to DOS (Command) Prompt.
- 3. Type copy dhcpoff.ps lpt1.

to your c:\ drive.

4. Power cycle the printer (turn off, then back on).

- 5. Using a word processing application, open setipsub.ps file from the ps\_files folder. Edit the file so it contains the IP, Subnet, and Gateway address you obtained from your network administrator. Save the file to your c:\ drive.
- 6. Go to DOS (Command) Prompt.
- 7. Type copy setipsub.ps lpt1.
- 8. Power cycle the printer again and verify that the start-up page contains your IP, Subnet, and Gateway addresses.

Go to DOS (Command) Prompt to ping the printer.
 c:\ping (IP Address)

*Note:* If you *can* ping the printer, go on to step 10. If you *cannot* ping your printer, contact your Network Administrator.

- 3. Click the Device Options tab (fig. 72).

#### Installation - Windows NT/2000/XP

This section is the installation instructions for Windows NT/2000/XP only.

#### **IP Address Configuration**

When using the IP Address interface, use the keys on the front panel to set the address as follows:

- **Reset** key increases the current number flashing by one.
- Menu key moves to the next number to the right of the current number flashing.

- Test key moves to the next number to the left of the current number flashing.




Fig. 77 Read File Destination. Click Yes.

# Configuring IP, SubNet, and Gateway Addresses

- From the ps\_files folder on the XANTÉ CD-ROM, copy dhcpoff.ps to your c:\ drive.
- 2. Go to DOS (Command) Prompt.
- 3. Type copy dhcpoff.ps lpt1.
- 4. Power cycle the printer (turn off, then back on).
- 5. Using a word processing application, open setipsub.ps file from the ps\_files folder. Edit the file so it contains the IP, Subnet, and Gateway address you obtained from your

- network administrator. Save the file to your c:\ drive.
- 6. Go to DOS (Command) Prompt.
- 7. Type copy setipsub.ps lpt1.
- 8. Power cycle the printer again and verify that the start-up page contains your IP, Subnet, and Gateway addresses.
- 9. Go to DOS (Command) Prompt to ping the printer.c:\ping (IP Address)

# **PPD Configuration**

- Select Start: Settings: Printers and Faxes.
- Highlight your printer and click the right mouse button. Select Properties from the drop-down menu.
- 3. Click the Device Settings tab (fig. 90).

# Installation - Macintosh (7.5 or higher)

If your Mac version is less than 8.1, some libraries required by **setup** are not available. If your system falls under this, select **Pre MacOS 8.1 Setup** from the CD-ROM.




Fig. 91 Select Install Printer.




Fig. 97 Select AdobePS Driver.




Fig. 103 Network Window

- Select Built-in Ethernet from the drop-down Show menu (fig. 103).
   Next, select the AppleTalk tab, select Make AppleTalk Active, and click Apply Now. Then, close the window.




Fig. 109 Page Setup Window




Fig. 110 Page Attributes Window




Fig. 111 Select File: Print; click Printer Features.




Fig. 112 Select Appropriate Features; click Print.




Fig. 116 Select Printer Menu: Show Options.




Fig. 117 Select Installable Options to configure your printer's options, resolution, and memory. Then, click Apply Changes.




Fig. 122 Select Appropriate Features; click Print.
