





Assembled arbor base with planters

IMPORTANT: The side panel width will determine the location of the braces. For  $17\frac{1}{2}$ " width arbors (Rosedale, Astoria, Nantucket and the Longevity) attach inside arbor base assembly arms. Refer to STEP 2A. For 24" width arbors (Victoria, Glendale, and the Casablanca) attach outside arbor base assembly arms. Refer to STEP 2B for .

#### STEP 1 STEP 2A




Attach 2 braces to each base assembly. Braces may go on outside of arms depending on Arbor width.




Attach braces to inside of arbor base assembly, then to arbor frame.
