Introduction

Congratulations on purchasing your new VCR.

You can't wait to get it working, but before you do, spare a few moments to read this brief introduction to the world of video recording. It may repay you handsomely in terms of improved results, and avoiding of costly mistakes.

Positioning

Do not place the VCR directly on top of, or underneath, your TV set. Ensure that there is at least 20 cm between the VCR and the TV set, and that air can circulate freely through the ventilation openings of the VCR.



DESCRIPTION OF CONTROLS

Front Panel



1 POWER button

- Turns the VCR on or off.
- Sets the VCR for an unattended recording (timer recording) after timer settings are completed. (*P.18)

2 STILL/PAUSE II button

Stops the tape during recording (pause) or playback (still picture). (№P.14, P.16) Press again to resume normal recording. Press PLAY ► to resume normal playback. Activates slow motion picture when pressed for more than 2 seconds during playback.

3 Cassette Compartment

Where a video cassette is inserted.

4 ►/OK button

Changes the selection when using the menus. (**P.11)

5 REC (record)/OTR ● button

- Starts recording when pressed once. (*P.14)
- Starts a recording for 30 minutes to 9 hours long when pressed more than once. The shut-off time increases in 30 minute intervals. (№P.15)

6 STOP/EJECT ■ / ▲ button

Stops the tape when the tape is running. (*P.14)

Press again to eject the cassette when the tape is not running. (*P.14)

7 PLAY ► button

Starts normal playback. (%P.14)

8 AUDIO/VIDEO input jacks

For connecting another VCR or a portable video camera. (*P.19)

9 COLOUR MODE button

Selects the colour mode both for playback and recording. (*P.13)

10 Display window

See page 8.

11 IR (infrared) remote sensor

Receives the signal from the (IR) remote control

12 MENU/EXIT button

Display the main menu. Press again to exit from the menu operations. (*P.11)

13 CHANNEL ▼ /▲ buttons

- Changes the channels on the VCR. Release at a desired channel.
- Moves the cursor up and down when using the menus. (*P.11)
- Adjusts the tracking during playback, still picture, and slow motion picture. (*P.17)

14 REW (Rewind) ◀◀ button

- Rewinds the tape when the tape is not running. (№P.14)
- Starts reverse rapid visual search during playback. (*P.14)

15 FF (Fast forward) ▶▶ button


- Fast forwards the tape when the tape is not running. (≈P.14)
- Starts forward rapid visual search during playback. (*P.14)

Remote Control (For VR588/55)



Using this remote control to operate other components

You can use this remote control to operate some of the PHILIPS TVs.

1 CBL/DBS button

Does not function for this model.

2 POWER button

Before using this button, press VCR or TV to select your target component.

- · After pressing VCR:
- Turns the VCR on or off.
- Sets the VCR for an unattended recording (timer recording) after timer settings are completed.

For some Philips TV only:

 After pressing TV, turns the TV on or off.

3 VCR/TV button

Does not function for this model.

4 SKIP SEARCH button

Skips playback for 30 seconds by time counter reading.

Stops the tape during recording (pause) or playback (still picture) temporarily. (*P.14, P.16)

Press again to resume normal recording. Press PLAY ► to resume normal playback. Activates slow motion picture when pressed for more than 2 seconds during playback.

Before using this button, press VCR.

- After pressing VCR:
 - Rewinds the tape. Also, during playback, starts rapid reverse visual search. (*P.14)
 - Goes back to the previous menu screen when using the menus.
 (*P.11)

8 SLOW/BACK - button

During a slow motion picture, adjust the playback speed in the reverse direction. (*P.16)

9 EXIT/STATUS button

Before using this button, press VCR.

- After pressing VCR:
 - Displays the time counter, present time, channel number, and remaining tape length. (*P.16)
 - Exits from menu operations when using the menus. (№P.11)

10 SPEED button

Selects the tape speed for recording (SP, LP or SLP). During playback, the tape speed is automatically selected (SP, LP, or SLP). (*P.14, P.17)

SP, LP : For PAL signal. SP, SLP : For NTSC signal.

11 REC (record)/OTR button

- Start recording when pressed once.
 (>P14)
- Starts a recording for 30 minutes to 9 hours long. When pressed more than once, the shut-off time increases in 30-minute intervals. (№P.15)

12 TV button

Makes the remote control ready for operating the TV.

13 VCR button

Makes the remote control ready for operating the VCR.

14 EJECT **≜** button

Ejects the cassette. (*P.14)

15 CH (channel) ▲ / ▼ button

Before using this button, press VCR or TV.

 After pressing VCR, changes the channels on the VCR. Release at a desired channel.

For some Philips TV only:

 After pressing TV, changes the channels on the TV. Release at a desired channel.

16 PLAY ► / ▲ button

Before using this button, press VCR.

21 TIMER button

Display the Timer Recording menu. (≈P.17)

22 Number buttons

(0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9)

Before using these buttons, press VCR.

- Press to select a channel on the VCR.
 To select channels 1 to 9, press 0
 then the channel you want. For example, for channel 4, press 0 then
 4.
- Also used to programme the Timer Recordings. (≉P.17)

23 CLEAR button

Erases unwanted timer programmes. (\$\times P.18)

24 AUDIO/MUTE button

For some Philips TV only: Turns off the TV sound.

25 INDEX I◄◄ / ▶▶I buttons


Locates an index marked at the beginning of every recording. (≉P.15)

To insert the batteries:

 Remove the battery compartment lid from the bottom of the remote control.



10 SPEED button

21 CH (channel) ▲ / ▼ button

Before using this button, press VCR or TV .

 After pressing VCR, changes the channels on the VCR. Release at a desired channel.

For some Philips TV only:

 After pressing TV, changes the channels on the TV. Release at a desired channel.

22 VOL (volume) ▲ / ▼ buttons

For some Philips TV only: Changes the TV volume. Release at desired volume.

23 CLEAR button

Erases unwanted timer programmes.

24 AUDIO/MUTE button

For some Philips TV only: Turns off the TV sound.



Rear Panel



1 AC (alternating current) power cord

VR388/588-55 EN (N)

Connect the AC power cord to an AC outlet.

2 ANT. (antenna) IN (input) terminal (from Antenna)

Connect your antenna or Cable to this terminal. (*P.9)

3 AV1 IN/OUT terminal (SCART)

For connecting to the SCART terminal (21-pin SCART connector) on TV or another VCR. (*P.9. P.19.)

4 RF OUT (output) terminal (to TV)


Use the supplied RF coaxial cable to connect this terminal on the TV. (*P.9)



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DESCRIPTION OF CONTROLS (CONTINUED)

Display Window



1 Operation mode indicators

- O: Lights up during recording.
- ►: Lights up during playback.
- III: Lights up during a pause.

2 Speed indicator

Indicates the tape speed.

SP - Standard Play

LP - Long Play

SLP – Super Long Play (For NTSC signal only).

3 ⊕ (timer) indicator

Lights up when the VCR is set for an unattended recording (timer recording). (*P.18)

4 Channel indicator

A channel number selected with the TV tuner built-in the VCR appears. When the external line input is selected: "L-F" appears for the front panel connectors or "L-1" appears for the rear panel connectors.

5 (Cassette-in) indicator

Lights up when there is a cassette in the VCR.


6 Digital clock/counter

- Normally the present time appears.
- When a tape is inserted, the time counter appears (and is reset to 0:00:00).

If you always rewind your tapes completely, you can use this counter reading as an index to find where a programme starts.

On-Screen Display

The following information (VCR operating status) appears on the TV screen. (*P.16)



Note on the displayed information

- The time counter and remaining tape length will not be correct when playing back an NTSC tape.
- When you playback a thin tape like an E-160 cassette tape or compact video cassette tape (VHS-C), the remaining tape length will flash.






GETTING CONNECTED UP

VCR to TV Connection

Connection Diagram

- 1 Disconnect the antenna or Cable from the TV and the AC power cord of the TV from the AC outlet.
- 2 Connect the antenna or Cable to the VCR.
- 3 Connect the VCR to the TV using the RF coaxial cable.
- 4 Plug the AC power cords of the VCR and TV into the AC outlets.



CAUTION

Do not plug the AC power cords until all connections are completed.

To watch a picture from this VCR on the TV, select UHF E36 channel (video channel of this VCR when shipped from the factory). If you want to change video channel, see "Setting the Video Channel" (*.P10).


VCR to AV TV Connection Using SCART Cable

With this connection, you can get better pictures and sounds when playing back a tape.

To watch a picture from this VCR on the

TV, select the video input on the TV, to which this VCR is connected.

Use the appropriate SCART cable depending on the TV's AV terminal.

SETTING UP

Setting the Video Channel

This VCR is designed to send picture and sound signal on UHF channel E36 to the TV, through the RF coaxial cable. If you want to change this video channel (E36) to another channel (between E28 to E60), follow the procedure below before turning on the VCR for the first time.

- 1 Make sure the VCR is turned off and no cassette is inserted.
- 2 Turn on the TV, and tune it to any channel (UHF E28 to E60) you want to use as the video channel on the TV.Select a channel not used in your area.
- **3** Press STOP/EJECT /▲ on the front panel for more than 5 seconds. The following indication appears on the display.



- TV system number starts flashing.


- **4** Press CH ▲ / ▼ to select an appropriate TV system number for your area.
 - 1: For B/G (West Europe, ASEAN Countries, Australia, New Zealand).
 - 2: For D/K (China, Russia, East Europe).
 - 3: For I (Hong Kong, South Africa, United Kingdom).
- **5** Press ►/OK.

The channel number starts flashing on the display.

6 Press CH ▲ / ▼ to select the channel you have tuned on the TV as the video channel in step 2. A test signal (two vertical white bars) appears on the TV.




Test signal (two vertical white bars)

If you use only external video input (AV) mode to watch the picture from this VCR

You can turn off the video channel output. To turn off the video output channel, press $CH \vee until "--"$ appears on the channel number position.

7 Press ►/OK to finish the video channel setting. Now you will enter the Initial Setup mode explained on page 11.

To watch a picture from this VCR on the TV, select the same channel you have selected as the video channel (in step 2 above) on the TV.



The buttons on the front panel having the same (or nearly same) name or same (or nearly same) mark function exactly the same as those on the remote control.

Menu Operations

Before operating the VCR, be familiar with the menu operations first because most of the features built into the VCR can be available only on the menus.

- 1 Press VCR on the remote control.
- When using the buttons on front panel, skip this step.
- 2 Press MENU (or MENU/ EXIT on the front panel) to display the main menu screen.



- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ (or CHANNEL ▲/ ▼ on the front panel) to select a desired feature on the menu, then press ►/OK.
- 4 When you select a feature, go to the section in this manual and follow the instructions described

To go back to the previous menu screen, press **◄**.

To exit from the menu operations, press EXIT/STATUS (or MENU/ EXIT on the front panel again).

Menu operating buttons function only when a menu is on the TV screen. When no menus is on the TV screen, they function differently.

IMPORTANT

The setup and adjustment procedures explained hereafter are written under the following conditions:

- You have turned on the TV and selected the video channel (or external video input).
- You have turned on the VCR.

Initial Setup

For the first time you turn on the VCR, the VCR automatically enters the Initial Setup mode unless you have set it. This mode asks you to set the following items:

- Selecting the language.
- Setting the clock.
- Selecting the TV system.
- Setting the channels.

Make sure....

- · Your VCR, TV, and antenna are connected correctly.
- The remote control operation mode is set correctly for operating your target component.
 - Press VCR to operate the VCR.
 - Press TV to operate the TV.

Select the Language

- 1 Press VCR.
- When using the buttons on front panel, skip this step.
- 2 Press POWER. The VCR turns on, then the menu for selecting the language appears.


Set Clock

- 2 Press ▲ or ▼ to set the time, then press ►/OK.

- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to set the month and day, then press ►/OK.

4 Start Auto Programming

Press ►/OK.

Auto programming starts, and the following message appears on the TV.



The local channels receivable in your area are automatically programmed in the VCR tuner.

• If "NO TV SIGNALS" appears on the TV screen, the TV or an antenna is not connected correctly. Check the connection and press ►/OK again.

SETTING UP (CONTINUED)

When the auto programming is completed

The following message appears on the TV, and the lowest channel will be tuned in.



Now you have finished the initial set up procedure.

If you stop the initial setup procedure while it is proceeding:

The VCR enters the initial setup mode again the next time your turn on the VCR.

Initial setup will not start in the following cases:

- · If there is a tape inserted.
- If any one of the initial setup procedures is finished manually.

To reset the clock manually

You can also reset or correct the clock manually.

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "INITIAL SET UP" then press ►.

 The Initial Set Up menu appears.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "SET CLOCK" then press ►/OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to set the time, then press ►/OK.
 - Each time you press ▲ or ▼, the set time changes by 1-minute intervals. If you hold the button, the set time changes by 30-minute intervals.
- 6 Press ▲ or ▼ to set the month and day, then press ►/OK.
 - Each time you press ▲ or ▼, the set date changes by 1-day intervals. If you hold the button, the set date changes by 15-day intervals.
- 7 Press ▲ or ▼ to set the year, then press ►/OK.
 - Each time you press ▲ or ▼, the set date changes by 1-year intervals. If you hold the button, the set year changes rapidly.
- **8** Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

Note:

If a power failure occurs, clock will lose its setting.

To change the language manually

You can also change the language manually.

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "INITIAL SET UP" then press ►.

 The Initial Set Up menu appears.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "LANGUAGE."
- 5 Press ►/OK to select the language on the TV screen.

Each time you press the button, the language changes as follows:

6 Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

If you want to delete unwanted channels

You can delete channels manually. After you have deleted the channels, they will be not selected by pressing $CH \blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$.

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "CHANG-ING TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.

The programmed

channel information list appears with the settings of the tuned channel flashing. (You can also watch the picture of the tuned channel since the list and the picture alternates on the TV.)

- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ until an unwanted channel setting flashes.
- **6** Press CLEAR to delete the unwanted channel.
- If you have accidentally deleted a channel, press ◀.
- 7 Repeat steps 5 and 6 until you delete all unwanted channels.
- **8** Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

If you want to exchange the channel positions

You can also replace the channel position numbers.

EX. Replace channel 9 and channel 3

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "CHANGING TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ until information for channel 3 flashes.
- 6 Press ►/OK once. Only channel indication for channel 3 starts flashing.
- 7 Press 0 then 9. The channel settings for channel 3 and 9 are exchanged.
- If you have accidentally deleted a channel, press ◀.
- 8 Press ►/OK to store the setting.
- **9** Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

If the picture is not clear

You need to fine-tune this particular channel.

EX. Fine-tune channel 3

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "CHANGING TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ until information for channel 3 flashes.
- 6 Press ►/OK twice. Only frequency indication for channel 3 starts flashing.
- 7 Press ▲ or ▼ to fine-tune the station until you get the best possible picture.
- **8** Press ►/OK to store the setting.
- **9** Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.









You need to change the TV system for this particular channel.

EX. Change the TV system for channel 3

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "CHANGING TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ until information for channel 3 flashes
- 6 Press ►/OK three times. Only TV system indication for channel 3 starts flashing.
- 7 Press ▲ or ▼ to select the appropriate TV system (BG, DK, I) so that sound comes out.
- 8 Press ►/OK to store the setting.
- 9 Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

If you need to do the auto programming again

If you move to another place, you may need to tune the VCR tuner again for your new residential area.

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK.
- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "AUTO TUNER SET UP" then ►/OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to select the appropriate TV system (B/G, D/K, I) of your residential area.
- 6 Press ►/OK. Auto programming starts. When it ends, programmed channels, frequencies, and TV systems are shown on the display.
- 7 Press EXIT/STATUS to exit from the menu operations.

Manual Channel Setting

When you want to do channel setting manually, follow this procedure.

Select Tuner Set Up Mode

- 1 Press VCR.
- 2 Press MENU.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to select "TUNER SET UP" then press ►/OK. The Tuner Set Up menu appears.

Selecting Colour Mode

Before using the VCR, you need to set the colour mode both for recording and playback.

Press COLOUR MODE on the front panel to change the colour system.

For recording:

- AUTO: Normally select this mode. The colour system is automatically detected.
- NTSC3.58: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when recording the NTSC signals. (For playback on an NTSC TV)
- NTSC4.43: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when recording the NTSC signals on the PAL TV. (For playback on a PAL TV)
- PAL: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when recording the PAL signals.
- MESECAM: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when recording the SECAM signals.

For playback:

- **AUTO:** Normally select this mode. When you watch a PAL, NTSC or MESECAM tape, the colour system is automatically detected.
- NTSC3.58: Select this mode when you watch an NTSC3.58 tape on an NTSC TV.
- NTSC4.43: Select this mode when you watch an NTSC4.43 tape on a PAL TV.
- NTSC→PAL TV : Select this mode when you watch an NTSC3.58 tape on a PAL
- PAL: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when playing back a PAL tape.
- MESECAM: Select this mode if "AUTO" does not work well when playing back a MESECAM tape.

Notes on the indications on the display while an OTR operation

- During recording, the displayed time counts down. When "0:00" is reached, recording stops and the VCR turns off automatically.
- If an OTR is engaged during pause, the displayed time counts down normally, but recording does not begin until you cancel the pause.

Index Search

Auto rewind

When a tape reaches its end during playback, fast forwarding, or manual recording, the VCR rewinds the tape and stops.

Memory rewind power off

Eject cassette






Auto tracking








Connection Diagram
